Capital Improvement Program: PHL has undergone more than \$2 billion in capital improvements since 2000.

Major Construction Projects:

- Terminal A-East Improvements: \$82.3 million, completed 2014
- Runway 9L/27R rehabilitation: \$ 1.8 million, completed 2015
- Taxiway K extension: \$19.7 million, completed 2015
- Terminal F Expansion: \$162 million, completed 2016

Ongoing Capital Projects:

- Runway 27L Extension and Taxiways Improvements: estimated \$200 million
- East Airfield Improvements: estimated \$20 million
- PNE Runway 6-24 Pavement Rehab: estimated \$35 million
- Terminal A-West Sector 3 Explosive Detection System: estimated \$30 million
- Restroom Improvements Program: estimated \$15 million
- Passenger Loading Bridge Program: estimated \$20 million
