



Impact of Northridge Earthquake on MTA Service Delivery and System Patronage

30 Day Progress Report

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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

After a quick assessment of the damage to the MTA's bus and rail operating facilities, as well as roads and highways in the Los Angeles Metropolitan Area resulting from the Northridge earthquake on the morning of January 17, 1994, the MTA Operations staff moved swiftly to implement a number of service changes to its regularly scheduled bus service and the Freeway Service Patrol Program.

Service changes were made to restore some of the accessibility lost by the residents of affected communities of Antelope, Santa Clarita, Simi, and San Fernando Valleys, and the Westside Communities due to the partial closures of the I-5, I-10, SR 14, and SR 118 Freeways. A total of 106 bus detours were initially implemented to get around the street closures. Service was enhanced along major radial bus lines in the I-10 Corridor connecting Westside Communities and the Los Angeles CBD to avoid anticipated overcrowding.

To complement the Metrolink service along the Santa Clarita and the Palmdale/Santa Clarita Lines, the MTA implemented a number of route deviations along its regularly scheduled service in the vicinity of Sylmar/San Fernando, Burbank, and Glendale Stations. MTA Operations staff also conducted an origin-destination study and established new emergency routes to provide direct expedited service to the final destinations of the Metrolink patrons disembarking at Sylmar/San Fernando, Burbank, Glendale, and Union Stations.

MTA Operations staff also worked with the CSUN Administration to design and implement shuttle services between the fringe parking lots and the main campus.

The MTA bus system and the Metro Blue Line experienced a decline in patronage immediately following the quake, but patronage levels were restored to the pre-quake level within 10 days. For the entire month of January, 1994, the MTA Red Line patronage increased by 12.5% as more Metrolink riders transferred to this service to reach their final destinations.

The Freeway Service Patrol Program was expanded by eight light duty and two heavy duty trucks to improve the mobility during the post-earthquake recovery and reconstruction. Over 2,500 assists were made by the Service Patrol drivers within the earthquake assistance beats (service areas).

The MTA continues to monitor the effectiveness of all of its service changes. If sufficient patronage does not materialize, these service changes have either been modified further or discontinued.

In summary, the MTA, together with its sister agencies, has mitigated some of the lost accessibility to jobs and other regional opportunities by providing viable alternatives to the automobile to the residents of the affected communities in Antelope, Santa Clarita, Simi, and San Fernando Valleys, and the West Los Angeles Area.

IMPACT OF NORTHRIDGE EARTHQUAKE ON MTA SERVICE DELIVERY AND SYSTEM PATRONAGE—30 DAY PROGRESS REPORT

1.0 INTRODUCTION

Following the Northridge earthquake of January 17, 1994, the MTA implemented a number of changes to its regularly scheduled bus service as well as the Freeway Service Patrol Program. This report describes the alterations to the regularly scheduled service, introduction of new service, rationale for implementing these service changes, and the associated impact on system ridership for both bus and rail service. Also included is a description of the expanded service areas (beats) for the Freeway Service Patrol Program that were created to serve alternate routes that were recommended by the California Department of Transportation (CALTRANS) and the California Highway Patrol (CHP) which bypassed the freeway closures resulting from the quake.

2.0 IMPACTED SERVICE AREAS

The Northridge earthquake resulted in severe structural damage and the closure of portions of the four major freeways serving the Los Angeles Metropolitan Area. These freeway segments were: (1) Golden State Freeway (I-5) between Calgrove Blvd. and Weldon Canyon Road in the Santa Clarita Valley, (2) Ramps connecting the Antelope Valley Freeway (SR 14) and I-5 in the Santa Clarita/Antelope Valley Area, (3) Simi Valley Freeway (SR 118) between Tampa Ave. and Foothill Freeway (I-210), and (4) Santa Monica Freeway (I-10) between Washington Blvd. and La Cienega in the West Los Angeles Area. Locations of these freeway closures and alternate routes recommended by CALTRANS and the CHP to get around these closures following the quake are shown in Appendix I.

3.0 MTA SERVICE CHANGES

In order to restore some of the accessibility lost by the residents of affected communities of Santa Clarita, Antelope Valley, Simi Valley, Northridge, Granada Hills, and the West Los Angeles Area, the MTA implemented a number of service changes to its bus lines. These service changes can be categorized as follows: (a) Detours along existing bus lines to get around freeway and arterial closures due to the quake, (b) Service enhancements to existing bus lines, (c) Route deviations along existing bus lines to better serve the Metrolink Stations (d) Creation of new

park-and-ride lots, and (e) New bus lines operated by the MTA and other local operators.

Subsequent sub-sections describe these service changes in greater detail.

3.1 Bus Detours Along Existing Bus Lines Following the Quake

Immediately following the quake, the MTA Operations staff established a command post in the Bus Operations Control Center at the 425 S. Main St. Location. The MTA staff moved swiftly to assess the damage sustained by each MTA operating facility as well as the general infrastructure within the service area.

A total of 106 bus detours were initially established to bypass:

- Damaged streets and highways in the San Fernando Valley (SR 118) and the West Los Angeles Area (I-10), and;
- Street closures resulting from condemned buildings in Hollywood, West Hollywood, Westlake, Santa Monica, and Huntington Park Area.

Despite the severity of the tremor and associated damage, the MTA Operations staff managed to roll-out 94% of the scheduled buses on the morning of Monday, January 17, 1994. The following morning, 99.3% of the scheduled service was filled; by the third day scheduled service was restored to fully authorized levels.

As of March 1, 1994, 13 detours still remain in effect due to the partial closure of I-10 and SR 118. These detours are along:

- Pull-out, and pull-in routes of MTA lines operating out of Divisions 8 and 15 in the San Fernando Valley;
- Segment of MTA Line 545 (Highway Hummer) along SR 118 Freeway;
- Pull-out, and pull-in routes of MTA lines operating out of Divisions 2, 6, 7, and 10.
- MTA lines that are routed through the West Los Angeles Transit Center, including Lines 1/217, 37, 38, 68, 434, 436, 439, and 576. These lines may continue to experience operational delays for a period of up to one year or until the I-10 reconstruction is complete.

3.2 Service Enhancement Along Existing Bus Lines Connecting Westside Communities and the San Fernando Valley

In order to provide adequate capacity to meet anticipated increase in transit usage along major radial bus lines connecting the Westside Communities and the Los Angeles CBD, and increased demand to utilize the Metrolink Burbank Station to reach the jobs located in the Universal City Area, the MTA Operations staff enhanced the existing services as follows:

MTA Line 2 (Sunset Blvd.)--For the period 1/20/94 through 2/2/94, three buses were added during the AM and PM peak periods on weekdays, providing 22 additional revenue hours of bus service daily.

MTA Line 4 (Santa Monica Blvd.)--For the period 1/19/94 through 2/2/94, five buses were added during the AM and PM peak periods on weekdays, providing 37.5 daily additional revenue hours of bus service daily.

MTA Line 20 (Wilshire Blvd.)--For the period 1/20/94 through 2/2/94, five buses were added during the AM and PM peak periods on weekdays, providing 37.5 daily additional revenue hours of bus service daily.

MTA Line 152 (Fallbrook Ave.-Roscoe Blvd.-Vineland Ave.-Burbank)--For the period 1/20/94 through 1/31/94, one bus was added during the AM and PM peak periods on weekdays, providing 10.1 daily additional revenue hours of bus service. For the period 2/1/94 through 2/3/94, two buses were added during the AM and PM peak periods, providing 10.4 daily additional revenue hours of bus service. For the period 2/4/94 through 2/18/94, two buses were added during the AM peak and one bus added during the PM peak period, providing 14.7 daily additional revenue hours of bus service.

MTA Line 434 (Los Angeles-Santa Monica-Malibu-Trancas Express)--For the period 1/20/94 through 1/21/94, two buses were added during the AM and PM peak periods on weekdays, providing 13.2 daily additional revenue hours of bus service. For the period 1/24/94 through 1/28/94, two buses were added during the AM and PM peak periods, providing 7.5 daily additional revenue hours of bus service. For the period 1/31/94 through 2/4/94, four buses were added during the AM peak and five buses were added during the PM peak period, providing 21.6 daily additional revenue hours of bus service. For the period 2/7/94 through 2/11/94, four buses were added during the AM peak and five buses were added during the PM peak period, providing 23.4 daily additional revenue hours of bus service. For the period 2/14/94 through 2/18/94, four buses were added during the

AM peak and five buses were added during the PM peak period, providing 26.4 daily additional revenue hours of bus service.

MTA Line 439 (Los Angeles-LAX-Redondo Beach Express)--For the period 1/20/94 through 2/11/94, six buses were added during the AM and PM peak periods on weekdays, providing 42.9 daily additional revenue hours of bus service. For the period 2/14/94 through 2/25/94, six buses were added during the AM and PM peak periods, providing 50.9 daily additional revenue hours of bus service.

It should be noticed that the only major radial line in the I-10 Corridor not receiving additional service was MTA Line 33 along the Venice Blvd. The MTA Operations staff opted to defer the service enhancement on this line due to the anticipated increase in vehicular traffic and congestion as a result of the diversion of traffic from the freeway.

Table 1 provides pre and post quake transit demand data (average passengers on-board per trip) during certain time periods at key locations along these lines. Details of route-of-line, scheduled trips prior to the quake, and temporary change notices showing service enhancements are shown in Appendix II.

3.3 Route Deviations Along Existing MTA Routes in the Vicinity of the Metrolink Stations

With the exception of a train derailment in Northridge on the Moorpark Line, there was little damage along the Metrolink right-of-way. It became apparent that: (1) the Santa Clarita Commuter Rail Line connecting stations located in Santa Clarita, Burbank, Glendale, and the Los Angeles CBD, and (2) the Moorpark Commuter Rail Line connecting stations located in Moorpark, Simi Valley, Chatsworth, Van Nuys, Burbank, Glendale, and the Los Angeles CBD would provide major trunk service to the affected communities of Santa Clarita/Antelope Valley and Simi/San Fernando Valley.

Having received authorization from the MTA Board of Directors on January 26, 1994, for an emergency funding of \$51 million, the Santa Clarita Line was extended northeast to provide access to the communities of Lancaster and Palmdale with new station openings at Lancaster, Palmdale, Vincent Grade/Acton, and Santa Clarita/Princessa. In addition, a new station was added between Santa Clarita and Burbank Stations to provide access to the communities of Sylmar/San Fernando. This station was previously slated for opening in April '94. The Moorpark Line was extended further southwest to provide access to the community of Camarillo. A new station was added between Chatsworth and Van Nuys Stations to provide access to the community of Northridge.

To better interface the existing MTA bus routes and the Metrolink Stations located at Sylmar/San Fernando, Burbank, and Glendale, the MTA implemented route deviations along existing lines operating in the vicinity of these stations as well as established new routes to provide direct service to the major final destinations of patrons disembarking at these stations. This section describes the deviations to existing routes. The following section provides details on newly established routes.

Sylmar/San Fernando Metrolink Station

The following seven MTA routes were re-routed to the newly established station on opening day, February 3, 1994.

MTA Routes 92/93 and 410 that operate along Glenoaks Blvd. through Pacoima, Sun Valley and into Burbank, then along Brand Blvd. through Glendale;

MTA Line 94 serving Juvenile Hall and Olive View Medical Center in Sylmar and City of San Fernando, Sylmar, Pacoima, Sun Valley, Burbank-Glendale-Pasadena Airport, Burbank, and Glendale via San Fernando Road;

MTA Line 230 that operates along Laurel Canyon Blvd. through the City of San Fernando, Pacoima, Sun Valley, North Hollywood, and Studio City; and

MTA Line 239 that operates primarily over Rinaldi St. and Zelzah and White Oak Avenues through the City of San Fernando, Mission Hills, Granada Hills, Northridge, Reseda, and Encino.

In addition, **MTA Line 573** (Santa Clarita-Granada Hills-Century City Commuter Express Line) was also re-routed to serve this station. This line is operated by the MTA under contract for the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT).

Burbank Metrolink Station

Prior to the quake, only MTA Line 152 was providing a shuttle service between this station and the Media District in downtown Burbank. After the quake, the following four MTA lines were also re-routed to serve this station:

MTA Line 154 that operates through North Hollywood and Van Nuys to Encino, Tarzana, Reseda and Northridge along Burbank Blvd., Oxnard St. and Tampa Ave. to Rinaldi St.;

MTA Line 163 that operates through North Hollywood and Van Nuys to Reseda and Canoga Park along Sherman Way;

MTA Line 164 that operates through North Hollywood and Van Nuys to Reseda and Woodland Hills (Warner Center-Topanga Plaza) along Victory Blvd.; and

MTA Line 165 that operates through North Hollywood and Van Nuys to Reseda and Canoga Park along Vanowen St.

Glendale Metrolink Station

Prior to the quake, **MTA Line 183** directly served this station. This line operates through downtown and southeast Glendale and into the San Fernando Valley along Chevy Chase Drive, Kenneth Road and Magnolia Blvd. Another **MTA Line 94** (San Fernando Road) is a short walk from the station to the east. After the quake, the following three lines were re-routed to provide direct access:

MTA Routes 180-181 that operate through Eagle Rock to Pasadena along Colorado Blvd. and Yosemite Drive and also to Hollywood along Los Feliz Blvd. and Hollywood Blvd.; and

MTA Line 201 that serves downtown Glendale and northeast residential areas, and also Atwater, Silverlake, and the Mid-Wilshire Area to the south along Brunswick Ave., Silverlake Blvd. and Vermont Ave.

Passenger boarding/alighting activity along the MTA lines serving the aforementioned Metrolink Stations is summarized in Table 2.

3.4 New Bus Lines Implemented by the MTA to Complement the Metrolink Service

Based upon a comprehensive origin-destination survey of the Metrolink riders conducted on January 25-26, 1994, the MTA Operations staff identified the major work destinations of the patrons alighting at Sylmar/San Fernando, Burbank, Glendale and Union Stations. Besides Burbank, Glendale and the Los Angeles CBDs, the major final destinations were also reported in Pasadena, Hollywood, Warner Center, Universal City, LAX/El Segundo Area, and Century City. To provide a direct and expedited service to these final destinations, the MTA designed and implemented a number of new bus lines. These emergency bus routes were:

MTA Emergency Line 640 (Burbank-Glendale-Pasadena Special Express) providing express service between Burbank Metrolink Station and origin/destinations further east in downtown Glendale and downtown Pasadena.

MTA Emergency Line 641 (Burbank-Warner Center Special Express) providing express service between Burbank Metrolink Station and destinations further west in the Burbank Media District, Sherman Oaks, Encino, Tarzana, Warner Center (Woodland Hills) and Canoga Park Areas.

MTA Emergency Line 642 (Burbank Metrolink Station-East Pasadena Special Express) providing express service between Burbank Metrolink Station, downtown Pasadena, and East Pasadena (Hastings Ranch). This line was operated by the Foothill Transit on MTA's behalf.

MTA Emergency Line 643 (Sylmar-Van Nuys) providing service between Sylmar Metrolink Station and destinations further south along Van Nuys Blvd. in Van Nuys. This line was operated by Super Shuttle on MTA's behalf under a contract from the LA DOT.

It should be noted that effective February 21, 1994, the MTA canceled service on Lines 641 and 642, replacing segments on restructured Line 640. Restructured Line 640 provides expedited service from the Burbank Metrolink Station to the Universal City and the Burbank Media District. The line was also extended to serve East Pasadena and Hastings Ranch. Replacement for Line 641 service to Warner Center was made available on Santa Clarita Line 796 and Antelope Valley Transit Authority Line 787 or by transferring from revised Line 640 to MTA Line 425 on Ventura Blvd. Effective February 17, 1994, service on Line 643 was also canceled and was taken over by the Transportation Management Association (TMA) using corporate sponsored vanpools.

Westside Communities

To improve access from the Westside and to provide connecting service to Metrolink patrons having final destination in the West Los Angeles Area, three new express lines were designed and implemented. These lines are as follows:

MTA Emergency Line 634 (Westside Special) providing service between Santa Monica, Century City, Olympic/Western Ave, and downtown Los Angeles.

LA DOT Emergency Line 644 (West Los Angeles Park-Ride) providing service between UCLA Park-Ride lot OC located in the West Los Angeles and downtown Los Angeles.

MTA/Foothill Emergency Line 646 (Union Station-Aviation Station Park-Ride-Lot-LAX City Bus Center) providing service between LAX City Bus Center, Metro Green Line Aviation Station, and downtown Los Angeles.

Total daily patronage on these post-quake emergency lines is shown in Table 3.

3.5 Establishment of New Park-and-Ride Lots

In order to improve the access between the LAX/Weschester Area and the Union Station, the MTA created a new Line 646 effective Monday, 2/14/94. This line is being jointly operated by the MTA and the Foothill Transit Zone. This line also serves the Aviation Station to be opened along the Metro Green Line. Besides providing park-and-ride opportunity at this lot, the MTA also re-routed two existing lines providing circulation through the El Segundo Employment Center. These lines are MTA Line 515 (Blue Line Transfer) and MTA Line 623 (Rabbit).

3.6 California State University Northridge (CSUN) Shuttle Service

The Northridge earthquake severely damaged several student/faculty parking structures located on the CSUN Campus. The MTA Operations staff met with the CSUN Administrators to help develop and implement a system for off-site parking and shuttle service to and from the class-rooms and other main buildings on the campus. Shuttle bus routes were designed from temporary fringe parking lots located near Devonshire/Lindley, Shirley/Plummer (Handyman's Lot) and the newly opened Metrolink Station in Northridge. Actual service was started on February 14, 1994, the opening day of classes for the new semester. Table 4 provides total daily patronage along these shuttle routes operated to and from the CSUN Campus.

Specific route-of-line, hours of operation and service frequencies, and tariffs along new emergency lines described in these sections are provided in Appendix III.

4.0 EXPANDED FREEWAY SERVICE PATROL

Following the quake, the MTA created two new beats to serve freeway alternate routes that were designated by CALTRANS and CHP as bypasses to the closed freeway segments. These new service areas are:

- Beat 41 - Antelope Valley Freeway Alternative between I-5 at Roxford and San Fernando Road; and
- Beat 42 - I-5 Alternative between Lyons Ave. and Roxford St.

These new service areas are shown in Figure 1.

Besides creating Beats 41 and 42, the following beats received added trucks or hours of service coverage for alternate freeway routes and "back-up" congestion:

- Beat 7 - I-101 between Reseda and SR 134 Interchange
- Beat 10 - I-405 between Devonshire and Mulholand
- Beat 17 - I-10 between Bundy and Vermont
- Beat 31 - I-5 between Hollywood Way and Stadium Way
- Beat 33 - SR 118 between Rocky Peak Road to I-210 interchange at McClay
- Beat 35 - SR 134 between Pacific and Orange Grove
- Beat 36 - SR 170 between Sheldon and Magnolia.

As back-up congestion cleared with opening of closed freeway segments, the expanded service is being eliminated. For example, expanded service on Beats 31, 35 and 36 was in effect for ten days only. Occasionally, night and weekend service has been used to accommodate construction required lane closures. As shown in Figure 2, the expanded Freeway Service Patrol has provided over 2,500 additional assists. It is estimated that approximately \$1 million of travel time delay has been eliminated in first-five weeks since the quake.

In addition, the MTA created two heavy duty tow truck beats to ensure that trucks carrying perishable goods to the Los Angeles Metropolitan Area along I-5 were not delayed. Everyday these heavy duty trucks clear between four to six lane-blocking incidents involving trucks which cause significant delay. It is estimated that thousands of hours of commuter and shipping delays have been saved by reducing clearance time for these incidents. Figure 3 shows daily heavy duty assists made possible by these truck beats.

A maximum amount of \$2.2 million of expenditures is expected to finance this expanded Freeway Service Patrol Program. However, no impact on the MTA's budget deficit is anticipated as these expenses will be fully reimbursed by the Federal Highway Administration's (FHWA) Emergency Relief (ER) funds until July, 1994, six months after the quake. After that time, 90% reimbursement will be received.

5.0 IMPACT OF NORTHRIDGE EARTHQUAKE ON MTA BUS SYSTEM FAREBOX REVENUE

Pre and post quake daily farebox revenues on the MTA bus system are shown in Figure 4. It can be seen that immediately following the quake a significant decline

in the farebox revenue was experienced. However, within 10 days following the quake, farebox revenues recovered to the pre-quake level.

Weekly bus system farebox revenues (pre and post quake) are shown in Figure 5. This chart also shows the weekly farebox revenues realized in 1993 during the same period. During the first two week period preceding the quake, farebox revenues were running 14.3% higher than registered during the same period last year. If farebox revenues during the two week period *following* the quake had continued to increase 14.3% over the January 1993 level, the MTA could have realized \$5.36 million in farebox revenues against \$4.01 million actually received. This implies that as a result of the Northridge earthquake, the MTA has experienced a loss of at least \$1.35 million in passenger revenues during January '94.

During the first three weeks in February '94, total farebox revenues were \$7.14 million versus \$7.26 million received for the same period last year. If the 14.3% growth in farebox revenue would have continued during February '94 as well, the MTA could have realized \$8.27 million in farebox revenues. This implies that another \$1.14 million may have been lost as a result of the earthquake. It should be noted that any gain in passenger revenues due to reimbursements received from Metrolink for increased transfer activity between the MTA bus lines and the Metro Red Line are not included in these analyses. Also, the impact of pass sales for February '94 on the potential loss or gain in passenger revenues is not included in these calculations.

6.0 IMPACT OF NORTHRIDGE EARTHQUAKE ON THE MTA BUS SYSTEM RIDERSHIP

To assess the impact of the quake on the MTA system ridership, Operations staff tracked a number of indicators that could signal change in ridership. The indicators that were tracked are:

- Daily farebox receipts,
- Point checks at key locations along the MTA bus lines,
- Trip cards filled out by Operators on new Emergency Routes,
- Daily Metrolink ridership,
- Point Checks at the Florence Station on the Metro Blue Line, and

- Boarding/Alighting checks on randomly selected Metro Red Line cars.

Estimated daily system-wide bus patronage pre and post the quake is shown in Figure 6. Following the trend in farebox revenue, patronage declined during the first week following the quake but recovered to the pre-quake level within a week after the earthquake. Following the quake, most of the schools and colleges in the Santa Clarita, Antelope, Simi, and San Fernando Valleys remained closed for a period of at least two weeks. If these school related boardings, which account for 8 to 10% of the system boardings, are excluded from the pre-quake level, it appears that following the quake the MTA bus system patronage may have actually increased.

As indicated earlier, patronage trends following the quake were tracked using a series of point checks at key locations within the affected travel corridors. These point check locations were: (1) Temple and Grand, (2) Hill and College, and (3) Van Nuys and Roscoe. Table 5 provides pre and post patronage activity at these locations. It can be seen that within 10 days following the quake, patronage activity resumed to the pre-quake level.

7.0 IMPACT OF NORTHRIDGE EARTHQUAKE ON THE METRO BLUE LINE RIDERSHIP

Estimated daily pre and post quake Metro Blue Line patronage is shown in Figure 7. It has been estimated that on January 17, 1994, the Metro Blue Line carried approximately 6,000 patrons. Besides the earthquake, the ridership on this day was also influenced by the holiday celebrating Dr. Martin Luther King's Birthday and partially curtailed service due to the safety inspections. During the first ten days following the quake, the Metro Blue Line experienced a decline in patronage, but by January 26, 1994, the ridership had recovered to the pre-quake level.

8.0 IMPACT OF NORTHRIDGE EARTHQUAKE ON THE METRO RED LINE RIDERSHIP

Estimated daily pre and post quake Metro Red Line patronage is shown in Figure 8. For safety inspections, the Metro Red Line service was not operated on January 17, 22 and 23, 1994. Following the quake, the Metro Red Line experienced an increase in daily patronage due to the increased number of riders taking Metrolink to commute to the LA CBD and transferring to the Red Line to reach their final destinations. For the month of January '94, the Metro Red Line average weekday boardings were 12.5% higher than those registered during the previous month, December '93.

9.0 SUMMARY AND CONCLUSION

Following the Northridge earthquake, the MTA made a number of changes in its bus network to meet altered travel demand from Santa Clarita/Antelope Valley, Simi/San Fernando Valley, and the Westside Communities. Brand new emergency lines such as 634, 640, 641, 642, 643, 644, and 646 were created to improve the regional accessibility from the affected communities. Route deviations/detours and service enhancements were also implemented to bypass freeway/arterial closures, to provide better interface to the Metrolink stations, and to meet anticipated increase in transit travel demand. Besides service enhancements, the Freeway Service Patrol Program provided by the MTA was expanded to cover alternate routes designated as bypasses for closed freeway segments. In addition, extra Heavy Duty Patrol Service was created to tow disabled trucks.

MTA continues to monitor the effectiveness of these service changes. If sufficient patronage does not materialize, these service changes have either been discontinued or further modified. For example, effective February 21, 1994, the MTA canceled service on Lines 641 and 642 and restructured the service on Line 640. Restructured Line 640 provides expedited service from the Burbank Metrolink Station to Universal City and the Burbank Media District. The line was also extended to serve East Pasadena and Hastings Ranch. Replacement for Line 641 service to Warner Center was made available on Santa Clarita Line 796 and Antelope Valley Transit Authority Line 787 or by transferring from revised Line 640 to MTA Line 425 on Ventura Blvd. Service on Line 643 was discontinued on February 16, 1994. Service enhancements along MTA Lines 2, 4, 20, 152, 434, and 439 have also been discontinued due to less than anticipated increase in patronage.

Overall system-wide bus and Metro Blue Line patronage levels have recovered to the levels recorded prior to the earthquake. Increased Metrolink demand has resulted in increased Metro Red Line patronage.





SYSTEM-WIDE DAILY BUS FAREBOX REVENUE PRE AND POST NORTHRIDGE EARTHQUAKE






MTA SYSTEM-WIDE DAILY BUS RIDERSHIP PRE AND POST EARTHQUAKE



DAILY METRO BLUE LINE BOARDINGS BEFORE AND AFTER THE EARTHQUAKE



DAILY METRO RED LINE BOARDINGS BEFORE AND AFTER THE EARTHQUAKE








