PRICE SITUATIONER OF SELECTED AGRICULTURAL COMMODITIES

FIRST WEEK OF JUNE 2019

1. Prices of rice are generally stable during the week (Table 1).
 - Five regional centers posted changes in the prices of rice by P1.00 and P2.00 per kilogram during the period.
2. Price movements in meat and egg are noted in some regional centers (Table 2).
 - Price changes by P5.00 and P10.00 per kilogram of pork were registered in five regional centers.
 - A medium-sized chicken egg was priced higher by P0.25 per piece in Cebu City. However, it decreased by P0.33 to P2.00 per piece in four regional centers.
3. Some fish species are priced lower in selected regional centers (Table 3).
 - The price of a kilogram of alumahan fell by P15.00 in Cagayan de Oro City and by P20.00 in San Fernando City (Region 1), Cebu City and Tacloban City. Meanwhile, it picked up by P10.00 in Butuan City and by P20.00 in Legaspi City.
 - Prices of galunggong were cheaper by P10.00 per kilogram in Legaspi City, Cebu City and Cotabato City; and by P20.00 per kilogram in Batangas City and Davao City. On the other hand, it climbed by P10.00 to P20.00 per kilogram in five regional centers.
4. Price changes in vegetables vary in the regional centers this week (Table 4).
 - Prices of a kilogram of ampalaya went up by P5.00 to P20.00 in six regional centers. However, it was lower by P10.00 in Cebu City and Cotabato City, and by P20.00 in Kidapawan City.
 - A P20.00 per kilogram price mark-up for cabbage was noted in Tacloban City. On the other hand, it dropped by P10.00 to P35.00 per kilogram in seven regional centers.
 - Price increments in eggplant ranging from P5.00 to P20.00 per kilogram were noted in seven regional centers. On the contrary, it was sold lower by P5.00 in Cagayan de Oro City and Cotabato City, and by P10.00 in Naga City and Cebu City.
 - The price of a kilogram of native pechay went up by P10.00 and P20.00 in seven regional centers. Meanwhile, it declined by P10.00 in Cabanatuan City and by P60.00 in Naga City.
5. Prices of condiments accelerate in selected regional centers (Table 5).
 - A kilogram of red onion increased by P10.00 in Baguio City and Batangas City. Meanwhile, it decreased by P10.00 to P20.00 per kilogram in four regional centers.
 - The price of a kilogram of imported garlic soared by P70.00 in Tacloban City. It, likewise, rose by P10.00 to P30.00 per kilogram in five regional centers.

6. Prices of fruits in selected regional centers drop this week (Table 6).
- Price of calamansi fell by P2.00 to P25.00 per kilogram in five regional centers. Meanwhile, it picked up by P10.00 in Cabanatuan City and Cebu City, and by P40.00 in Zamboanga City.
 - A kilogram of carabao mango was priced lower by P10.00 to P40.00 in four regional centers. On the contrary, it went up by P20.00 per kilogram in Tacloban City.
7. Prices of other basic commodities generally remain at their previous week's levels (Table 7).
- Price cuts from P2.00 to P10.00 per bottle of long neck cooking oil were posted in four regional centers.
 - A kilogram of brown sugar declined by P2.00 in Legaspi City; by P8.00 in Tacloban City; and by P10.00 in Kidapawan City. Meanwhile, a price mark-up of P2.00 per kilogram of brown sugar was noticed in Naga City.
 - Prices of refined sugar were cheaper by P1.00 to P5.00 per kilogram in four regional centers. However, it was higher by P1.00 per kilogram in Naga City.
