FUN FACTS

- ★ It will be game No. 304 in the history of the Gold Cup. It will be the 2nd game played at the Allianz Field Stadium (Saint Paul, MN) in GC (1 of the 4 stadiums debuting in this edition).
- ★ The two teams will do battle in an unprecedented duel in the Gold Cup. Guyana will be seen for the first time in the general history. The current Champion USA begins its journey in search of the back-to-back and a 7th GC trophy.
- ★ The United States will be in its 15th Gold Cup (along with Mexico, they are the ones that have participated in all the editions of the tournament).
- ★ Guyana will have its debut in the Gold Cup, along with fellow Caribbean side Bermuda.
- ★ USA is the 2nd highest Gold Cup winner all-time. Champions in 6 editions ('91, '02, '05, '07, '13, '17). Also won the Subchampionship four times ('93, '98, '09 and '11), twice the 3rd place ('96 and '03) and once the 4th place (2015).
- ★ USA will play its 74th Gold Cup game. Record is 73 MP: 56W-9D-8L (147GF-53GC), an 81% efficiency, the highest percentage in the history of the competition.
- ★ The road to the 2019 Gold Cup of the USA: 5th place in the CONCACAF Hexagonal (12 pts). Record: 10 MP: 3W-3D-4L (17GF-13GC). Top Scorers: Christian Pulisic - Overall scorer - (5), Clint Dempsey (4) and Bobby Wood (3). (The U.S. did not qualify for Russia 2018.)

- ★ The road to the GUY Gold Cup 2019: 7th place in CNLQ 2018-19 (9 pts). 4 MP: 3W-1L (14GF-3GC). Top Scorers: Emery Welshman (4), Sheldon Holder (3) and Neil Danns (2).
- ★ United States is the team with the most games (73) and wins (56) in the history of the Gold Cup.
- ★ Landon Donovan is the USA's top scorer in Gold Cup history (18 goals). In addition he is the player with the most appearances in GC (34 MP). Clint Dempsey follows him in the goals department (13 goals in 24 MP).
- ★ Currently, Jozy Altidore is the USA player with the most goals in the Gold Cup (4). Michael Bradley has the most games in GC (20) and has 3 goals.
- ★ USA is the team that scored the most goals from minute 0 to 15 (16) and 45-60 (29) in the history of the Gold Cup.
- ★ USA won its last 5 GC games: 3-2 to Martinique (Omar Gonzalez, Jordan Morris x2, Parsemain x2), 3-0 to Nicaragua (Joe Corona, Kelyn Rowe and Matt Miazga), 2-0 to El Salvador in QF (Omar González and Eric Lichaj), 2-0 to Costa Rica in SF (Jozy Altidore and Clint Dempsey) and 2-1 to Jamaica in the Final (Jozy Altidore and Jordan Morris, Je Watson).
- ★ USA has an unbeaten 7 Gold Cup games (5G-2E). The last loss was on 25 JUL 2015, 2-1 vs. Jamaica in SF 2015 in Atlanta (Michael Bradley, Darren Mattocks and Giles Barnes).
- ★ USA will play its 38th GC group phase game. 37 MP: 32W-4D-1L (80GF-20GC), a 90.1% success rate. The only loss was 1-2 PAN in Group C of USA 2011 (Clarence Goodson, Clarence Goodson -OG- and Gabriel Gómez).
- ★ USA has played 21 matches vs. Caribbean rivals in GC: 19W-1D-1L (55GF-13GC, a 90.5% victory rate. Their only loss was 2-1 vs. Jamaica in SF 2015.
- ★ 65% of US players currently play in MLS. The rest is shared between the leagues of Germany, England, Turkey and Mexico.
- ★ From the current USA list, 9 players go for the GC Back-to-Back Wins: Michael Bradley, Jozy Altidore, Matthew Miazga, Cristian Roldan, Paul Arriola, Gyasi



Zardes, Sean Johnson, Omar González y Jordan Morris. Tim Ream is the only player to have played in Gold Cup without winning the title (2011 and 2015).

- ★ Gregg Berhalter (USA), US coach, was hired in December 2018. Total Record: 6 MP: 3W-1D-2L (55.5% efficiency). As a footballer, he played 44 matches for the national team and was runner-up in the 1998 Gold Cup (1 He also played in the Korea & Japan 2002 and Germany 2006 World Cups).
- ★ Michael Johnson (JAM), Manager of GUY, coaching since June 2018. Record: 5 MP: 3W-2L (60% efficiency). As a footballer, he played 13 games with the Jamaica National Team, including 4 Gold Cup games (in the 2000 and 2003 editions).
- ★ Jozy Altidore (USA) scored 2 goals in GC 2017 (SF vs. CRC and Final vs. JAM). He is set to complete 10 MP in Gold Cup (4th participation).
- ★ Emery Welshman (GUY) was the top scorer for Guyana in CONCACAF Nations League Qualifiers 2018-19 (4 goals). He scored a hat-trick against Turks and Caicos Islands in the 8-0 W in Round 2 of CNLQ 2018-19.
- ★ Christian Pulisic (USA) was the top scorer of the CONCACAF Hexagonal Russia 2018 (5 goals). He will be making his debut in the Gold Cup.
- ★ Neil Danns (GUY), 36 years and 7 months old, is the most experienced player of the current Guyana squad. He scored 3 goals in 3 games of CNLQ 2018-19 (vs. Barbados, French Guiana and Belize).
- ★ Weston McKennie (USA) of Schalke 04 of Germany, is the youngest of the United States squad (20 years and 10 months).
- ★ Stephen Duke-McKenna (GUY) is the youngest player on the Guyana team (18 years and 10 months).
- ★ Sheldon Holder (GUY) was the only player for Guyana who played all matches in CNLQ 2018-19 (4 PJ). In addition, he was one of the scorers, netting 3 goals vs. Turks and Caicos Islands.
- ★ Matthew Miazga (USA), defender of Chelsea FC (ENG), scored 1 goal in Gold Cup after playing 1 game in 2017: vs. NCA (R3 of Group B).



★ Jordan Morris (USA) scored 3 goals in 6 Gold Cup games (in victories vs. Martinique and the tournament winner against Jamaica). He was the player who played the most matches in Gold Cup 2017 (6).

★ Omar González (USA) was the player who played the most minutes for the USA in the last edition of the Gold Cup (477 ').

PLAYER TO WATCH



MICHAEL BRADLEY

USA

MF - Toronto FC (CAN)

31 years 11 months

- ★ He was crowned Gold Cup Champion in the 2007 and 2017 United States editions. He also was runner-up in 2011.
- ★ He completed 287 minutes in the last edition of the Gold Cup.
- ★ At 31 years and 11 months, he is the most experienced player in the United States. His debut was in 2006 against Venezuela, in an International Friendly.
- ★ He played in the World Cups of South Africa 2010 and Brazil 2014.
- ★ It will be his 5th Gold Cup. He previously participated in the 2007 (5 MP), 2011 (6 MP), 2015 (6 MP) and 2017 (3 MP) editions. He registers 20 MP in GC, 3 goals (Mexico, Panama and Jamaica) and 5 assists.
- ★ With the National Team he has played 145 games and scored 17 goals. His last 2 goals were in CONCACAF Russia 2018 Qualifiers (in 2017 vs. Honduras and Mexico).
- ★ He was part of the youth national teams of the United States. From 2002 to 2004 he played for the U17; in 2004 the Sub 18; between 2004 and 2007 he was part of the Sub 20 and in 2008 the Sub 23 at the Beijing Olympic Games.
- ★ At the club level, he was the winner of MLS Cup (2017) and the Canadian Championship (2016, 2017 and 2018), with Toronto FC.
- ★ 192 career games in MLS and 12 goals between MetroStars and Toronto FC. He also played in Holland (Heerenveen), Germany (Borussia Monchengladbach), England (Aston Villa) and Italy (Chievo Verona and Rome).
