## Bidding process for the FIFA Women's World Cup 2023™

Dear Sir or Madam,

We are pleased to invite you to express your interest in submitting a bid to FIFA to host the final competition of the FIFA Women's World Cup 2023<sup>TM</sup>.

### **Expression of interest form**

In order to participate in the bidding process for the hosting of the FIFA Women's World Cup 2023™, please complete and duly execute the attached expression of interest form and submit it to FIFA by 17:00 CET (Central European Time) on 15 March 2019.

The completed expression of interest form must be submitted to FIFA by email, marked for the attention of the FIFA Bidding Team, to the following address: 2023wwcbid@fifa.org.

For joint bids, each member association interested in participating in the bid must return an individually executed expression of interest form, naming the other member association(s) involved in the bid.

#### Timeline for the bidding process

All relevant information about the bidding process will be given in the bidding registration, which will be provided by FIFA to the member associations that submit the completed expression of interest form. An overview of some of the key deadlines in the bidding process is provided below:

15 March 2019	Deadline to submit the completed expression of interest form to FIFA		
18 March 2019	FIFA to dispatch the bidding registration and overview document		
16 April 2019	Deadline to submit the completed bidding registration to FIFA		
18 April 2019	FIFA to dispatch hosting documents to the member associations that have returned the bidding registration by the above deadline		
4 October 2019	Submission of the bid book, the signed hosting agreement and all other hosting documents to FIFA		
March 2020	Expected appointment date of the host(s) by the FIFA Council

### Key hosting requirements

Member associations that have submitted the completed bidding registration to FIFA will be informed of the detailed hosting requirements for all operational areas in April 2019. However, for guidance purposes, an overview document providing a high-level description of key hosting requirements to be fulfilled by the member association(s) appointed to host and stage the FIFA Women's World Cup 2023<sup>TM</sup> will be shared together with the bidding registration in order to give interested member associations the opportunity to assess the feasibility of a potential bid.

#### **Next steps**

FIFA will dispatch the bidding registration and overview document to the interested member associations by 18 March 2019.

Please note that all documents provided by FIFA to the member associations in relation to the bidding process will be in English. FIFA will not provide translations and will not accept the submission of any such documents in any other language.
