About us

Habra Municipality is situated within Habra Police Station under Barasat Sub-Division in the district of North 24–Parganas of West Bengal. It was established in 1979 with a Government nominated Board. Initially nineteen wards were carved out of Panchayet areas to make way for the Municipality. The mouzas included with it are Habra, Kamarthuba, Joygachi, Hatthuba, Kamarthuba, Ashrafabad Hijalpukur, Nagarthuba, Haria and Akrampur. At that time population of Habra Municipality was 72,500 approx. Later, three more mouzas viz. Ayra, Belgoria and Daharthuba included out of panchayat areas. Currently this Municipality has an area of 21.82 sq. km and population as per census 2011 is 1,47,221.

The town 'Habra 'is medium in size having a settlement of massive influx of displaced persons since partition of India & Pakistan caused it to emerge out as a town and started agriculture, fisheries, small scale household industries and trading for their livelihood and day by day they built up their socio-economic status which imparted the rural area into urban in character.

Geographically the town has well-connection with its Linkage and Communication with the state capital, Kolkata and other important town that helps it to emerge as a good market centre and a vibrant town nearby to Kolkata which encourage people to migrate as well as causes overcrowd in the town.

As a result it is a great challenge to this Municipality to accommodate and place these migrated people mostly in slum populated areas in good service and better governance. The aim and object of this Municipality is now to up lift the socio-economic status of the poor people mostly in slum areas and acquaint them with the sphere of modernization in all respect and at par with other citizen in the Town.

Municipal Vision

Whenever this Municipality thinks of development, it does so in terms of improvement in the Livelihood quality of the people especially the weaker section of the population who can really test the fruits of urban developments. The areas where this municipality will focus are: clean and green environment, Improvement of Health, safe drinking water, spread of education and cultural activities, games and sports, improvement of inter ward communication, street and street lighting, drainage system, creation of employment opportunity and development of efficient administration and financial management.

National Urban Livelihood Mission (NULM)

National Urban Livelihood Mission (NULM) is a Centrally sponsored scheme to reduce poverty and vulnerability of the urban poor households by enabling them to access gainful self employment and skilled wage employment opportunities, resulting in an appreciable improvement in their livelihoods on a sustainable basis, through building strong grassroots level institutions of the poor. The mission would aim at providing shelters equipped with essential services to the urban homeless in a phased manner. In addition, the mission would also address livelihood concerns of the urban street vendors by facilitating access to suitable spaces, institutional credit, social security and skills to the urban street vendors for accessing emerging market opportunities.

An additional 275 candidates has been approved for further training in various trades.

NULM—SUH: Under NULM, Shelter for Urban Homeless a vacant land has been identified near Banipur Ward No. 22 to provide shelter to Urban Poor who does not have a proper shelter (e.g. pavement dwellers)

NULM—SEP: Under NULM, Self Employment Programme a Financial Literacy Camp has been held to financially literate SHG members on how to avail various loan for upliftment of their groups and individual self.

NULM—SMID: Under NULM, Social Mobilization and Institution Development a total of 163 SHG groups and 29 ALF has been created.

Atal Mission for Rejuvenation & Urban Transformation (AMRUT)

AMRUT is a centrally assisted project for providing basic services (e.g. water supply, sewerage, urban transport) to households and build amenities in cities which will improve the quality of life for all.

Water Supply-

The proposed water supply scheme covers entire Habra municipal area utilizing surface water as source from River Bhagirathi and newly laid Rising mains and Distribution network with proposal of six new Over Head Reservoir in six zones. Proposed water supply network covers all the wards through house connections. The intake point is designed for total demand for Habra for intermediate projected year at a point adjacent to Naihati having separate treatment plant. A total amount of Rs 110 crore has been sanction for water supply project.

- Work Order for Supplying D.I Pipes (Class-K7) has been issued to suppliers.
- E-Tender for construction of 6 Nos. Over Head Reservoirs has been invited.

Parks-



Banabithi Park

Habra Municipality has received an amount of Rs 11.88 Lakhs (50% of total fund) for the year 2015-16 for up-gradation of "Banabithi Park" to restore Green space for rejuvenation involving creation & up gradation of basic elements which will help to permissible and equitable physical & mental status especially for youth, children and also for elderly person.

 Work Order for Construction of 2 Nos. of Umbrellas and beautification of Banabithi Park has been issued and work is under progress.

Prime Minister Awas Yojana—Housing for All by 2022

Hon'ble Prime Minister envisioned Housing for All by 2022 when the Nation completes 75 years of its Independence. In order to achieve this objective, Central Government has launched a comprehensive mission "Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana–Housing for All (Urban)". The mission seeks to address the housing requirement of urban poor including slum dwellers through following programme verticals: • Slum rehabilitation of Slum Dwellers with participation of private developers using land as a resource • Promotion of Affordable Housing for weaker section through credit linked subsidy • Affordable Housing in Partnership with Public & Private sectors • Subsidy for beneficiary-led individual house construction /enhancement.

Habra Municipality has conducted a need assessment survey and submitted a proposal to State Government for approval and sanction of necessary fund.

- A total No. of 1621 beneficiaries has been identified for the Year 2015-16, out of which dedicated Bank Accounts for 1310 beneficiaries has been opened at Punjab National Bank, Habra Bazar Branch.

Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM)

SBM (Urban) aims to ensure that-

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a) No households engage in the practice of open defecation,

b) No new insanitary toilets are constructed during the mission period and

c) Pit latrines are converted to sanitary latrines.

Under SBM, Habra Municipality is constructing 1768 Nos. of Sanitary Latrines, out of which work started for 1200 Nos. and 196 Nos. have been completed.
