

Bandipora-Gurez road opens for traffic after 3 days

Bandipora, Nov 16: Bandipora-Gurez road was reopened for vehicular traffic after remaining closed for three days following heavy snowfall on Razdan Pass.

An official said the road was thrown open for the traffic after it was cleared of snow.

The 84km road was closed for the second time on Nov 13 after Razdan Pass witnessed heavy snowfall.

Locals from the villages and areas adjoining had complained that the frequent closure of the road had been affecting their daily lives and rendering them cut off from rest of the Valley.

They had appealed the authorities to expedite the work of clearing the road.

Meanwhile, deputy commissioner Bandipora, Dr. Shahid Iqbal Choudhary in a tweet said, "Gurez road open. Use of snow chains is mandatory."

Srinagar-Kargil road to open today

Ganderbal, Nov 16: The Srinagar-Kargil highway is likely to be opened for one-way traffic on Saturday, four days after heavy snowfall on Zojila Pass had led to its closure.

An official of Project Beacon that maintains the road to Ladakh, said snow clearance work was almost completed on Friday evening.

Muzafar Ahmed Shah, the in-charge superintendent of police for traffic, said if weather remained dry, the traffic would be allowed from Kargil towards Sonamarg on Saturday.

"There are some vehicles stranded on Kargil side and they would be allowed on Saturday. If possible after clearing Kargil traffic, vehicles from Sonamarg side will also be allowed," Shah told Greater Kashmir.

Security situation in J&K stable but fragile: Lt Gen Ranbir Singh

Udhampur, Nov 16: Lieutenant General Ranbir Singh, General Officer Commanding-in-Chief Northern Command, on Friday said that "hinterland security situation" in Jammu and Kashmir is stable but fragile because any trigger can cause disturbance.

He was speaking to the media on the sidelines of a function organised to felicitate teachers of Army Goodwill Schools in Udhampur.

The commander said "it is a matter of great satisfaction" that fewer youths have been joining militant outfits for the past some time.

The army commander said Army goodwill schools have made a positive impact on the society and children in Jammu and Kashmir. "I would like to assure you that army goodwill schools acted as a catalyst that no radicaliza-



tion is allowed to take place and no reports suggest any goodwill school student drifting towards radicalization," he said. The commander awarded 24 teachers of AGSs for their innovative skills in teaching.

The schools were started in 1998 and currently the Northern Command runs 45 such schools under Project Sadbhavana. As many as 15,000 students study in these schools that also employ 1,000 teaching and non-teaching staff.

LOC SITUATION
Lt Gen Ranbir Singh said, "There have been snipping incidents across the Line of Control and we have been protesting with our Pakistani counterparts. And wherever

Pakistan has violated the ceasefire we give them befitting reply because the message to the troops on ground is very clear that if Pakistan does not stop any activity, it should be punished accordingly."

PANCHAYAT POLLS
He said adequate security measures have been taken for the elections beginning on Saturday. "We are very sure that we have a secure environment and people are able to come and participate in polls," he said.

DECLINE IN TREND OF YOUTH JOINING MILITANT GROUPS

Lt Gen Ranbir Singh said there is a relative decline in the number of youths joining militant groups in Kashmir for the past some time.

"As far as recruitment is concerned, it is a matter of satisfaction that for the past some time there has been a relative decline in the number of youths joining militancy," he said but did not specify the time period.

"There have been a large number of reports of radicalisation of youths," he added.

2 boys detained during night raid in Lolab, locals protest

Kupwara, Nov 16: Government forces detained two boys during the night intervening Thursday/Friday in Sever Thandipora area of Lolab in north Kashmir's Kupwara district.

Locals said the government forces raided several houses during late night hours in Sever Lolab and detained two boys from the area.

Locals said they took out a protest on Friday in Sever demanding release of the two boys.

The protesters said the duo is not involved in any kind of subversive activity.

The arrested boys were identified as Abass Shafi Malla son of Mohammad Shafi Malla and Ishfaq

Ahmad Malla son of Ghulam Mohammad Malla both residents of Sever Thandipora area of Lolab of Kupwara.

Locals of the area blocked Kupwara-Warnow road for hours to register their protest.

Locals alleged the security forces vandalized private properties in the area. "They beat our children, broke the doors and windows of our houses and abused us," said a female protester.

She said, "We appeal to the higher authorities to look into the matter."

Meanwhile, the SDM Lolab reached the spot and assured the protesters that he had take up the matter with the higher ups of administration.

Despite repeated attempts, SSP Kupwara Ram Ambarkar couldn't be contacted.

JKJCCPS welcomes withdrawal of circular

Srinagar, Nov 16: J&K Joint Coordination Committee of Private Schools (JKJCCPS) has welcomed withdrawal of circular asking private schools not to issue results and marks/discharge certificates to the students unless they produced approval of the fee structure by Fee Fixation Committee.

President JKJCCPS Showkat Chowdhary thanked chairman Fee Fixation Committee Justice Imtiyaz Hussain and director School Education Dr G N Itoo "for agreeing to requests the Coordination Committee in this regard".

Notably, a Chowdhary-led delegation had met chairman FFC and DSEK separately and apprising them about the "unjust" circular issued by CEOs preventing private schools from issuing results, marks/discharge certificates.

Candidates appeal KVIB authorities

Srinagar, Nov 16: Aspirants for the post of junior supervisor in Khadi Village Industries Board have urged the authorities to finalize the selection list.

A delegation of the aspirants said the posts were advertised in 2016, and despite lapse of two years, the KVIB is yet to finalise the list.

"While the board has finalised the selection list for other posts, we fail to understand why they have not issued selection list of junior supervisors," they said, adding that the delay in completing the recruitment process is causing mental agony to the aspirants.

"Thirty three posts of junior supervisor were advertised. We applied for these posts and submitted all required documents in a prescribed form. Since then, we are waiting for completion of process," they said.

They appealed the KVIB higher ups for the intervention. Javid Anjum Mir, deputy chief executive officer KVIB said that some candidates have got stay over these posts from the court.

"We have submitted the objections in the court. We are waiting for the decision and will take further course of action after that," he said.

Chhewang quit politics for spiritualism: Ravinder Raina

Jammu, Nov 16: BJP state president Ravinder Raina Friday said that party MP from Ladakh constituency, Thupstan Chhewang has not only resigned from the BJP but also left the active politics to "take the path of spirituality".

Addressing media men here, Raina said, "Chhewang had been writing letters to national leaders for the past around one year expressing his willingness to quit the active politics to take the path of spiritualism. Recently, I also got one such letter, but I along with other

party leaders was requesting him to defer his decision until 2019."

"Recently through another letter, he mentioned about his ailing health. So, he took this decision (resignation from BJP) in view of his bad health and his plan to join spiritualism," said the BJP state president.

Raina said, "Let me also make it very clear that Thupstan Chhewang will not join any other party."

The veteran Ladakhi politician resigned from BJP on Thursday. Chhewang has also made it clear that he is also renouncing his seat in the Parliament.

Chhewang had won the BJP its first ever parliamentary seat in Ladakh and also managed to secure a majority for the saffron party in the important Ladakh Autonomous Hill Development Council (LAHDC), Leh.

Chhewang's jolt to the BJP comes just few months ahead of the next Lok Sabha elections.

Earlier, Dorjey Motup, Chief Executive Councillor (CEC) of Leh's LAHDC resigned from the post and the BJP.

Both top BJP leaders from Ladakh cited health reasons for their departure from the party.
