## Candidates appeal KVIB authorities

Srinagar. Nov 16: Aspirants for the post of junior supervisor in Khadi Village Industries Board have urged the authorities to finalize the selection list.

A delegation of the aspirants said the posts were advertised in 2016, and despite lapse of two years, the KVIB is yet to finalise the list.

"While the board has finalised the selection list for other posts, we fail to understand why they have not issued selection list of junior supervisors," they said, adding that the delay in completing the recruitment process is causing mental agony to the aspirants.
