#### INTRODUCTION

- (1) This summary of the results of the various Parliamentary By-Elections in Northern Ireland on 23 January 1986 was compiled from information provided by and returns made by the Deputy Leturning Officers for the fifteen constituencies involved. Their names and the addresses of their principal offices for the purposes of the election are given on page 2.
- (2) On pages 4 to 18 the candidates descriptions given are those contained in the candidates nomination forms.
- (3) The electorate figures given are the actual numbers of persons entitled to vote on 23 January 1986.
- (4) + before the name of a candidate indicates a member of the previous Parliament.
- (5) \* before the name of a candidate indicates a forfeited deposit.
- (6) Percentages where given are rounded up or down to the first decimal place.
- (7) Averages where given are rounded to the nearest whole figure.
- (8) The total number of candidates was forty-one.
- (9) Fifteen of the candidates standing were members of the previous Parliament.
- (10) Fourteen of the successful candidates were members of the previous Parliament.
- (11) Seven candidates forfeited their deposits.
