Note A. Percentages are based on the number of U.S. citizens or immigrants who report race/ethnicity. Excludes non-resident alien and non-reporting.

Note B. Race/Ethnicity is based on students' voluntary self-report.

Note C. Numbers include students enrolled in programs administered by Continuing and Professional Education (CPE), including off-campus and on-line programs.

Note D. In 2010 federal race/ethnicity standards changed, allowing individuals to specify more than one race, as well as splitting, renaming and adding categories.

Because of these changes, data from fall 2010 forward are not comparable to previous years.

Note E. URM (Underrepresented Minority) includes American Indian/Alaska Native, Black/African American, Hawaiian/Pacific Islander, Hispanic/Latino, and those who declared multiple race/ethnicities (except Asian and White).
