Australia established diplomatic relations with Armenia in 1992. Australia and Armenia share friendly relations, underpinned by strong people-to-people links, and engage on issues of mutual interest in international organisations.

### Foreign policy

Armenia's foreign policy priorities include a settlement of the Nagorno-Karabakh issue, strengthening its relationship with its neighbour, Russia, deepening partnership and cooperation with the United States and integration with Europe.

Armenia is a member of a range of international organisations, including the United Nations, the World Trade Organization, the Council of Europe and the Organisation for Security and Cooperation in Europe, the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development, the World Bank, the Asian Development Bank and the Organisation of the Black Sea Economic Cooperation. It is a member of the Commonwealth of Independent States, the Eurasian Economic Union and the Collective Security Treaty Organisation. It has also joined NATO's Partnership for Peace and the European Union's Eastern Partnership Initiative.
