PRESIDENT + EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014

Fiscal year 2014 was filled with many triumphs. Topping the list, are the nearly 400 artists who were nurtured and sustained by VCCA. Toiling away in our studios, they created work that enhances not only their lives and their audiences, but culture itself. We delight in their many stellar accomplishments. Here is a sampling of them:

- Helen Benedict was named a finalist for the Trust Women Journalist Award, recognizing a journalist who has made a significant contribution to the coverage of women's rights.
- Sandra Gibson and Luis Recoder's *Topsy-Turvy: A Camera Obscura Installation* was unveiled in New York's Madison Square Park by the park's conservancy's: Mad. Sq. Art. The piece was reimaged and reinstalled across the East River in Brooklyn Bridge Park the following fall.
- *Coming to Know What We've Always Known*, the beautiful installation by poet Sally Dawidoff and visual artist Georgia June Goldberg, ran the length of the front lawn of the historic main house at Morven Farm as the commissioned centerpiece of the 2nd annual VCCA fundraiser, *The Commission*. Over 225 patrons were on hand for the unveiling.
- Holen Sabrina Kahn's highly acclaimed film *A Quiet Inquisition* had its premiere screening at the Human Rights Watch International Film Festival, Walter Reade Theater, Lincoln Center, New York, NY. The film has been shown internationally and it won the Vaclav Havel Jury Award at the ONEWORLD International Human Rights Film Festival in Prague.
- In its sixth year, the Etchings Festival, hosted by VCCA and the East Coast Contemporary Ensemble (ECCE), in Auvillar, France, featured guest composer Beat Furrer and guest artist Garth Knox. The Etchings Festival was created by Fellow John Aylward.
- Florence Carbonne the 2013 recipient of VCCA's Prix Moulin à Nef, a competitive fellowship offered to French artists from the Midi-Pyrénées and Aquitaine regions, was featured at Riverviews Artspace during her residency at VCCA.
- Alan Berliner's *First Cousin Once Removed* documenting the decline and death of poet scholar and Fellow Edwin Honig was featured at the Virginia Film Festival followed by VCCA hosted panel discussion. The film received the Grand Prize for Best Documentary Feature at the International Documentary Film Festival in Amsterdam.
- The Alonzo Davis Endowment for Fellowships supporting American artists of Latino descent and African descent and named in honor of Fellow Alonzo Davis reached its goal of \$100,000 in January 2014.

In FY2014 an anonymous donor made it possible for VCCA to purchase the Maison Vieillescazes for Fellows in residence at the Moulin à Nef, VCCA's flagship residency program in Auvillar, France.

During this time period, we bid adieu to two highly valued staff members: Artistic Director Craig Pleasants and Director of Communications Lexie Boris. An acclaimed sculptor, Craig first came to work at VCCA in October, 1989. He and his wife

Sheila Gulley Pleasants (VCCA's Director of Artists' Services), raised three daughters in the Studio Barn apartment where they lived for 17 years, before moving off the property in 2006. Since stepping down from VCCA, Craig has been devoting himself to his artistic practice and to Sculptorhouse.com, an art and design venture he started several years ago that produces a kit house, the OLU or Octagonal Living Unit.

Lexie brought her considerable taste, graphic design skills and marketing savvy to VCCA. She is now Advancement Director at Piedmont Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA), which provides trained volunteers to advocate for the best interests of abused and neglected children in Charlottesville.

In June 2014, we hired Sarah Sargent as the Director of Communications and Grants Management. The former director of Second Street Gallery, a nationally recognized nonprofit contemporary art space, Sarah brings her enthusiasm for the creative energy fostered by VCCA and her skills as an arts administrator, writer and curator to the position.

As we reflect on 2014, we cannot help but think of all the people—many, extended members of the VCCA Family—adversely affected in this current year (FY2015) by the announced closure of Sweet Briar College. We have shared a wonderfully genial and mutually rewarding relationship with Sweet Briar for 37 years and we were saddened at the prospect of its closing. With the recent announcement of the college's plan to remain open, we wish them every success!

We know the future for VCCA will be every bit as inspiring and fruitful as the ones that preceded it. We thank everyone who has who has made VCCA's journey thus far possible and look to you for your continued support as we forge full steam ahead!

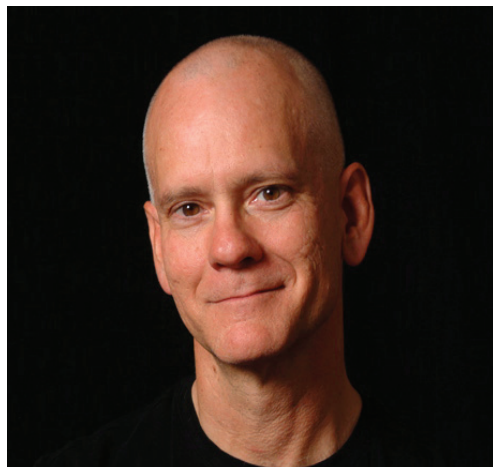
It would be impossible to include all the 397 amazing Fellows who passed through our doors in fiscal year 2014. Following are three VCCA Fellows (one from each of the disciplines we support) who were in residence at Mt. San Angelo between July 1, 2013 and June 30, 2014. They represent just a sampling of the incredible creativity and talent that is nurtured at VCCA. They are: writer Joyce Maynard (Oakland, CA), composer Eric Moe (Pittsburgh, PA) and visual artist, David Fludd, (New York, NY),

Joyce Maynard has been a reporter and columnist for *The New York Times*, a syndicated newspaper columnist, a regular contributor to NPR and national magazines, and a performer with *The Moth*. Maynard's essays have appeared in numerous collections, most recently *The Best of the Moth*. Her books include the novel *To Die For*, made into a motion picture, the memoir, *At Home in the World*, translated into fifteen languages, and the award winning novels *The Cloud Chamber* and *The Usual Rules*, among others. Her novel *Labor Day* was recently adapted for a film, directed by Jason Reitman. Her most recent novel, *After Her*—a portion of which was written at VCCA—was published in fall, 2013. *Under the Influence* to be published in 2016 was begun at VCCA. She is founder of the annual Lake Atitlan (Guatemala) Writers' Workshop.



“On three different occasions, when I found myself at a creative standstill, I was lucky enough to be granted a residency at VCCA (all

three times, on very short notice), says Maynard. “Each trip to Virginia provided what I had needed and longed for: a quiet, unobstructed space (not only the physical space, but the emotional one too) to focus on my work. I will always be grateful to VCCA and the VCCA community for making this possible.”

Eric Moe composes what *The New York Times* calls “music of winning exuberance.” He has received numerous grants and awards for his work, including the Lakond Award from the American Academy of Arts and Letters and a Guggenheim Fellowship; commissions from the Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra, the Fromm Foundation, the Koussevitzky Foundation, the Barlow Endowment, and Meet-the-Composer USA. In addition to VCCA, Moe has had residencies at the MacDowell Colony, Yaddo, Bellagio and the Camargo Foundation. Released in 2009 by Naxos, *Strange Exclaiming Music*, a CD of Moe's

chamber music, was described by *Fanfare* magazine as “wonderful inventive, often joyful, occasionally melancholy, highly rhythmic, frequently irreverent, absolutely eclectic, and always high-octane music.” Moe's “sit-trag” (situation tragedy) one-woman opera *Tri-Stan*, available on a Koch International Classics CD, was greeted by *The New York Times* as “a tour de force” that “subversively inscribes classical music into pop culture”. *Kick & Ride*, on the bmop/sound label, was picked by WQXR for album of the week: “...it's completely easy to succumb to the beats and rhythms that come out of Moe's fantastical imaginarium, a headspace that ties together the free-flowing atonality of Alban Berg with the guttural rumblings of Samuel Barber's *Medea*, adding in a healthy dose of superhuman strength”. Other all-Moe CDs are available on New World.

“In May 2014, I was struggling with a commission from Music From China, an ensemble that mixes traditional Chinese instruments with Western ones,” says Moe “I was having particular difficulty coming up with an overarching concept for the piece until I had a transformative conversation with VCCA Artist-in-Residence Barbara Bernstein, who lent me her copy of an 11th century treatise on Chinese landscape painting. Suddenly unlocked, with the metaphor of a horizontal Chinese landscape scroll firmly planted and flowering, I went on to compose *A Panoramic Guide To Glacier Travel*, which premiered in Weill Hall, New York and the Freer Gallery in Washington D.C. last fall. Only in a residency program like VCCA's are such magical things possible...” ericmoe.net

David Fludd has won a John Guggenheim Memorial Fellowship and a Rome Prize for Painting. He has also been an Artist-in-Residence at the Studio Museum in Harlem. Recently, he had a solo exhibition of works on paper at the Hatch-Billops Collection in New York City.

Fludd's paintings feature bold color, staccato pattern and dynamic composition. There's a fierce energy in these works that blends a narrative that seems inspired by fables and folk tales with sophisticated formal technique. Fludd works slowly, building up his surfaces with many layers of paint adding texture and depth. This gives him time to consider his canvases allowing him to balance an exuberant visual language and create rhythmically charged works of great power.

“VCCA is an inspiring place,” says Fludd. “I was productive. There were thought provoking events. Having the space and time in such a scenic and positive environment was ideal for focusing on the art and exploring the creative process.” dfludd.weebly.com
