## Executive Exits At ASCAP, BMI, SESAC Point To Renewed Optimism In Publishing

When, on Sept. 23, SESAC vp creative services **Shannan Hatch** announced her departure to become president of Fourward Music, she completed an unprecedented trifecta among performing rights organizations in Nashville.

All three PROs — SESAC, ASCAP and BMI — have now lost their top writer/publisher executives since the start of summer, creating turnover in one of the key segments of the city's music industry. The personnel changes

this month to segue out of his post at the end of the year and form a new publishing company. Williams expects to found a co-venture with a to-be-determined major firm once his 13-year tenure at BMI is completed.



All three pursuits represent investment in the copyright business, now on the upswing after the transition to digital distribution ravaged publishing. The loss of album tracks gutted mechanical royalties, reducing the number


of songwriters in town. Those composers who remained increasingly saw revenue come from streaming platforms, where micropayments demoralized many in the creative sector.

But the 2018 passage of the Music Modernization Actinstalled new rules that improve streaming rates, while increases in other revenue sources — including synch licensing, commercial use and gaming — have led to rosier expectations. For Nashville, heightened collaboration with other formats provides additional reason for optimism, and the PROs are a logical place for publishing investors to find executive talent.

"We know the climate, we know everybody who's anybody in the business and have a good Rolodex," says Williams.

Music publishing is a tricky endeavor. Most songs never get recorded, and those that reach the marketplace typically don't start paying royalties for 2-4 years, given the time lag of

recording the song, promoting it and waiting for quarterly royalty payments.

Additionally, weeding through the thousands of hopeful songwriters in Nashville to find the best bets for success in a subjective business is difficult. Thus, publishers are tasked with balancing patience and motivation on their teams, creating what Martin calls a "culture of creative hope."

"When somebody knows that you trust them, they don't pull further away, they come closer to you," he says. "That's, I think, the mystique of managing creative people. Once you develop the trust with each other, it's like a coach and an athlete. It creates an amazing friendship and relationship."

Each PRO works with most multiwriter publishing companies, so the awards season in November focuses on the agencies' relationships in Nashville. All three execs were sensitive to those relationships when planning their transitions. Hatch and Williams timed their departures to smooth the awards process, and Martin—who was succeeded by ASCAP Nashville vp membership <code>Mike Sistad</code>—recently celebrated with his former colleagues when ASCAP held its Christian honors.

"After 17 years at a company, it's a part of my family," says Hatch of her SESAC experience. "My relationships over there will remain intact for a long time, and I'm glad about that. So I'm leaving them on a really good note with a very strong system and really great people in place. There's comfort in that."

There's excitement ahead too. A recent Goldman Sachs study predicted that the music business will grow from a \$62 billion industry in 2017 to a \$131 billion one in 2030. The publishing sector's revenue is likely to balloon from \$6 billion a year to \$12.5 billion, which means it's an advantageous time for new players.

Williams and Martin, who were both publishing execs prior to their PRO experience, are returning with experienced publishing partners. Hatch, who received a big-picture view of publishing at SESAC after starting her career in public relations, was lured to Fourward by **Will Ward**, who previously managed **Zac Brown**. Fourward has its fingers in a range of entertainment pots, including pop music, film, TV and even a fitness app. With publishing looking at a more stable future, that kind of synergy intrigued Hatch.

"It's not the Wild, Wild West like it used to be," she says. "There are just so many great opportunities going forward."

The digital transition that decimated publishing has also provided it with new tools. Publishers and managers now have the ability to serve as indie labels—to finance recordings and coax streaming and satellite play for their clients. Since the PROs are often the first place that new writers and artists go when they arrive in Nashville, writer/publisher-relations execs are perfectly suited to launch Nashville's new publishing entities, develop the most promising new creators and connect them to key mediums of exposure.

"My team did identify talent early on, before everybody knows about it," says Martin. "That's just what we do."

As they move into the next phase in their careers, the three ASCAP, SESAC and BMI pros have the opportunity to expand on that skill by jumping into their new publishing positions.

"The climate is better than it was just a few years ago," says Williams. "If you were ever going to do it, now would be the time."



## Zac Brown Band's *Owl* Perches Atop Top Country Albums, Chris Lane All 'About' No. 1 On Country Airplay

**ZAC BROWN BAND** 



**Zac Brown Band** earns its fifth No.1 on *Billboard*'s Top Country Albums chart, as *The Owl* (ZB Collective/BMG) flies in atop the Oct.5-dated tally with 106,000 equivalent album units (99,000 in album sales) in its opening week, ending Sept. 26, according to Nielsen Music.

On the all-genre Billboard 200, *The Owl* arrives at No. 2, awarding the act its sixth top 10.

ZBB's sixth full-length, and first via BMG, includes collaborations with EDM DJ Skrillex and pop talents Benny Blanco, Jason "Poo Bear" Boyd, Max Martin, Shawn Mendes, Ryan Tedder and Andrew Watt, among others. Meanwhile, the track "Finish What We Started" features singer-songwriter Brandi Carlile. (Some of the names above also worked on Brown's surprise solo set *The Controversy*, released Sept. 27.)

All five of the band's Top Country Albums No. 1s have launched at the summit. Before *The Owl, Welcome Home* debuted atop the tally dated

June 3, 2017, with 146,000 equivalent album units (139,000 in album sales); *Jekyll + Hyde* bowed on May 16, 2015, with 214,000 sold; *Uncaged* arrived on July 28, 2012, with 234,000 sold; and *You Get What You Give* opened on Oct. 9, 2010, with 153,000 sold.

The outfit's breakthrough LP, *The Foundation*, started at No. 3 on Dec. 6, 2008, and rose to its No. 2 peak the following March.

The Owl's lead single, "Someone I Used to Know" (ZB Collective/BMG/Wheelhouse), ranks at No. 23 on the airplay-, streaming- and sales-fueled Hot Country Songs chart and No. 31 on Country Airplay.

LANE LEADS Chris Lane notches his second Country Airplay No. 1 as "I Don't Know About You" (Big Loud) ascends 2-1 in its 45th week on the survey, up 11% to 38.7 million audience impressions in the week ending Sept. 29.

"I'm so proud of this song and all who worked really hard to make this happen," says Lane. "Thank you to the songwriters who let me record it and country radio for playing it, and a huge shoutout to the fans."

Penned by **Ashley Gorley**, **Hardy**, **Hunter Phelps** and **Jameson Rodgers**, the track is the second single from Lane's LP *Laps Around the Sun*, which debuted and peaked at No. 8 on Top Country Albums in July 2018. Lead single "Take Back Home Girl" (featuring **Tori Kelly**) reached No. 8 on Country Airplay in August 2018.

Lane first crowned Country Airplay with his second entry, "Fix," for a week in August 2016. Lane landed his second of four top 10s to date with follow-up "For Her," which hit No. 10 in September 2017.

On Hot Country Songs, "Know" pushes 4-2 for a new best in its 51st week. It drew 7.5 million U.S. streams and sold 4,000 downloads in the week ending Sept. 26.

STRIKE UP THE 'BAND' Old Dominion banks its eighth Hot Country Songs top 10 as "One Man Band" (RCA Nashville) sprints 14-10. It hikes by 23% to 17.7 million audience impressions as it

rises 17-14 on Country Airplay, while gaining by 6% to 6.8 million U.S. streams and 8% to 6.000 sold.

A 'LITTLE' BIGGER Russell Dickerson rolls up his third straight career-opening Country Airplay top 10, as "Every Little Thing" (Triple Tigers) climbs 11-10, gaining by 8% to 25 million in radio reach. His first two hits led the list last year: "Yours," for two weeks starting on Jan. 27, and "Blue Tacoma" (one week, Oct. 13).

**NEW CHARTS** Effective this issue, *Billboard* begins including the newly launched Country Songwriters and Country Producers charts, spotlighting the talents that contribute to chart hits. The two tallies will appear each week below the first page of the Hot Country Songs chart (see page 13). The Country Songwriters and Country Producers charts are based on total points accrued by a songwriter and a producer, respectively, for each attributed song that appears on the Hot Country Songs chart. **Blanco Brown** tops the latest Songwriters survey and **Dann Huff** paces the Producers list. •







#### BUSBEE REMEMBERED

Songwriter-producer **Michael James Ryan**, who worked under the professional name **busbee**, died over the weekend, sending shockwaves throughout the country music community.

Since he earned his first country hit 10 years ago as a co-writer on **Rascal Flatts**' "Summer Nights," the 43-year-old California native had become a major creative force in the genre, particularly as the primary producer on **Maren Morris**' first two Columbia Nashville albums, *Hero* and *Girl*.

"He was an extraordinary human being whose generosity, spirituality and humor inspired everyone around him," said the team at Warner Chappell Music in a statement. "An amazingly gifted songwriter, he used his talent, his music and his love to break down boundaries and bring people together. He left us far too soon."

A jazz trombone player during his earliest musical development, busbee approached sound with a jazz player's rule-breaking mindset and a spiritual man's conviction to inspire. He typically threaded some element of positivity into his compositions, including Florida Georgia Line's "H.O.L.Y.," Lady Antebellum's "You Look Good" and Carly Pearce's "Every Little Thing." He also produced tracks for Keith Urban, Hunter Hayes, Gavin DeGraw and Lauren Alaina, who earned a No. 1 single with "Road Less Traveled."

In the last year, busbee had formed an A&R firm, Altadena, in partnership with Warner Chappell. He was gregarious, considerate, open and grateful, and he attributed much of his latter-day success to Jessie, his wife of 10 years.

"Marriage is a challenge in a way that you have to look at your own shit," he told *Billboard Country Update*. "That ultimately is my saving grace because I could have remained [heading] down the path of being fairly self-absorbed. It was in that relationship where I was constantly being challenged and changed and shaped and baptized. Any time I am writing a love song, I'm thinking about my wife."

The couple's sons, Del and Dane Bryant, announced their donation of the duo's entire collection to the hall. The event included Jason Isbell and Alison Krauss covering "Love Hurts," Old Crow Medicine Show doing "Country Boy" and Bobby Osborne on a rendition of "Rocky Top."





## Florida Georgia Line Counts On 'Blessings' For A Year-End Uplift

Patience, we're told, is a virtue, and one good way to test it is a jigsaw puzzle.

The individual pieces, with their indiscriminate shapes and swatches of color, often fit together to create visual beauty and — for the puzzle builder — a sense of accomplishment. But the road to completion is sometimes long and uncertain.

So it was with Florida Georgia Line's "Blessings." Its nifty patchwork of

homespun phrases, acoustic accents and sweet melody is a satisfying package wrapped with an understated reminder: Always take time to count your blessings.

Things that take time often require patience, and "Blessings" took a lot of time to go from conception to terrestrial single. Patience was in order.

"We were in that place in our life of counting our blessings and being thankful and taking a second to let all the hard work soak in," says FGL's **Tyler Hubbard**. "It's funny, because we wrote that three-and-a-half years ago, and it kind of rings more true now than ever."

That word "rings" is part of the puzzle in "Blessings," though it never actually appears in the song. FGL's other half, **Brian Kelley**, and his wife, Brittney, were on vacation in the Virgin Islands in January 2016, feeling grateful for their marriage and for FGL's commercial success. Kelley referenced both rings and blessings with two lines that became the start of the chorus—"I can't count 'em on

one hand/But, honey, look there on your finger"—during an informal writing session with songwriters **Jordan M. Schmidt** ("God's Country," "You Make It Easy") and **Ernest K. Smith**, whose initial two tracks as an artist will be released under the stage name **Ernest** on Oct. 4.

As it turned out, Ernest had been exercising musical patience of his own, and it paid off in that tropical setting. During his high school years, he played around frequently with a folky, descending chord progression. On a trip to the local Guitar Center, another customer introduced him to an alternate opening tuning, DADGAD, and it made his chord pattern even better. He toyed with it often while writing songs, but never found the right puzzle pieces to match it.

"John Mayer is a big inspiration to me, so I was just playing guitar—I wasn't really even thinking of a country song," says Ernest. "Then, when Brian brought that idea up, I was like, 'Well, shit. This could be dope.'"

They wrote the chorus there in the Virgin Islands and mapped out the verse melodies around that descending guitar progression, fitting the vocal parts with the chords in a way that creates a series of tension-and-release moments as it unfolds.

"It's always waiting on a resolve," notes Ernest. "That is a cool thing about it, for sure."

They would finish at another time.

"Tyler was in Africa with [his wife] **Hayley** at the same time we were in the islands," recalls Kelley. "We were both in, like, life-changing places, probably doing a little bit of soul-searching, also doing a lot of looking back. We sent [the song] to Tyler and were like, 'Yeah, when we get back, we gotta finish this.'"

Kelley also sent it to songwriter **Tom Douglas** ("The House That Built Me," "Meanwhile Back at Mama's"), who didn't know the duo all that well, but definitely appreciated the foundation of "Blessings."

"I loved the message, but there was just something really powerful about the cool way that they were doing it melodically," he says. "So I just started writing. Once I have an idea, I try to let it reveal what is going to be revealed, not trying to edit myself in the beginning. Some of it is just kind of stream of consciousness, and I bang out a few verses just for an approach."

One of Douglas' key early rhyme schemes—"There's music in your laughter from the floor up to the rafters/You're that happy-ever-after I've been after my whole life"—cemented the first verse, though patience was required of

him, too, after he sent FGL some of his work.

"It went dark—I know it was months, it may have been a year," he says. "Occasionally I would reach back out and I would say, 'Hey, what do you guys think?'"

Finally, the duo asked Douglas to visit Kelley's "Treehouse" home and studio with Hubbard, Schmidt and Ernest, and they wrapped most of it there.

"I remember Tom Douglas coming in with a notepad and already having, like, a whole page and just kind of scribbling notes and scratch written down," says Hubbard. "It didn't take us long to put all those pieces together and complete the puzzle."

Other than a house, a ring and a Jeep, there are no man-made items referenced in "Blessings," which focuses more on a marital relationship, simple beauties in nature and a spiritual element that ties the rest of it together.

"The whole song really is [about] materialism versus spiritualism," says Douglas. "It's a very old theme of, you know, 'count your

blessings.' And your blessings are the things that money can't buy."

Yet more patience was needed after that Treehouse appointment. Schmidt pulled together a demo, but FGL still wasn't certain the song was done. The duo tapped songwriter **Jesse Frasure** ("Dirt on My Boots," "Ring on Every Finger") to do some extra work on the demo. He slowed down the tempo and changed a few pieces in the arrangement, helping find the track's acoustic center.

"We wanted to keep it pretty simple and organic and raw," says Hubbard. Producer Joey Moi (Jake Owen, Morgan Wallen) followed Frasure's demo fairly closely in a tracking session at Ocean Way studios, where the stained-

glass windows fit nicely with the spiritual undercurrent of "Blessings." **Ilya Toshinsky** captured the central acoustic guitar riff, **Russ Pahl** added tangy steel licks, **Jerry Roe** swirled brushes across the snare head to create a soft sonic filter and **Dave Cohen** chipped in with a Hammond B-3 organ, enhancing the elements of faith in the song's text.

"The fact that Ocean Way is an old, converted church, it does kind of tie it all together," says Moi.

FGL always saw "Blessings" as a potential single, though the group's previous release, "Talk You Out of It," lingered longer on the charts than it had anticipated. Thus, a little more patience was required before "Blessings" finally went to radio via Play MPE on Sept. 10, though the wait allowed Big Machine Label Group to snap it into the calendar like a perfect puzzle piece.

"When we get into the holiday-heavy part of the year, it feels like a good topic," says Moi. "It just feels appropriate for the season and the mood that we go through over the next few months."

Gratitude, says Douglas, is the antidote for the poisonous tone that dominates much of the national discussion. That's why, Hubbard believes, "Blessings" matters at this moment in time.

"We really do hope that God can use this song," he says, "and that people can be reminded of this amazing life we live." •

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### 10 Years Ago

## Justin Moore's 'Small Town USA' Was A Really Big Hit

In 2009, he notched his first Hot Country Songs No. 1

On Oct. 3, 2009, **Justin Moore**'s "Small Town USA" rose 3-1 on the Hot Country Songs chart.

His second chart entry, which he co-penned with **Brian Maher** and **Jeremy Stover**, followed launch track "Back That Thing Up," which peaked at No. 38. Both singles were released from his first studio LP (produced by Stover), which debuted and peaked at

No. 3 on Top Country Albums. Third and fourth singles "Backwoods" and "How I Got This Way" reached Nos. 6 and 17, respectively.

Moore signed with the Valory Music Company, which is part of the Big Machine Label Group, in 2007 as one of its first three artists, along with Jewel and Jimmy Wayne. He has rung up eight Hot Country Songs top 10s, including two No. 1s. "If Heaven Wasn't So Far Away" became his second leader in 2011. Moore currently boasts seven No. 1s on Country Airplay, having led earlier in September with "The Ones That Didn't Make It Back Home."

Moore will kick off 2020 by joining **Tracy Lawrence** on the Late Nights & Longnecks Tour, which begins Jan. 16 in Dodge City, Kan.
