

The Cross River Rail Delivery Authority is planning three new rail stations on the Gold Coast Line to help connect South East Queensland's growing population.

Concept designs have now been prepared and we are seeking your feedback. Stations are being planned in Merrimac, Pimpama and Helensvale North. The proposed new Merrimac station will provide the local community with greater access to convenient rail services; expanding options for easy travel within the Gold Coast, as well as to Brisbane.

The Merrimac station will service the growing residential population in Merrimac, Worongary and Carrara.

Merrimac Station is scheduled to be open in time for the first Cross River Rail services.

We'd like your feedback and local knowledge to help further develop the concept designs.

The Merrimac station will be located on Gooding Drive, approximately 750 metres west of the Pacific Motorway and Gooding Drive Interchange (Exit 77). See the map below for further information.


