



Paper Size: A4 or A5, 1 red and 1 green of the same size —both sides coloured Sections required: Flower, Bud, Stem, Petals



1. Flower




1. Start with a Preliminary Fold




2. Valley Fold






4. Valley Fold the top layer only






6. Repeat Step 2 to 5 on the other three sides




7. Fold back into a Preliminary Fold




8. Sink the top half



9. Reverse fold. Repeat behind.




10. Valley fold up. Repeat behind.




11. Turn one layer on both sides and repeat step 9


(Note: This might get a bit thick so it is best to undo step 10 first and redo it later)



12. (Enlarged) Open from the centre and flatten




14. Mountain Fold on all four sides into the pocket and turn over




15. Fold and unfold on the four corners


(Note: Best to keep a bit of space at the area highlighted by the circle to prevent ripping later)




17. Repeat Step 16 on the other 3 sides








19. Bring the line between the two points of A to the line between the two points of B. Make sure flap A is on top of flap B


(Note: This is where the ripping as mentioned in step 15 might occur on the opposite side)



20. Mountain Fold and tuck inside. Repeat on the quarter to the right, making sure that flap B is on top of flap A




21. Rotate by 90° and repeat step 20 on the other half




22. Flip over



23. Peel back along line A until it cannot be peeled further. Repeat on the other four corners




24. Peel back the second layer






2. Bud




1. Start with a Waterbomb base. Inside Reverse Fold along the top corner and a point halfway between the bottom left corner and the centre



2. Inside reverse fold the flap at a 45° angle




3. Mountain fold the top layer of the flap. Repeat on the layer behind.




4. Step 3 Finished. Repeat Step 1 to 3 on the other four sides


5. Crease at a slight angle. Repeat on the other corners




6. Completed Bud section. Snip a little bit off the tip and just big enough of a hole to allow the stem to be inserted



1. Crease along the lines




2. Valley fold on all the corners




Basically roll or fold up any length or width of green paper


5. Assembly



1. Get the Rose section and turn over. Notice that there are four pockets. Get the Bud section and open the flaps to 45° and insert them into the pockets (Note: Best to open up some of the tucked flaps made in Step 20)



2. Insert the stem into the little hole snipped off previously



3. Undo Step 4 of the petals section and insert the flaps into the pockets
