TO THE COMMAND OF ONO/5K /5th Corps

DRAFT Toperations and Training/

Pursuant to the order of the 2nd VO /Military District/, strictly confidential no. 12/81-433 of 11 May 1992, and for the purposes of protecting the Serbian people and honourable members of other peoples in the SR BH /Serbian Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina/, and also for the purposes of strengthening the operational and tactical position of units of the 5th Corps, I hereby

ORDER:

1. Immediately carry out a mobilisation and formation of all RJs /wartime units/ within your organisational strength. Include into the strength of units Serbs bearing weapons, TO /Territorial Defence/ units that have been formed so far and volunteer units, the personnel of which are to be included in establishment units. Ensure

unitary command and control over these structures in your zone.

- 2. Ensure that without fail all conscription-eligible persons of Serbian ethnicity are mobilised, as well as conscription-eligible persons of other ethnicities if they wish to fight for the just cause of the SR BH's struggle.
- In manning units, give priority to: motorised and artillery units, then armouredmechanised formations, military police units, reconnaissance units and units for antiarmour combat.
- 4. During and after completing the mobilisation, send us the prescribed regular and summary reports, as well as interim reports if necessary.
- 5. Consolidate mobilised units in organisational terms, and train, arm and prepare them for combat as soon as possible.
- 6. Carry out detailed reconnaissance with commanders of all units on axes of unit engagement and ensure a planned take-over of positions, areas and zones from men and units being withdrawn on the basis of personnel relocation (citizens of the FRY /Federal Republic of Yugoslavia/ and the SR /Serbian Republic/ of Krajina).
- 7. After taking over duties from personnel being withdrawn, gather them together L0021227 and ensure their planned and safe transfer to their destination in the FRY.

8. Send regular summary reports, and if necessary interim reports also, to the PKM /?Rear Command Post/ – the Organ for Mobilisation Matters to allow them to be combined and sent to the 2^{nd} Military District Command.
