## **The Funeral of Rear-Admiral Pearson.**

The funeral of Rear-Admiral GEO. F. PEARSON took place from the Stone Church (Unitarian) at Portsmouth, N. H., on Tuesday, Rev. Mr. DAVIS, of the Episcopal Church, and Rev. Dr. BURROUGHS officiating. The funeral was attended by many of his brother officers stationed and residing in Portsmouth, with several army officers and many of the prominent people of the town. The Marines from the yard, under command of Col. JOSEPH H. JONES, and Company I, Third United States Artillery, with the Portsmouth Cornet Band, performed escort duty. Minute guns were fired from the battery at the yard during the services. Admiral PEARSON had been a resident of Portsmouth for many years, and was highly esteemed for the excellence of his character and for his gentlemanlike deportment, by all his townsmen.
