Hjemmesiden klar til redigering, 5 lastbiler til Ukraine og én container afsendt til Burkina Faso, samarbejde med medicinalfirmaer, hospitaler, og private firmaer forstærket, offentlighedens interesse øget, økonomien meget dårlig.

Modtaget 500 komplette computere samt ca 450 pumper til enteral ernæring.

MEDICIN OG Udstyr:

Ukraine: 4 lastbiler á 93 m3 til private organisationer, én lastbil til Ukrainian Military-Medical Academy

ØKONOMI:

Stærkt forringet, hovedsageligt som følge af udgifter til renoivering af blodfraktioneringsmaskinerne, men også af uventede og højere udgifter end normalt. Indtægterne må øges væsentligt og udgifterne reduceres.

GMA har modtaget en større økonomisk donation fra et medlem i Amerika, der også tidligere har betænkt GMA. Økonomien er selvfølgelig forbedret, men stadig ikke tilfredsstillende.

VÆSENTLIGE BEGIVENHEDER:

De fem lastbiler til Ukraine, i alt over 450 m³, indeholdt mange værdifulde maskiner, bl.a. en dexa scanner, et mammografi apparat, en hjertelunge-maskine, tre U/L apparater, to anæstesi apparater, fem artroskopiapparater og adskillige desinfektions- og vaskemaskiner, som blev fordelt til de største hospitaler i Kiev, hvor de selvsagt vil blive særskilt kontrollerede.

Den administrative sagsgang i Ukraine er imidlertid uforholdsmæssig besværlig og må forenkles.

”Blodmaskinerne” er fordelt til 8 centre og 21 mindre tapningssteder. Donationen er af umådelig stor betydning, og firedobler Ukraines blodbehandlingskapacitet, Sundhedsministeriet er meget taknemmelig og overdragelsesceremonien, hvori UNFPA deltog, blev udsendt på tre landsdækkende TV-kanaler, jfr. forsiden., ligesom UNPFA Nordic bragte en stor artikel med billeder på hjemmesiden.

GMA vil, evt. ved henvendelse til firmaer i medico branchen, forsøge at få flere ensartede maskiner i større mængder, idet det må forventes, at firmaerne fremover vil være mere opmærksomme på betydningen af genbrug, ”recycling” eller ”cirkulær økonomi”.

GMA har modtaget 500 velfungerende computere mv., 3–4 år gamle, der vil kunne anvendes i fx undervisningen samt ca. 450 velfungerende ernæringspumper, 2-6 år gamle.

Både computerne og pumperne kan efter omstændighederne have national betydning for modtagerlandet, men vil kunne medføre større ekstraordinære omkostninger til klargøring og fragt, der vil kunne belaste forningens økonomi, da GMA ønsker at opretholde sine sædvanlige udstyrsaktiviteter

Henvendelserne fra hospitaler, medico firmaer og medicinal firmaer er øget, utvivlsomt forårsaget af, at GMA er blevet mere kendt i offentligheden.

The website is ready for editing, and 5 trucks for Ukraine and one container for Burkina Faso shipped off. In addition, cooperation with pharmaceutical companies, hospitals and private companies strengthened, interest from the publics increased, finances very poor.

Received 500 complete PCs and approximately 450 pumps for enteral nutrition

Donation of medicine and hospital equipment totals DKK146,374,123 since beginning in 2010.

MEDICINE AND EQUIPMENT:

Burkina Faso: Shipped one container med medicine and equipment for the university hospital in Ouagadougou.

Ukraine: 4 trucks with 93 m3 each for private organizations, and one truck for the Ukrainian Military-Medical Hospital.

FINANCES:

Increasingly diminished, mainly due to costs incurred for refurbishing the blood fractioning machines, but also because of unexpected and higher than usual costs.

Incoming money must be increased substantially, and costs reduced.

NOTEWORTHY EVENTS:

The 5 trucks for the Ukraine, with a total of 450 m³, contained many valuable machines, including a dexta scanner, a mammography machine, a heart and lung machine, three U7L machines, two anaesthesia machines, five arthroscopy machines, and several disinfection- and washing machines. These were all distributed to the largest hospitals in Kiev where they, of course, will be thoroughly checked. See more on the heart- and lung machine on our website.

The new administrative way of handling cases in Ukraine has become disproportionately difficult and must be simplified.

“The blood machines” have been distributed to 8 centers and 21 smaller blood clinics. The donation is of immense use, and will quadruple Ukraine’s blood handling capacity.

The Ministry of Health is very thankful, and the hand-over ceremony wherein UNFPA participated was sent on three national TV channels (mentioned on page three). In addition, UNPFA Nordic ran a big article with pictures on their website.

GMA will, fx. by contact to companies in the medico businesses, try to receive more uniform machines in larger quantities since it must be expected that these companies in the future will pay more attention to recycling or circular economy.

GMA has received 500 functioning computers, 3-4 years old, that can be used in, fx. classroom teaching, and approximately 450 functioning pumps for nutrition, 2-6 years old. Computers and pumps alike can, given the circumstances, have national importance for the receiving country, but will also possibly incur larger extraordinary costs for preparation and freight which will weigh on the foundation’s finances as GMA wishes to keep its usual equipment activities.

Requests from hospitals, medico companies and medicinal companies has increased, likely because GMA has become more known in the public.
