## "URSULA" SLIGHTLY WEAKENS WHILE MOVING WEST-NORTHWESTWARD TOWARDS THE WEST PHILIPPINE SEA.

Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal is now lifted over the eastern portion of Romblon.

At 10:00 PM today, the eye of Typhoon "URSULA"

was located based on all available data including

Busuanga Doppler Radar at 100 km North

Northwest of Coron, Palawan (12.8°N, 119.8°E).

#### **Heavy Rainfall Outlook**



- Between tonight and tomorrow morning: Occasional to frequent heavy with intermittent intense rains over Calamian and Cuyo Islands, Mindoro Provinces including Lubang Island, and northwestern Antique. Light to moderate with intermittent heavy rains over Romblon, Aklan, Capiz, the rest of northern Antique, Marinduque, CALABARZON, Metro Manila, Central Luzon, and the northern portion of mainland Palawan.
- Residents in these areas are advised to take appropriate measures to reduce the potential impact of flooding and raininduced landslides, especially in areas identified to be highly to very highly susceptible to these hazards.

#### Other Hazards and Warning Information

- Rough sea conditions will prevail over the seaboards of areas under TCWS. Sea travel remains risky over these areas.
- Storm surge of 1.0 to 2.0 meters may still affect several coastal areas in Occidental Mindoro and Calamian Islands.
- Landfalls: Salcedo, Eastern Samar (4:45 PM yesterday); Tacloban City, Leyte (7:30 PM yesterday); Cabucgayan, Biliran (9:15 PM yesterday); Gigantes Islands, Carles, Iloilo (2:30 AM today), Ibajay, Aklan (8:40 AM today), Semirara Island, Caluya, Antique (1:00 PM today); southern tip of Bulalacao, Oriental Mindoro (3:00 PM today).
