
Capt. Bull Resigns.

PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 9.—Alfred E. Bull, Captain of the University of Pennsylvania 'Varsity eight, has resigned from the crew. Bull has rowed in the 'Varsity boat for the past three years, and is an enthusiastic believer in the efficiency of the "Woodruff" stroke, which is a modified "Cook" stroke. When Ellis Ward was elected coach of the crew, a few days ago, it was announced that the "Woodruff" stroke would be abandoned, and a stroke taught by Ward substituted for it. Bull was not in sympathy with this move, and, believing that the men in the boat should be in thorough accord with their coach, he resigned. Notwithstanding his resignation, Bull promises to do all he can to aid in turning out a winning crew for Pennsylvania.
