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Working in cooperation with the Board of Supervisors and the Washington Township Police Department, the district this year will expand our School Resource Officer program by having Officer Ken Hollis in our schools. The new position will be partially funded by state grant monies made available under Act 44 of 2018. For the past six years, our schools have been covered by Officer Charity Butz of the Allegheny Township Police Department, who will continue to serve as a School Resource Officer.

Officer Hollis will be present in all schools, but his primary assignments will be Kiski Area Upper Elementary, South Primary, and East Primary schools. Officer Butz will have a primary assignment of the High School, Intermediate School, and North Primary. Both officers will work together to assure consistent programs and services across the district.

Officer Hollis has been a police officer since 2001, working for the North Apollo and Vandergrift Police Departments before moving to the Washington Township Police Department in 2002, first on a part time, then a

full time basis. Over the past several years he has made a presence in our schools in Washington Township as part of his regular patrol duties. He has completed the National Association of School Resource Officers basic training to prepare him for his new role as a full-time SRO.

We look forward to the additional support he will provide our students and staff to promote safety in the school environment. One of the primary functions of a School Resource Officer is to forge positive relationships with students and provide assistance resolving problems faced by students to keep them safe. Officer Hollis has already demonstrated his ability to connect with our students during his regular visits to schools and will now be able to further support the students in the district.



### 2019 - 2020 LUNCH AND BREAKFAST PROGRAM

The Kiski Area School District continues to meet new federal nutrition standards for school meals to ensure that meals are healthy, well-balanced, and providing all the nutrition students need to succeed at school. Now is a great time to encourage your children to choose school breakfast and lunch!

Meals consist of fat-free or 1% milk, a wide variety of fruit, and large serving of vegetables, proteins and whole grains, that must meet standards for saturated fat, sodium and have age appropriate calorie limits.

Breakfast and lunch will be served by the Kiski Area Food Service Staff in each building beginning Thursday, August 22, 2019. <u>District wide breakfast prices will be \$1.40 (\$7.00 per week)</u>; \$0.30 reduced breakfast (\$1.50 per week). Elementary lunch prices are \$2.70 each day (\$13.50 per week); secondary lunch prices are \$2.80 each day (\$14.00 per week); reduced lunch prices are \$0.40 per day (\$2.00 per week). Lunch includes one half pint of milk; additional milk may be purchased for \$0.65 per carton.

Kiski Area East Primary and Kiski Area Upper Elementary are approved Community Eligibility Program (CEP) schools. CEP allows students at these schools **to receive a free breakfast and free lunch** every day during the school year. These items are the menu meal items only, not ala carte items. All items taken ala carte will have a charge to them, including milk. Students must take a minimum of three items, **one of them being a fruit or vegetable**. Parents whose children attend East Primary or the Upper Elementary School will no longer need to complete a Free and Reduced Application. However, if you have children attending North Primary, South Primary, Intermediate School or the High School and they are eligible for free and reduced meals, a new application will need to be completed for 2019-2020. *Be sure to include all children in the household total, even if they attend a school that is certified as CEP*. The CEP will continue at these schools for three years.

Kiski Area School District accepts electronic payments for Food Service through Skyward Family Access using the District Web Store through the RevTrak processing system. We are currently accepting debit



and credit cards from Discover, MasterCard and Visa. Making electronic payments saves time and eliminates the need to send cash and checks with your child. Make a quick payment in the evening or morning with just a few clicks! Please note: A Service Fee of 3.61% will be added to your shopping cart at checkout.

#### **Electronic Payment Instructions**

- Login to SKYWARD FAMILY ACCESS
- Select the Food Service tab on left side of screen
- Current Account Balance will show at top of the page. Note: You can switch between children or select all students to view children within your family access.
- Click Make a Payment next to your child's name
- Enter your email and password. Click LOGIN. Note: If this is the first time you are using the new system, you will need to create an account and set up your new account by entering information and following the steps to create a new account. You can set your password the same as your Skyward Family Access password if you choose.
- Click Food Accounts under Family Account Fees on the left
- Enter the amount to add to each student's food service account
- Click Add to Cart and then click Check Out
- Select your payment card then click continue (or click add card to enter new card information)
- Review your billing and payment information then click Place Order
- A receipt screen will appear for saving or printing
- Close the screen when finished

Skyward and RevTrak do not have the ability to move funds between student accounts. If you would like funds to be transferred from one student account to another student account, you will need to contact the Kiski Area Food Service office at 724-842-0466 and the staff can complete this task for you. To view past and present student purchases, log into the Skyward Family Access screen to view current purchases is listed on the right hand side of the screen. By clicking on previous payments you are able to see prior transactions.

You can apply online for free and/or reduced benefits at https://www.SchoolCafe.com. The sooner you apply, the sooner your children can take advantage of this program. If your child participated in the program last year, he or she will be eligible for the same benefit for the first two weeks of this school year. Remember, you must reapply each year.

Only <u>one application needs to be completed for each household</u> wishing to participate in the free/ reduced program. If you have been directly certified for the benefits, you should have received a letter prior to the start of school. If you have received a letter, do not fill out or send an application. There is no need since you have already been approved.



All schools are on a computerized debit system. Money is deposited into a student's account regardless of whether your child is free, reduced or a full paying student. Students were assigned a personal identification number (PIN) during the prior school year which they will use to access their account. Students who are new to the district will receive a PIN their first day. Paying by check or money order is encouraged, but cash payment will be accepted. If paying by check or money order, sign the student's name and pin number in the memo section. Please be aware that if your child is a free, reduced or paying student, the point of sale system will know this and price meals accordingly. Free and reduced paying students can deposit money into their accounts, enabling them to purchase additional lunches or ala carte items above the basic meal. There is no limit on the amount of money that can be deposited into the account. There is confidentiality with this system; all students will access the system in the same manner, regardless if they receive free, reduced or full price meals.

Students in grades K-12 who do not have sufficient funds to cover meals are still offered the menu meal of the day. Parents have the ability in Skyward to set up parameters for low balance notifications. When student balances are negative, parents will be notified by phone, or by letters sent home with students. If it appears the student may need financial assistance, additional free and reduced applications will be sent home to parents/guardians. If student accounts continue to be in the negative, the magistrate is notified to take further action.

Accounts must have a positive balance in order for ala carte items to be purchased. Under no circumstances may ala carte items be charged. If students have negative balances in their accounts, they are required to pay their balance. Students/parents are responsible for any debts incurred on their accounts, including debts incurred during lapses in free/reduced status. Debts can be carried over from year to year, however, they must be resolved prior to departure from the district including graduation, withdrawal or expulsion. When paying debt upon leaving the district, students must sign a paid receipt. Students/ staff are entitled to a refund of their account balances, except amounts less than \$.99 upon their departure from the district, including graduation, withdrawal or expulsion. **Graduating students will be required to sign a receipt for a refund.** In the case of a returned NSF check, the student will be served a regular lunch until the parent/guardian is notified of the account being delinquent.

The Kiski Area Food Service Department's primary concern is the students' welfare. If you have any questions, feel free to contact Allison Brasile, Director of Food Services, at 724-842-0466. The food service staff is looking forward to serving our Kiski Area students. Please review the menu and help your child select the days he or she chooses to participate.

### **CHILD FIND & ANNUAL NOTICE TO PARENTS**

#### Services for Pre-School Children

Act 212, the Early Intervention Services System Act, entitles all preschool children with disabilities to appropriate early intervention services. Young children experiencing developmental delays or physical or mental disabilities and their families are eligible for early intervention services including screening, evaluation, individualized education program planning and provision of appropriate programs and services. Potential signs of developmental delay and other risk factors that could indicate disabilities and the possibility that a child is an "eligible young child" could include:

- By the age of 3: not saying many words; not using 2 or 3 word phrases and sentences; not walking; awkward gait (walking); drooling; not answering "show" or "what" questions; and/or not using utensils to feed self;
- By age of 4 (all of the above included): not toilet trained; difficulty with directional words (in, on, under, out); not playing with other children, not able to draw a circle, cross or imitate a vertical line; not able to understand the child's speech most of the time; difficulty following simple two-step directions (e.g., pick up the paper and put it in the garbage;
- By the age of 5 (all of the above included): unable to answer "where" questions; unable to recall details from a story; not drawing a person with at least 6 parts; immature speech patterns (me instead of I), not able to hop forward with one foot without support;
- Other warning signs at any age: little or no eye contact, over/under sensitivities to pain, light, noise; hand flapping; no awareness of space (always bumping into other people or things); awkward hand or foot positioning; won't touch or eat certain textures; child no longer can do things he/she used to do; developed normally, then stopped; echoes what is said; plays with toys inappropriately (e.g., watches wheels spin on the car, but does not play with the car).

#### Services for School-Age Students with Disabilities

KASD provides a free, appropriate, public education to eligible students. To qualify as an eligible student, the child must be of school age, in need of specially-designed instruction, and meet eligibility criteria for one or more of the following physical or mental disabilities, as set forth in Pennsylvania State Regulations: Autism, Deaf-Blindness, Deafness, Emotional Disturbance, Hearing Impairment, Intellectual Disability (formerly referred to as Mental Retardation), Multiple Disabilities, Orthopedic Impairment, Other Health Impairment, Specific Learning Disability, Speech or Language Impairment, Traumatic Brain Injury, or Visual Impairment including Blindness. Information regarding the appropriate developmental milestone descriptors for infants and toddlers may be found at the Center for Disease Control (CDC) website at http://www.cdc.gov or the National Dissemination Center for Children with Disabilities (NICHCY) web-site at http://nichcy.org. For additional information regarding the signs of developmental delays or other disabilities, please contact the Director of Student Support Services at 724-842-0452 or the School Psychologist, Mr. Scot Harvey, at 724-842-0409.

The District engages in identification procedures to ensure that eligible students receive an appropriate educational program consisting of special education and related services, individualized to meet student needs. At no cost to the parents, these services are provided in compliance with state and federal laws and are reasonably calculated to yield meaningful educational benefit and student progress. To identify students who may be eligible for special education, various screening activities are conducted on an on-going basis. These screening activities include: review of group-based data (cumulative records, enroll-ment records, health records, report cards, ability, and achievement test scores); hearing, vision, physical, and speech/language screening; and review by a Child Study Team, Pupil Personnel Team, or Elementary Student Assistant Program (ESAP) Team. When screening results suggest that the student may be eligible for special education services, the District seeks parental consent to conduct a multidisciplinary evaluation. Parents who suspect that their child is eligible for special education services may request a multidisciplinary evaluation at any time through a written request to the building principal or Director of Student Support Services.

Services designed to meet the needs of eligible students include the annual development of an Individualized Education Program (IEP), bi-annual or tri-annual multidisciplinary re-evaluation, and a full continuum of services, which include Itinerant, Supplemental, or Full-Time Levels of Intervention. The extent of special education services and the location for the delivery of such services are determined by the IEP team and are based on the student's identified needs and abilities, chronological age, and the level of intensity of the specified intervention. The District also provides related services, such as transportation, speech and language therapy, physical therapy, and occupational therapy, required for the student to benefit from the special education program. Parents may obtain additional information regarding special education services and programs and parental due process rights by contacting the child's building principal or the Director of Student Support Services at 724-842-0452.

#### Services for Students who are Mentally Gifted

The definition of giftedness comes from the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) Special Education Rules and Regulations under Chapter 16 and states that a student who is mentally gifted demonstrates outstanding intellectual and creative ability, the development of which requires specially designed programs or support services, or both, not ordinarily provided in the regular education program. This term includes a person who has an IQ of 130 or higher or when multiple criteria, as set forth in Chapter 16 and in Department Guidelines, indicate gifted ability. Determination of gifted ability will not be based on IQ score alone. Deficits in memory or processing speed, as indicated by intellectual ability subtests, cannot be the sole basis upon which a student is determined to be ineligible for gifted special education. A person with an IQ score lower than 130 may be admitted to gifted programs when other educational criteria in the profile of the person strongly indicate gifted ability. Determination of mentally gifted must include a full assessment by a certified school psychologist. Once a student meets the screening requirements, a Gifted Multidisciplinary Evaluation (GMDE) is conducted. The GMDE must be sufficient in scope and depth to investigate information relevant to the student's suspected giftedness, including academic functioning, learning strengths and educational needs. The Gifted Written Report (GWR) brings together the findings from the evaluation or reevaluation concerning the student's educational needs and strengths.

The GWR must make recommendations as to whether the student is gifted and in need of specially designed instruction, which are considered by the GMDE Team in the development of the Gifted Individualized Education Plan (GIEP). At the conclusion of the GIEP meeting, a Notice of Recommended Assignment (NORA) is issued.

Parents have the right to obtain an independent educational evaluation at their own expense to share with the District. The results of the independent evaluation must be considered by the District in any decision made with respect to the provision of a gifted education.

Parents of students who are mentally gifted have the right to request a special education due process hearing or to file a compliance complaint with the Pennsylvania Department of Education. Details concerning the procedures governing hearing requests may be found on the website of the Office for Dispute Resolution http://odr-pa.org. For additional information, please contact the Director of Student Support Services, 724-842-0452.

#### Services for Students in Nonpublic Schools

Parents of nonpublic school students who suspect that their child has a disability and is in need of special education may request a multidisciplinary evaluation through a written request to the Director of Student Support Services, 724-842-0452.

In order to receive special education services and programs, a student must (1) qualify through the two pronged evaluation concerning the existence of an exceptionality and a consequent need for specially designed instruction and (2) be enrolled in the school district. In the event that a student in a nonpublic school qualifies for special education services and the parent does not wish to enroll them in the district full time, through dual enrollment, the student can access these services during the scheduled times when the services are available in the district. However, transportation to and from those services is the responsibility of the parent.

#### Services for Protected Handicapped Students

In compliance with the state and federal law, KASD will provide to protected handicapped students services or accommodations that are needed to provide equal opportunity to participate in and obtain the benefits of the school program and extra-curricular activities to the maximum extent appropriate to the student's abilities. These related services or accommodations are provided without discrimination or cost to the student or family. In order to qualify as a protected handicapped student, the child must be of school age with a physical or mental disability, which substantially limits or prohibits participation in or access to an aspect of the school program.

Services and safeguards for protected handicapped students are distinct from those applicable to exceptional students enrolled or seeking enrollment in special education programs. Protected handicapped students fall under Pennsylvania Chapter 15 of Title 22 of the Regulations of the State Board of Education, sometimes known by its federal name Section 504 of the 1973 Rehabilitation Act. In contrast, students with disabilities who qualify for special education services are covered by the regulations contained in Chapter 14. For further information about the evaluation procedures and provisions of services to protected handicapped students, contact the child's building principal.

#### STUDENT SERVICES

#### **Confidentiality of Student Records**

KASD protects the confidentiality of personally identifiable information for all students in accordance with state and federal law and the District's student records policy.

#### **Student Records**

School records are an important part of a student's formal educational file in a public school setting. They are confidential and privileged; so a policy regarding the collection, maintenance, and dissemination of records has been adopted by the KASD School Board. As a parent of an eligible/non-eligible child, you have rights guaranteed by the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, (FERPA) (20 U.S.C. §1232 g; 34 CFR Part 99). This notice outlines your rights.

You have the right to inspect your child's records within forty-five days from the date of a written request. You may make a written request for copies of your child's records at a fee not to exceed duplicating costs. Requests for review, inspection, or duplication should be submitted to the staff person designated as having responsibility for the records. (Refer to 'Location of Records' below.) If you believe that any information in the records is inaccurate, misleading, or in violation of privacy, you may request a change in records or have a hearing if the request is refused.

#### **Release of Information**

Your child's records cannot be released without your written consent except for directory information, incidents specified in the policy, or as otherwise stated herein. Directory information may consist of name, address, telephone number, date and place of birth, major field of study, honors won and offices held, recognition for achievements, post high school endeavors, recognition of graduating seniors, participation in officially recognized activities and sports, weight and height (for members of athletic teams), dates of attendance, enrollment status, degrees and awards received, and the last educational agency or institution attended by the student. If you do not want directory information about your child transferred, you may prevent its release by contacting the District in writing within thirty days from the receipt of this notice. Please address such requests to the building principal.

#### **Additional Exceptions**

Your child's records may be moved to another school or school system in which you plan to enroll your child, or in which your child is already enrolled, if you notify the responsible staff person at KASD, or if the enrolling school system submits written notification of enrollment and the disclosure of information requested is for purposes related to the student's enrollment or transfer. The following is a list of examples:

- School officials with legitimate educational interest.
- Other schools to which a student is transferring.
- Specified officials for audit or evaluation purposes.
- Appropriate parties in connection with financial aid to a student.
- Organizations conducting certain studies for or on behalf of the school.
- Accrediting organizations.
- Compliance with a judicial order or lawfully issued subpoena.
- Appropriate officials in cases of health and safety emergencies; and state and local authorities within a juvenile system, pursuant to specific state law.

#### Maintenance of Records

Records will be maintained on a child until no longer necessary. Special Education Records must be retained for six years. Permanent records will be kept for 100 years beyond the date the student attains the age of 21. The permanent records may contain such information as the student's name, birth date, address, enrollment date, class rank, grades, and academic and non-academic awards. Parents have certain rights with respect to their child's records that are transferred to a student when he or she reaches the age of 18 or attends an institution of post secondary education unless the student is dependent upon the parent, as defined in Section 152 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.

Should your primary language not be English, you may write for assistance in understanding the records policy and your child's records.

If you wish to review the policy regarding records for eligible and non-eligible students, the Director of Student Support Services may be contacted. Should you feel that the District is not providing the rights as guaranteed by the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, you may file a letter with the Family Policy

### **IMMUNIZATION NOTICE**

The law requires all children entering school to have verification of the following immunizations:

- 4 doses of tetanus, diphtheria, and acellular pertussis\* (1 dose on or after the 4th birthday)
- 4 doses of polio (4th dose on or after 4th birthday and at least 6 months after previous dose given)\*\*
- 2 doses of measles, mumps, rubella\*\*\*
- 3 doses of hepatitis B
- 2 doses of varicella (chickenpox) or evidence of immunity

\*Usually given as DTP or DTaP or if medically advisable, DT or Td

\*\*A fourth dose is not necessary if the third dose was administered at age 4 years or older and at least 6 months after the previous dose \*\*\*Usually given as MMR

For attendance in 7th grade:

- 1 dose of tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis (Tdap) on the first day of 7th grade
- 1 dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV) on the first day of 7th grade

For attendance in 12th grade:

• 1 dose of MCV (Meningogcoccal A, C, Y, W-135) given ON or AFTER the 16th birthday. If one dose was given at 16 years or older, that shall count as the twelfth grade dose.

#### ALL IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS MUST BE MET ON FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL.

Please be aware that students who are exempt from immunizations due to medical, religious, or philosophical reasons will be excluded from school in the event of a disease outbreak. In some circumstances, these absences may extend for an entire incubation period, which would be determined in consultation with the PA Department of Health.

### NOTICE FOR STUDENTS WHOSE NATIVE LANGUAGE IS NOT ENGLISH

This information is important for all English language learners (students whose native language is not English) and their parents/guardians. Throughout the school year very important information is sent home or provided to students in school. An example would be the parent/student handbook, which contains information, schedules, calendars, policies, etc., all critical to the student's successful participation in school. ### **TITLE IA COMPLAINT RESOLUTION PROCEDURES**

On December 10, 2015, a new Federal education law was signed by the President. This law, the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), requires schools that receive federal Title IA funding adopt written procedures for resolving complaints filed.

A "complaint" is a written, signed statement filed by an individual or an organization. It must include:

- a. A statement that a school has violated a requirement of federal statute or regulation that applies to Title IA.
- b. The facts on which the statement is based.
- c. Information on any discussions, meetings or correspondence with a school regarding the complaint.

#### **Complaint Resolution Procedures**

 Referral – Complaints against schools should be referred to the District's Federal Programs Office: Mrs. Christine M. Ross, 1048 School Road, Leechburg, PA 15656, 724-845-2032 or christine.ross@kiskiarea.com.

- 2. Notice to School The Federal Programs Office will notify the school Superintendent and Principal that a complaint has been received. A copy of the complaint will be given to the Superintendent and Principal with directions given for the Principal to respond.
- 3. **Investigation** After receiving the Principal's response, the Federal Programs Office, along with the Superintendent, will determine whether further investigation is necessary. If necessary, the Federal Programs Director and the Superintendent may do an onsite investigation at the school.
- 4. **Opportunity to Present Evidence** The Federal Programs Director may provide for the complainant and the Principal to present evidence.
- 5. **Report and Recommended Resolution** Once the Federal Programs Director has completed the investigation and the taking of evidence, a report will be prepared with a recommendation for resolving the complaint. The report will give the name of the party bringing the complaint, the nature of the complaint, a summary of the investigation, the recommended resolution and the reasons for the recommendation. Copies of the report will be issued to all parties involved. The recommended resolution will become effective upon issuance of the report.
- 6. Follow up The Federal Programs Director and the Superintendent will ensure that the resolution of the complaint is implemented.
- 7. **Time Limit** The period between the Federal Programs Director receiving the complaint and resolution of the complaint shall not exceed sixty (60) calendar days.
- 8. **Right to Appeal** Either party may appeal the final resolution to the Department of Education. Appeals should be addressed as follows:

#### Do you know a student at risk academically? Are you concerned about a friend's behavior?

The Student Assistance Program (SAP) is a team of dedicated staff members who give their time to assist students in need. The purpose of the team is to help identify, assess, refer, and support students who are experiencing a variety of academic, behavioral, and/or personal difficulties which may interfere with their daily functioning. SAP also works to prevent student problems through promoting personal wellness in all students. Each school in the district has a team available to assist our students.

### **PUBLIC NOTICE - AHERA**

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) Management Plan for Kiski Area School District continues to be maintained and updated. A copy of the management plan, subsequent re-inspections and response actions information is available for review in the school district offices.

### ANNUAL PEST MANAGEMENT NOTIFICATION

The Kiski Area School District uses an Integrated Pest Management (IPM) approach for managing insects, rodents and weeds. Our goal is to protect every student from pesticide exposure by using an IPM approach to pest management. Our IPM approach focuses on making the school building and grounds an unfavorable habitat for these pests by removing food and water sources and eliminating their hiding and breeding places. We accomplish this through routine cleaning and maintenance. We routinely monitor the school building and grounds to detect any pests that are present. Pest sightings are reported to our IPM coordinator who evaluates the "pest problem" and determines the appropriate pest management techniques to address the problem. The techniques can include increased sanitation, modifying storage practices, sealing entry points and physically removing pests.

From time to time, it may be necessary to use chemicals to manage a pest problem. Chemicals will only be used when necessary, and will not be routinely applied. When chemicals are used, the school will try to use the least toxic products when possible. Applications will be made only when unauthorized persons do not have access to the area(s) being treated. Notices will be posted in these areas 72 hours prior to application and for two days following the application.

Parents or guardians of students enrolled in the school may request prior notification of specific pesticide applications made at the school. To receive notification, you must be placed on the school's notification registry. This can be done by notifying the building principal in writing. Please note that because it is updated annually, parents must submit a letter to the school every year if they wish to be placed on this registry. Include your name, your child's/children's name(s), address, and telephone number.

If a chemical application must be made to control an emergency pest problem, notice will be provided by telephone to any parent or guardian who has requested such notification in writing. Exemptions to this notification include disinfectants and antimicrobial products; self-containerized baits placed in areas not accessible to students, and gel type baits placed in cracks, crevices or voids; and swimming pool maintenance chemicals.

#### Notice to Students, Parents and District Staff Regarding the Use of Video/Audio Equipment

Pursuant to Kiski Area School Board Policy 810.2, for the safety of our students and staff, the district utilizes video and audio recording on school buses outfitted with this equipment. Only the Transportation Supervisor or Supervisor's designee, District Administrators and the Bus Company Supervisor shall be authorized to view the video recording for such purposes as:

- Documenting a problem
- Investigating the validity of a complaint
- Determining the involvement of individual or individuals in an incident
- · Determining if there was an infraction of behavior or safety procedures

Disciplinary action may be taken as a result of the video/audio documentation. Procedures for the administration of discipline will follow district guidelines and procedures.

#### **School Bus Information**

The bus schedules are provided as a guide for parents and should not be considered as final. Schedules can change as students enter and withdraw from the district. Every effort will be made to follow these schedules for the start of school. After the first week of school, the bus driver will inform the students and/or parents of any change.

Any requests for consideration of changes in bus stops should be submitted to the Office of Transportation, Kiski Area Central Administration, 200 Poplar Street, Vandergrift, PA 15690. All requests must be received in writing by September 15th in order to be considered for the present school year. Requests received after this date will be reviewed for possible implementation next year, unless exceptional circumstances exist (new resident, major construction project, etc.).

All requests for changes in transportation regarding pick up and drop off points will require a three day implementation period. All forms are available at www.kiskiarea.com on the Transportation Services link.

Please review the rules for school bus transportation in the student handbook. These rules have been established for safety reasons and all students will be expected to comply.

The bus driver is in complete charge of the bus and has the same authority as a teacher in the classroom. All drivers have undergone extensive training and testing to operate a school vehicle. They must devote all of their energies and skills to the safe operation of the vehicle and cannot be distracted by student discipline problems behind them.

Educating children on safe school bus riding is important in avoiding injuries inside and outside the school bus. Transportation Services can be reached at 724-842-0455.

#### Please remember the following:

- Leave home early enough to arrive at your bus stop 5 minutes prior to bus arrival.
- State Law says that bus stops are considered part of School District property therefore all school policies will apply.
- Wait for your bus in a safe place, well off the roadway.
- Enter your bus in an orderly manner, and take your seat immediately.
- Follow the instructions of your school bus driver.
- Remain in your seat while the bus is in motion.
- Keep your head and arms inside the bus at all times.
- Keep the aisle clear at all times.
- Remain quiet and orderly.
- Be courteous to your school bus driver and fellow passengers.
- Be alert to traffic when leaving the bus.
- NEVER retrieve an object you have dropped near the school bus. Tell the school bus driver and he/ she will help you.

Please take a few minutes to review these safety tips with your child. It could save a life.

#### Important Information for Kindergarten Parents:

To ensure the safety of our kindergarten students, a parent/guardian must be present at the bus stop before a student will be permitted to leave the bus. Kindergarten children not having someone to greet them at the bus stop will not be permitted to disembark and will be returned to their primary school. Parents will be contacted to come to the school to retrieve the child.
