

# **DR. KINSMAN TO BE BISHOP.**

**His Election Predicted at the Delaware Convention To-day.**

WILMINGTON, Del., June 2.—It is definitely announced that the Rev. Dr. Kinsman, member of the Faculty of the General Theological Seminary, New York, will be elected Bishop of Delaware on the first ballot at the Episcopal Convention here to-morrow.

The Rev. Dr. Frederick Joseph Kinsman has been Professor of Ecclesiastical History at the General Theological Seminary since 1903. He was born in Warren, Ohio, in 1869, and was educated at St. Paul's School, Concord, N. H., and at Keble College, Oxford, England. Since then he has been a Master of St. Paul's School, rector of St. Martin's Church, New Bedford, Mass., and Professor of Ecclesiastical History at Berkeley Divinity School, Middletown, Conn.
