Natural-color textures derive from Spot and Landsat satellite images, NOAA land cover data, and rasterized GIS linework draped on a digital elevation model using 3D software.
Vertical exaggeration is used. Foreground areas appear larger than comparably sized areas in the background because of the perspective.
The base of Haleakalā, which comprises all of east Maui, spans 33 miles (53 km) from La Perouse Bay in the west (NW) to Hana Bay in the east (right). The island of O'ahu, 120 miles (193 km) away and normally obscured by haze, is visible in this enhanced view.
