

PRATT'S GIFT TO AMHERST.

New Yorker Gave \$40,000 for Natatorium Dedicated Yesterday.

AMHERST, Mass., June 25.—The dedication of the new Pratt Natatorium, given to Amherst College by Harold I. Pratt, 1900, of New York, was the feature of today's observances of commencement week.

Mr. Pratt, Mortimer L. Schiff, '96, of New York; Dr. Edward Hitchcock, Athletic Supervisor, and President George Harris made addresses. The Brookline Swimming Club gave an exhibition in the large tank.

The building cost \$50,000, of which \$40,000 was given by Mr. Pratt for the natatorium, and \$10,000 by Mr. Schiff for squash tennis courts on the upper floor of the structure.
