

WILL HONOR GEN. BOYNTON.

President Promises to Attend the
Funeral—Gridiron Club Acts.

WASHINGTON, June 6. — President Roosevelt to-day promised a delegation representing the Army of the Cumberland that he would attend Gen. Boynton's funeral at 11 o'clock to-morrow morning unless something unexpected should occur to prevent him. The delegation consisted of Gen. Andrew S. Burke, Col. John Tweedale, and Gen. Carman.

A special meeting of the Gridiron Club was held at noon to-day at the offices of the Associated Press to take suitable action upon the funeral arrangements of Gen. Boynton.
