

## AN EDITOR MARRIED.

NEW-ORLEANS, Nov. 10.—Major Nathaniel Burbank, managing editor of the New-Orleans *Picayune*, was married last night to Miss Ella Burbank, daughter of a wealthy planter of Ascension Parish. The wedding was a strictly private affair. The groom was a journalist of Boston before the war. He accepted a commission in the regular Army, and served for several years on the staffs of Gen. Carby and Gen. Sheridan. He resigned at the close of the war, and attached himself to the New-Orleans press, making quite a general reputation as a writer of pointed, pungent paragraphs and humorous sketches.
