1254-vest Rough Vest



Suggested yarn:

 Pierrot Yarns Rough [56% cotton, 44% merino wool; 133 yds/122m per 1.4 oz./ 40g skein]; color #02 sheer blue, 6 skeins [235g]

Tools/Notions:

• 3.3mm (approx. US 3) and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- chest 102cm/40.2"
- cross back width 44cm/17.3"
- back length 61.5cm/24.2"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 23 sts and 31 rows
- pattern stitch: 26 sts and 31 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Back: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing, then continue in st st.

Front: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing, then continue in pattern stitch, taking care to always knit the 2 stitches at each edge (purl when on wrong side).

Finishing: Seam shoulders with slip stitch seam. Seam sides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline and armholes, respectively; work edging in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

k = knit


p = purl

PU = pick up

RE = row(s) even

st st = stockinette stitch

#-#-# = rows-stitches-times




Finishing: collar & armhole edging
