A recent poll of likely Republican primary voters in Alabama conducted by WPA Intelligence on behalf of Club for Growth PAC shows that Jeff Sessions and Tommy Tuberville are leading the race with Bradley Byrne a distant third.

If the election were held today, Jeff Sessions and Tommy Tuberville would advance to a run-off.

Jeff Sessions leads the field with 34% of the vote. Tommy Tuberville is in second with 29% and would join Sessions in a run-off if the election were held today. Bradley Byrne is in third place, 12 points behind Tuberville.

Methodology

WPAi conducted a poll of n = 600 likely Republican primary voters in Alabama. Interviews were conducted using live telephone interviews to cell phones (43% of interviews) and interactive voice response (IVR) calls to landlines from February 10-12, 2020. The survey has a margin of error of $\pm 4.0\%$. Sample was selected from the Alabama voter file with the probability of selection being equal to the probability of voting in the March Republican primary election in WPAi's turnout model. Sample was stratified by age, gender, and geography to ensure accurate representation of the electorate.
