## **B.3** Type of Allocation of Quota Places:

The quota place/s is/are allocated to the NOC. The selection of athletes for its allocated quota place(s) is at the discretion of the NOC subject to the eligibility requirements.

## C. ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

All athletes must comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter currently in force included but not limited to, Rule 41 (Nationality of Competitors) and Rule 43 (World Anti-Doping Code and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of Manipulation of Competitions). Only these athletes who comply with the Olympic Charter may participate in the Olympic Winter Games Beijing 2022.





## C.1 Age Requirements:

All athletes participating in the Olympic Winter Games Beijing 2022 must be born before 1 January 2007 in accordance with <u>Article 406.1: The Age Classification of Competitors of the International Ski</u> Competition Rules.

## C.2 Medical Requirements:

To be eligible to participate in the Olympic Winter Games Beijing 2022, all athletes must satisfy the medical requirements in accordance with <u>Article 221: Medical Services, Examinations and Doping of the International Ski Competition Rules (ICR).</u>

## C.3 Additional IF Requirements:

## C.3.1 Qualification Eligibility Criteria

Athletes are eligible for selection by their NOC who have gained at least one (1) FIS World Cup or Grand Prix point during their career, or at least one (1) Continental Cup point during the qualification period (1 July 2020 – 16 January 2022).

## C.3.1.1 Participation in Men's Team and Mixed Team events

Participation in the Men's Team and Mixed Team events are only available to athletes who have qualified to participate in the individual Ski Jumping events in the Olympic Winter Games Beijing 2022.

## D. QUALIFICATION PATHWAY

## **QUALIFICATION PLACES**

<u>D.1:</u>	D.1. Olympic Quota Allocation List and Continental Cup Olympic List	
Men: 60	The allocation of quotas per NOCs with athletes that are eligible is based on the Olympic Quota Allocation List which is calculated using the FIS World Cup and Summer Grand Prix standings for two (2) seasons added together from 1 July 2020 – 16 January 2022.	
Women:40		
	When there are no further athletes ranked on the Olympic Quota Allocation List, the Continental Cup Standings from two (2) seasons added together 1 July 2020 – 16 January 2022 (Continental Cup Olympic List) is used.	
	The allocation will be made by assigning one (1) quota place per athlete from the top of the standings downwards until the total of 60 male and 40 female athletes is reached including the host country individual and/or additional team place/s.	
	Once an NOC has achieved the maximum number of five (5) male quota places, respectively four (4) female quota places, its remaining athletes will no longer be counted and the NOC with the next eligible athlete on the Olympic Quota Allocation List will be allocated a quota place. If there are no more quota places to be allocated on the Olympic Quota Allocation List, the NOC with the next eligible athlete on the Continental Cup Olympic List will be allocated a place.	
	If there is a tie for the final allocated quota place(s) on either the male or female Olympic Quota Allocation Lists, the athlete with the highest ranking on the World Cup standings as of 17 January 2022 will be ranked ahead. If there is still a tie, the end of season World Cup standings 2020/2021 will be used.

	If there is a tie for the final allocated quota place(s) on either the male or female Continental Cup Olympic Lists, the athlete with the highest ranking on the Continental Cup standings as of 17 January 2022 will be ranked ahead. If there is still a tie, the end of season Continental Cup standings 2020/2021 will be used.	
	Athletes already counted for a quota place in the Olympic Quota Allocation List will skipped for the allocation of quota in the Continental Cup Olympic List.	
<u>D.2:</u>	D.2. Allocation of quota places for the Men's Team competition	
Men: 5	After the allocation of 60 male quota places have been made, in the event there are less than 12 NOCs with four (4) athletes allocated quota places, the NOC with the next eligible athletes on the Olympic Quota Allocation List and which has three (3) allocated quota places will be allocated an additional quota place to enable the NOC to participate in the Men's Team competition. This allocation will continue until there are 12 NOCs with four (4) eligible athletes.	
	Thereafter, if there are any remaining places, they will be allocated with a maximum of one (1) quota place to NOCs not yet allocated a men quota (including the host country) with athletes on the Olympic Quota Allocation List, followed by the Continental Cup Olympic list until the total of 65 male athletes is reached according to <b>D.1</b> .	
<u>D.3:</u>	D.3. Mixed Team Event	
	All NOCs that have been allocated a minimum of two (2) male and two (2) female athletes will be eligible to enter a team in the Mixed Team Event.	

## **HOST COUNTRY PLACES**

The athlete/s selected to fill the host country quota places must meet the athlete eligibility criteria as defined in **Section C**. If no athlete from the host country is able to fulfil the athlete eligibility criteria defined in Section C, the host country place/s will be allocated according to **D.1**.

If the host country has not earned at least one (1) quota place in the respective gender based on the allocation of quotas described under clause D.1 and D.2, one (1) male athlete will be permitted to enter in the Men's Normal Hill Individual and Men's Large Hill Individual competitions and one (1) female athlete will be permitted to enter in the Women's Normal Hill Individual competition subject to the athletes meeting the athlete eligibility in section C and the qualification eligibility criteria as described in **C.3.1**.

## Participation in the Men's Team and Mixed Team Events

In order for the host country to participate in the Men's and Mixed Team competition, the host country must have earned the required four (4) quota places within the maximum total quota, and the athletes are eligible according to section C eligibility requirements and the qualification criteria in **C.3.1**.

## **Participation in the Mixed Team Event**

In the case that the host country earned a minimum of two (2) female quota places according to D.1, but was not allocated two (2) male quota places, the host country is eligible to participate in the Mixed Team Event with two (2) female Ski Jumping athletes and up to (2) Nordic Combined male athletes. The athletes from Nordic Combined must meet the athlete eligibility in section C and the qualification eligibility criteria as described in **Section C.3** of the Nordic Combined Qualification System and must be entered in the Nordic Combined events.





All athletes must have been entered as part of the allocated NOC quota. The above quotas will be allocated on 17 January 2022 in accordance with **Section G. Qualification Timeline**. The host country NOC is required to confirm its use of allocated quota places to FIS by 18 January 2022.

## E. CONFIRMATION PROCESS FOR QUOTA PLACES

The confirmation process for quota places will be carried out via the FIS on-line system. Each NOC will be provided with log-in details prior to 17 January 2022.

Please refer to **Section G. Qualification Timeline** for the timeline of the quota publication, confirmation and reallocation dates.

## F. REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUOTA PLACES

## REALLOCATION OF UNUSED IF QUOTA PLACES

If an allocated quota place is not confirmed by the NOC by 18 January 2022, or is declined by the NOC, the quota place will be reallocated to the next eligible NOC according to the system described in **D.1**.

## REALLOCATION OF UNUSED HOST COUNTRY PLACES

Unused Host Country Place(s) will be reallocated to the next eligible NOC according to the system described in **D.1**.
