Police Director JAIME HERMO MORENTE, CEO VI (Retired) brings extensive experience in public service and police operations to the position of Commissioner, Bureau of Immigration. The proud son of Midsayap, Cotabato is a member of the Philippine Military Academy "Dimalupig" Class of 1981.
