

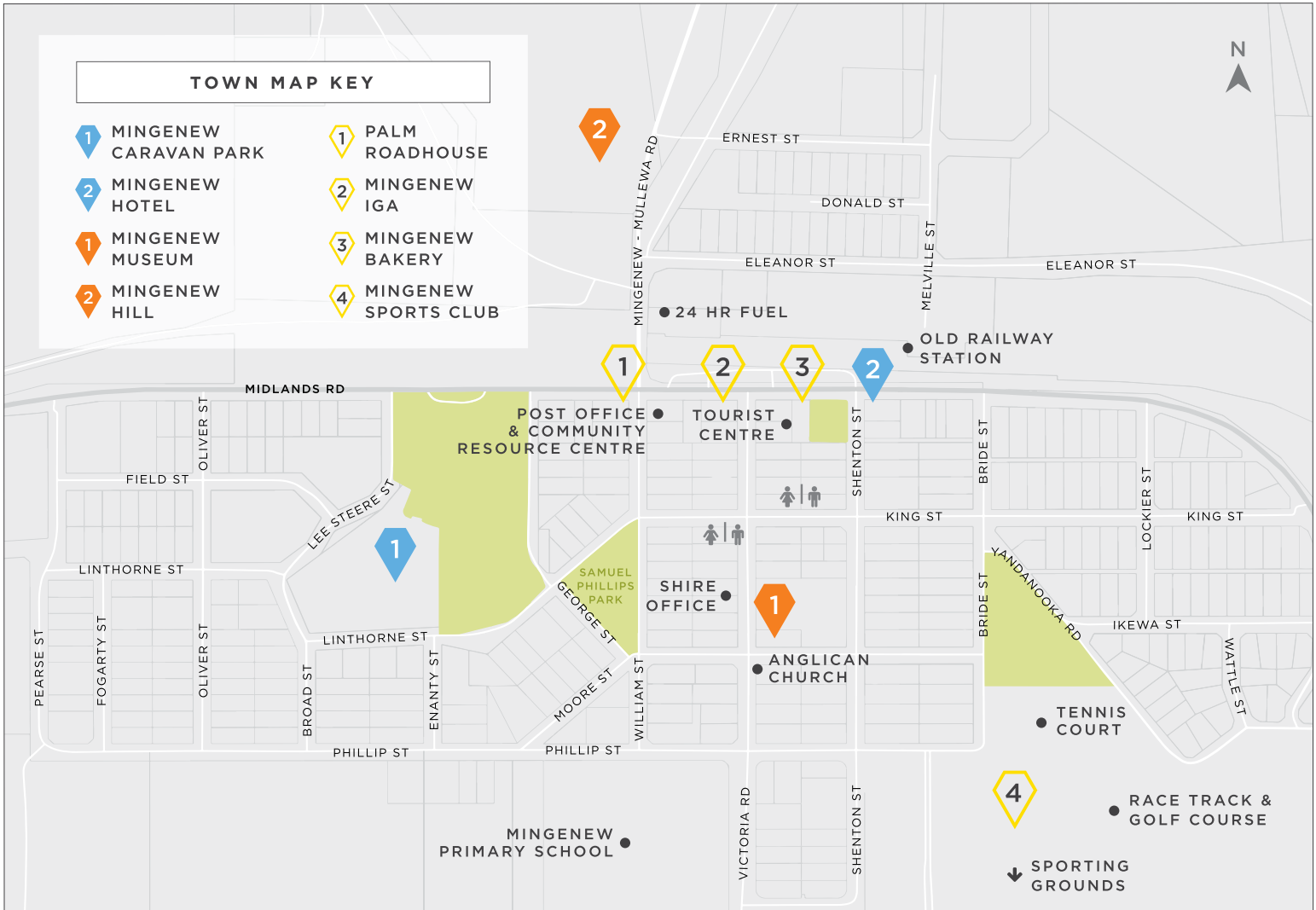

WHERE TO STAY



**MINGENEW HOTEL**  
 Located in the centre of town is the recently renovated Mingenew Hotel. Sit back, relax and enjoy a refreshing drink at one of the Mid-West's most iconic pubs.

**MINGENEW CARAVAN PARK**  
 Park owner, Carol, makes sure that you always feel most welcome in the Mid West's friendliest caravan park, which also offers accommodation.

**YANDANOOKA HALL**  
 Head 20 km south to find a fantastic nature spot for campers. It is RV friendly and free for up to 72 hours, but be aware there are no toilet facilities.

**COALSEAM NATIONAL PARK**  
 Situated by the Irwin River, Miners Campground permits caravans and tents and offers BBQ and toilet facilities. Camping fees and stay limits may apply.

**ENANTY BARN**  
 Just out of Mingenew, Enanty Barn offers free camping for self-contained vehicles. Head in to Mingenew for food, drinks and entertainment.

WHAT TO SEE

**COALSEAM NATIONAL PARK**  
 Arguably the most spectacular wildflower site in Western Australia and Mingenew is right on its doorstep!



**DEPOT HILL**  
 Just a few minutes from Mingenew, Depot Hill provides one of Wildflower Country's most beautiful walks.



**MINGENEW MUSEUM**  
 Our local historians keep the Mingenew Museum in beautiful condition, with artifacts dating right back to the 1850s.



**ASTROTOURISM**  
 With clear air and very little light pollution, Mingenew's night skies are perfect for stargazing and astrophotography.



**MINGENEW HILL**  
 Just over the railway line on Mingenew - Mullewa Rd, you'll find breathtaking views. Mingenew Hill is perfect for picnics and shutterbugs!



**LITTLEWELL RESERVE**  
 Explore the historical site where Aboriginal farm workers and their families lived from the 1930s-1970s, featuring first-hand accounts of life on the Reserve.



**YANDANOOKA HALL**  
 Just out of town, in season Yandanooka is covered in a carpet of wildflowers. Pack your camera, a picnic and head off to make some memories.



**WILDFLOWER COUNTRY**  
 Geographically and 'flowerfactually', Mingenew is the very heart of WA's Wildflower Country. Come and visit wildflower heaven.
