

## *FUNERAL OF MRS. HURST.*

The funeral services over the remains of Mrs. Caroline Elise Hurst, late wife of F. W. J. Hurst, manager of the National line of steam-ships, were held at the residence of her father, Edward S. Jaffray, No. 615 Fifth-avenue, yesterday afternoon. Mrs. Hurst, who was much beloved by a large circle of friends, died at the early age of twenty-nine, at Long Branch, on the 12th instant. Rev. Dr. Morgan, of St. Thomas' Episcopal Church, conducted the services, Rev. Mr. Paxton, of the First Presbyterian Church, assisting. A large number of mourning friends were assembled in evidence of their respect for the memory of the deceased lady. A beautiful collection of flowers rested upon the coffin and in a room where the body was laid. About 4 o'clock P. M., the cortége started, and proceeded slowly down the avenue to the First Presbyterian Church, where the body was quietly deposited in the family vault.
