Entries close:

International entries close <u>Tuesday 26 February 2019</u>, 23:59 hours BWF Headquarters time (+8:00 hours GMT). New Zealand Player entries close <u>Thursday 21 February 2019</u>, 23:59 local time.

Entries:

All players in the tournament will be deemed to have read and accepted the conditions under which the tournament events are to be conducted. The competition regulations of the BWF shall apply.

The organisers will NOT be responsible for any injury sustained, at any time, by any player or official arising from their participation in this Tournament. Any costs incurred for medical treatment and/or hospitalisation shall be borne by the Member Association of the player/official concerned.

All International entries are to be submitted online by the competitors' National Badminton Association (MA). The online entry page will automatically close on Tuesday 26 February 2019 at 23:59 hours BWF Headquarters time (+08:00h GMT) and you are required to submit the entries on time. Late entries will not be accepted.

After the closing date, the BWF Online Entry System will send a notification to all participating Member Associations confirming receipt of final entries. Receipt of this notification is the conclusive evidence of receipt of entries before the deadline. The Member Associations should contact BWF immediately if such notice is not received by the Wednesday (next day of the entries closing date) by noon BWF Headquarters time (+08.00h GMT) following close of entries.

If no objection is received by BWF by Thursday 28 February 2019 (second day after the entries closing day) 23.59 hours BWF Headquarters time (+08.00h GMT) following the close of entries, the entries shall be deemed to be correct. No complaints / objections shall be entertained after this point.

Meeting Times:

The Managers meeting will be held at Novotel Tainui on Wednesday 27 March at 7pm. All countries to ensure they have a representative at this meeting. It is compulsory that all team managers must attend the team managers meeting. Failing to attend the meeting a Member Association may be fined USD\$250 by Badminton Oceania. Member Associations can make a request someone to represent them at the meeting as long as the Referee is advised in advance.

Withdrawals:

Withdrawals will be managed according to the BWF regulations.

Withdrawals after Monday 11 March shall automatically attract withdrawal fees as per BWF regulations. No refunds for withdrawals will be given once the draw is published.

Withdrawals until 11 March must be initiated through online entry system by logging on to the tournament link used for sending the entry. Withdrawals after that date must be informed by e-mail to <u>events@waikatobadminton.co.nz</u> and the Referee Julie Carrel <u>julie.carrel.nz@gmail.com</u> as soon as possible. After the player/s arrive at the venue, notification of withdrawal must be made by the Team Manager and/or player to the Referee in person.

Transport:

Transport is available from **Hamilton Airport (HLZ)** or **Auckland Airport (AKL)** on Monday 25 March, and for players participating in the North Harbour International 2019 the week prior. Transport will be arranged in groups to suit the times of the greatest number - please be aware players and officials may be allocated a time requiring a longer wait at the airport. Transport forms with flight details must be provided <u>no later than 18 March 2019</u> for pick-up and drop-off to be arranged. Any request after this date will not be accepted. Requests for a refund of taxi charges will not be entertained.

Competition Rules and Regulations:

The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the BWF General Competition Regulations and as per the Badminton Oceania Grade 3 Tournament Regulations. The BWF Council, as per the authority delegated to it from the membership at the AGM 2018, decided not to change the Laws related to fixed service height. Therefore the following BWF Service law will be used:

BWF Service Law 9.1.6 – The whole shuttle shall be below 1.15 metres from the surface of the court at the instant of being hit by the server's racket.

Shuttles:

BWF approved Yonex shuttles will be used, 2 speeds will be available.



Clothing and Advertising:

Clothing and advertising are in accordance with the BWF General Competition Regulations (sections 19-23). The name of the player is <u>Mandatory</u> on the back of all player's shirts, the country name is optional. Players should ensure that they read these regulations and that their clothing complies with these.

Doping Control:

The BWF Anti-Doping Regulations apply.
