Update on steps taken to mitigate COVID-19 impact in Gujarat

- Entire Country is put under lockdown starting from 25.3.2020 to 14.04.2020 midnight by central government. All non-essential services such as shops, offices, factories, workshops will be completely closed. Only essential services will continue such as:
 - Essential commodities such as such as milk, vegetables, food items etc.
 - Drug stores, hospitals, laboratory drug manufacturing units, research centers
 - Animal food, animal drugs and hospitals
 - Internet and mobile services
 - Water, electricity and other essential services
 - Print, electronic and social Media channels
 - Insurance companies, Banks, Posts, Security etc.
 - Petrol Pumps etc.
- To overcome COVID-19, A purchase committee to oversee procurement under chairmanship of Mr. Pankaj Joshi (ACS-FD) has been framed.
- To facilitate implementation of COVID related activities, four senior IAS officers have been stationed at regional level.

- To monitor COVID-19 related activities, following responsibilities assigned to four senior IAS officers.

Shri Lochan Shahera, IAS : To monitor urban area
Smt. Manisha Chandra, IAS : O.P.D. / I.P.D. in IMA & Private Hospitals
Shri Harshadkumar Patel, IAS : To monitor Rural area
Shri Jenu Devan, IAS & : Techo and IDSP related issues
Shri Amit Yadav, IAS
- All passengers arriving at airport were screened as per the national guidelines and were put under home quarantine for 14 days.

- Additionally, all persons coming in contact with positive cases are being contact traced and put under home/government quarantine.
- All home quarantined people are visited daily for 14 days by FHW/MPHW or other health care workers.
- If anyone is found to be violating home quarantine, they are put under facility quarantine with the help of competent authority. Total **251** quarantine facilities have been created with **13,006** beds available in these facilities.
- House to house survey of entire state is being conducted through TeCHO+ app as per IDSP checklist. Any person found to have symptoms is put under quarantine. So far **5,01,35,152** people have been screened, out of that **71,132** persons have travel history observed. Out of that **58350** persons have inter State travel history observed and **12,782** persons have foreign travel history observed. Investigation is under progress for **181** persons whom signs of disease observed.
- Four special COVID hospitals at Ahmedabad (**1200**), Surat (**500**), Vadodara (**250**) and Rajkot (**250**) beds is being operationalized.
- Isolation facilities are being developed at every district- one in public sector and one in private sector, each of **50** bed capacity. Currently **1583** isolation beds in public facilities and **635** beds in private sector are available.
- Total **1061** ventilators are available in public sector and approximately **1700** ventilators are available in private sector.
- Isolation wards with ventilators and other latest facilities have been started. At present in the state there are **4300** isolation beds are available in the government hospitals and **635** isolation beds are available in the private hospitals.
- State government has notified reporting of any suspected case by any hospital (public, private, corporate, trust etc.) and all practitioners (private clinic doctors, AYUSH etc.) are also mandated to report such cases.
- Decision has been taken to strengthen human resource, the services of officers and staff of Ex-Serviceman have been used.

- Dr. Techo Application has been started by the Health & Family Welfare Department to get information of SARI cases from all hospitals & Doctors in the state.

Laboratory Testing

- Five medical College Hospitals at Ahmedabad, Vadodara, Surat, Bhavnagar, Jamnagar and two private labs, Newbarg Supratech Laboratory, Ahmedabad and Unipeth Laboratory, Ahmedabad are certified for the COVID Lab testing. Till 28-03-2020, total **1144** samples are tested, out of that **58** samples observed positive and **1073** samples are observed negative and **13** sample is pending.

Drugs and Logistics

- Personal protective equipment's and hand sanitizers are available in sufficient quantity. N-95 masks **9.75 lac**, PPE kits **3.58** and Triple layer masks 1.23 caror are available. Orders have been placed to purchase 150 ventilator.
- For COVID-19, Tab. Hydroxychloroquine is declared as schedule H1 drug and now it will be available only by doctor's prescription.

Community Awareness & Social Distancing

- Religious leaders, senior doctors & famous singers giving message e.g. kinjal Dave, Dr. Bharat Bhagat etc.
- Total **20** Videos and **7** Radio jingles created
- **15** state +**27** district channels are playing messages
- **330** hoardings put up across the state
- More than **500** Ads in newspaper (half + quarter page)
- Proactive social messaging through various social media platforms like twitter, face book, YouTube channel etc.
- More than **200** LCD and LED screens at railways stations
- **400** acrylic sign boards are placed at sachivalaya.

Protect yourself and others follow these Do's and Don'ts

Do's

- Practice frequent hand washing. Wash hands with soap and water or use alcohol-based handrub. Wash hands even if they are visibly clean
- Cover your nose and mouth with handkerchief/tissue while sneezing and coughing
- Throw used tissues into closed bins immediately after use
- See a doctor if you feel unwell (fever, difficult breathing and cough). While visiting doctor wear a mask/cloth to cover your mouth and nose
