*Daily report on Public Health measures taken for*

*COVID-19 Infection prevention and control*

WHO has declared COVID-19 affecting 144 countries as Pandemic. In this context, Government of Tamil Nadu has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease, as per the national guidelines.

All the passengers from all the international flights are screened universally through thermal screening. All over India the screening is carried out in 30 airports. In Tamil Nadu, till date 180062 passengers are screened at the Airports of Chennai, Trichy, Madurai, and Coimbatore. 2221 passengers are under home quarantine for 28 days and 22 are under hospital isolation.

Till now 98 samples have been taken from the passengers and sent for testing at King Institute of Preventive Medicine & Research, Guindy Chennai, National Institute of Virology, Pune, Theni VRDL, Thiruvavur VRDL and Tirunelveli VRDL. The samples of 96 passengers are processed of which 95 samples are negative, 1 sample positive for COVID-19 infection and 2 samples are in transit.

One COVID-19 positive patient admitted in RGGGH, Chennai is stable and under continuous observation. Results of his two consecutive samples taken 24hrs apart are tested negative. Hence the passenger and the contact has been stepped down from isolation ward. Health status of his contacts under home quarantine are stable.

In the background of the present COVID-19 pandemic, the general public are advised to adhere to health advisories issued by the state Government. Public should follow the cough etiquette by covering the face using handkerchief / towel while sneezing / coughing. Do frequent hand-washing with soap and water.

People are advised to refrain from travelling to China, Hong Kong, Republic of Korea, Italy, Iran, France, Spain & Germany and advised to avoid non-essential travel to other COVID-19 affected countries. All people coming from China, Hong Kong, Republic of Korea, Italy, Iran, France, Spain & Germany or having such travel history should remain under strict home quarantine or hospital isolation for 28 days from the date of arrival in India.
