KOM-back in Saudi Arabia

Distribution of Komatsu Heavy Equipment via Joint Venture

In the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, one of the fastest growing countries in the world, Komatsu has established a new partnership with Abdul Latif Jameel Summit Company (ALJS), a joint venture company between the Abdul Latif Jameel Group, a conglomerate of international repute and the largest automotive business houses in Saudi Arabia; and Sumitomo Corporation, one of the largest Japanese trading firms actively operating in the Middle East. Branded as Abdul Latif Jameel Heavy Equipment, the new venture company sells technologically advanced Komatsu equipment in the Saudi Arabia market.

The joint venture started its operation from the ground up in early 2013 and in just one year successfully held the official launching ceremony on

March 5, 2014 at the Ritz Carlton Hotel in Riyadh, the capital city of Saudi Arabia.
