Update on steps taken to mitigate COVID-19 impact in Gujarat

- Entire Country is put under lockdown starting from 25.3.2020 to 14.04.2020 midnight by central government. All non-essential services such as shops, offices, factories, workshops will be completely closed. And proper care has been taken for people may not face any difficulties.
- Arrangement has been made for Thelesemia and other Himoglobinopathy affected patients may get treatment in district and Taluka level hospitals with the help of Indian Red Cross society as per the instruction given by the Hon. Chief Minister.
- Till Dt. 31/03/2020 Thelesemia and other Himoglobinopathy affected 97 patients have supplied 123 units blood by the Red Cross Society with the help of Government Hospitals. Medicines also provided to 52 children.
- Decision have been taken to carry out the intensive surveillance in the state under the monitoring of commissioner of health due to more local transmission observed.
- The list of 1500 people gathered at Nizhamuddin area of Delhi, sent by the Central Government is forwarded to the districts and started tracking and collection of related information.
- To overcome COVID-19, A purchase committee to oversee procurement under chairmanship of Mr. Pankaj Joshi (ACS-FD) has been framed.
- To facilitate implementation of COVID related activities, four senior IAS officers have been stationed at regional and district level.

- To establish "Infection Control Disease" Hospital at district level following officers are appointed by the State Government.

- To monitor COVID-19 related activities, following responsibilities assigned to four senior IAS officers.

- Special COVID hospitals at Ahmedabad (1200), Surat (250), Vadodara (250) and Rajkot (250) and other Districts (100 in each district), Total of 4650 beds is being operationalise.
- Isolation wards with ventilators and other latest facilities have been started. At present in the state there are 4300 isolation beds are available in the government hospitals and 635 isolation beds are available in the privet hospitals.
- Decision has been taken to strengthen human resource, the services of officers and staff of **Ex-Serviceman** have been used.
- Dr. Techo Application has been started by the Health & Family Welfare Department to get information of SARI cases from all hospitals & Doctors in the state.

Ventilators & Ventilator care Training

- Total 1061 ventilators are available in public sector and approximately 1700 ventilators are available in private sector. Orders have been placed to purchase 1000 ventilators.
- Ventilator care training is started from 21-03-20 and till 30-03-20 a total of 738 health care personnel are trained which included 189 MBBS MO, 57 Ayush MO, 114 Dental surgeon and 378 Physiotherapist/Staff Nurses.
- From 01-04-20, total 28 centers are designated for this training in which 1400 healthcare personnel will be trained in one day.

- Training regarding COVID-19 will be given to 2367 Medical Officers, 1300 Ayurvedic doctors, 260 Physiotherapist, 266 Dental Surgeons and 5000 Staff Nurses.

Laboratory Testing

- 6 medical College Hospitals at **Ahmedabad, Surat, Vadodara, Bhavnagar, Jamnagar, Rajkot** and 3 private labs, **Newbarg Supratech Laboratory, Ahmedabad and Unipeth Laboratory, Ahmedabad and Pan Jino Mix Laboratory, Ahmedabad** are certified for the COVID Lab testing.

Drugs and Logistics

- Personal protective equipment's and hand sanitizers are available in sufficient quantity. N-95 masks **9.75 lac**, PPE kits **3.58 lac** and Triple layer masks 1.23 crore are available. For COVID-19, Tab. Hydroxychloroquine is declared as schedule H1 drug and now it will be available only by doctor's prescription.

- **1100 Helpline and Facility of Telemedicine**

Helpline no. **1100** have been started at GVK EMRI 108 Kathwada, Ahmedabad to help people who are in isolation and home quarantine for their physical and mental health related problems. In that M.B.B.S., M.D. physician, Clinical psychologist and Psychiatrist will give Tele medicine, Tele counselling and Tele advice round the clock 24x7 days. It will be in 4 shifts with 16 Counsellors and 4 Experts. Also one can contact on landline number 079-232-50818 in between 10:00 AM to 17:00 PM.

- Till 31-03-20 366 calls have been received, out of that 192 were for mental help and 173 calls were for physical help found.
- Due to COVID-19 lockdown situation, The Gujarat Cancer and Research Institute have also started telemedicine consultation. For that anyone can get help by dialling 079-22688028 number between 09:00 AM to 10:00 AM.
- In view of current COVID-19 situation, Gujarat Government has decided to extend retirement date for all health official/staff retiring on

31-03-20 and 30-04-20 to 31-05 20. This will ensure that state gets benefit of experience of all these health care officers/staff.

- Furthermore, State Government has also decided to appoint medical officers on 11 months contract at all Government medical colleges to ensure availability of additional medical officers in State.
