 Laws of Badminton / Competition
 Regulations – modified to include various
 categories / rules for people with a disability



- 2. Classification system describes the medical conditions a person has which affects their sport performance group / categorize people for fair competition
- 3. Current classification system is under review currently two main categories
- ✓ Wheelchair class WC1, WC2, WC3
- Standing Classs STL1 / STL2 / STL3 / STU4 / STU5

#### Parabadminton World Federation

- ✓ Founded in 1995
- ✓ Changed name in 2009 IBAD PBWF
- ✓ Governs / manages para-badminton



✓ Soon its functions are to become part of the BWF





## Integration – PBWF – BWF

- o 27 November 2009 Bali Council meeting
  - ✓ BWF Parabadminton Commission established
  - ✓ Chair of PBWF is an invited member of Council
  - ✓ Delegated Chair of IOC/IR Committee / COO / to finalise an MOU PBWF and BWF
- MOU PBWF / BWF signed in May 2010
- This outlines the process / stages towards integration of PBWF and para-badminton into the governance and management structure of the BWF









## **Key Goals**

- Develop parabadminton on all levels players, coaches, technical officials, classifiers, event managers, administrator
- 2. Achieve inclusion of Parabadminton in Paralympic Games 2020





## Integration

 Integration - the inclusion and active participation from the para-badminton community in the governance, management, development and regulation of para-badminton.



Para-badminton to come under the auspices of one recognised international federation – the BWF

 3 June 2011 - PBWF EGM – PBWF membership to consider a proposal to give authority to BWF to govern and manage para-badminton – to dissolve their organisation
