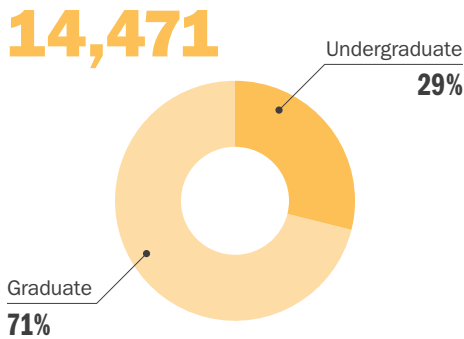


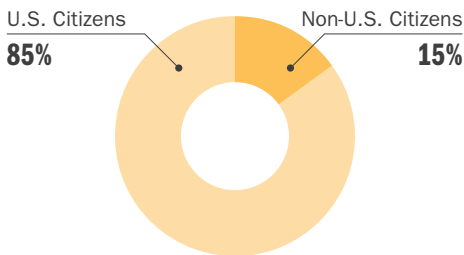

WORLDWIDE STUDENTS: U.S. VS. NON-U.S. CITIZENSHIP



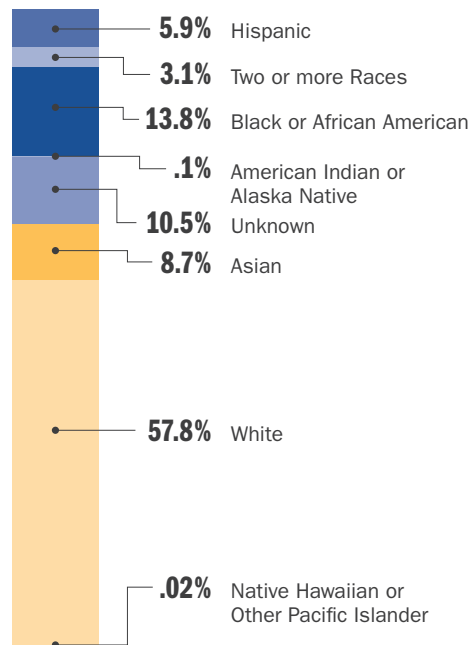
Percentage of '16-'17 worldwide undergraduate degree recipients that have studied abroad: **20%**

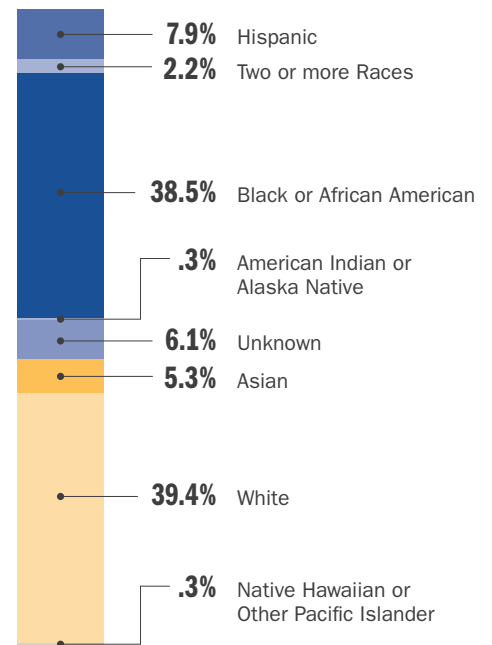

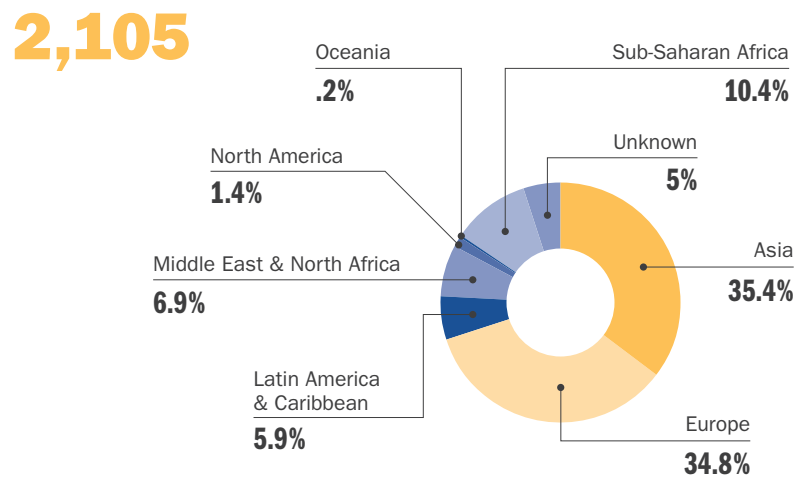

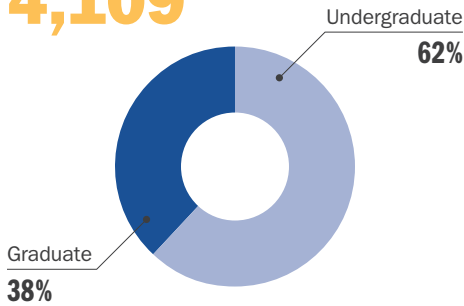
WORLDWIDE NON-US CITIZENS BY REGION OF CITIZENSHIP

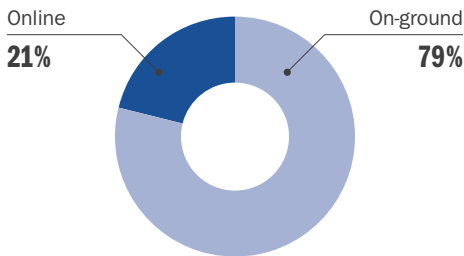
