AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency 2122 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has 23been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to

each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is
