

難得一身好本領!

盧國沾的一身本領包括為報章、雜誌撰 文,從事電視、電台、電影等媒體工作,以 至經營出版、廣告及貿易等業務,作詞從來 都是業餘手作,卻令這位兼職詞人享譽香港 樂壇。

拿著中文大學中文系的學位,盧沾(行內 盧國沾與寶貝女葦蓁 對他的暱稱)畢業後第一份工作是在無綫電視

做周刊記者,然後獲賞識轉到市場推廣部工作,一做便是十年;接著出現了香 港電視史上的「六君子事件」,在梁淑怡帶領下,一干人跳槽佳視;兩年後, 佳視倒閉,於是加入麗的電視任職宣傳總監,三個年頭過後,才正式告別十五 年的電視生涯,開始自己的事業。期間盧沾在工餘寫了過千首粵語流行曲及廣 告的歌詞,當中獲獎無數。

盧沾雖沒有拜師學作詞,但對歌詞的要求卻相當嚴謹,既講究文字的美 感,亦追求豐富的詞意,他認為流行歌詞應是優秀的文學作品,題材不限於男 女之情,他關心社會與國家民族,惦念遠方的鄉土,正是這份廣闊的襟懷及深 厚的文字功力,令他的作品,即使經歷年月變更,仍堪細味。

七六年,盧沾因在無綫工作,有機會發表第一首詞作《田園春夢》,隨之 出現的有《乘風破浪》、《錦繡前程》、《心有千千結》等等,盧沾的詞,於 此初露鋒芒。

八一年,憑《找不着藉口》獲頒「CASH最佳中文(流行)歌詞獎」,這首 作品運用了「棄車保帥」的寫法,將警句「來吧,講吧,無謂再等候,或者我 **愛得深,你找不着藉口**」留到最後,令人聽罷,低徊不已。小調式情歌在該 時期亦非常流行,《願君心記取》、《鮮花滿月樓》、《相識也是緣份》、 《情若無花不結果》等,婉約深情;寫別後重逢的《相逢有如夢中》更是文學 性甚強,意象極為豐富:「疏林過盡晚風,枯了小草老了壽松,浮雲白了天 空,初冬霧色已經變動......」,聽著歌詞,一幅幅蕭瑟冬景彷彿呈現眼前。其 他還有多首雋永情歌,例如《人在旅途洒淚時》、《殘夢》、《雪中情》等 等,今時今日的演唱會,依然有歌手選唱,依然感動樂迷的心。

盧沾的情歌,叫好叫座,但數拿手好戲,當推他的哲 理歌詞了。《每當變幻時》及《明日話今天》同奪七九年 「港台十大中文金曲獎」。加入麗的電視後,盧沾創作了 一系列劇集主題曲,如《變色龍》、《戲劇人生》、《天 蠶變》、《天龍訣》、《大內群英》、《太極張三豐》、 《大俠霍元甲》、《大地恩情》等皆深受樂迷歡迎,在詞 壇亦獲高度評價。《變色龍》是盧沾其中一首心頭好: 「讓我今後面對名共利,或者遲早心中有悔。有日我若再

回頭,笑望著人寰轉變」,他笑言這首詞是按劇情需要而 寫,卻也反映出自己當時心境,故印象特別深刻。

除蒼涼調子外,盧沾的詞亦以霸氣見稱,無綫時期的《小李飛刀》、《陸小鳳》及《决戰前夕》都是蒼涼中帶著一絲沉鬱,到了麗的時期所寫的《天蠶變》被公認為其武俠詞的巔峰之作,那種「冷眼對血路」的傲氣,「再與天比高」的霸氣,至今仍無人能出其右;而歷史人物劇《秦始皇》開首一句「大地在我腳下」,霸氣之盛,教人一聽難忘。

《大地恩情》是盧沾的最愛,亦是其寫鄉土情的代表作,畢竟字字句句總關情。事緣小 盧沾八歲隨祖母由新會潮蓮水鄉來港,當時稚子乘小艇離鄉,未懂報答江邊送行的母親,三 十年後感懷,於是寫成「**別我鄉里時,眼淚一串濕衣衫**」之句,「**若有輕舟強渡,有朝必定 再返**」更是多年素願。

盧沾的詞豐富多元·風格亦變化多樣,除上述經典外,還有清新愛情小品如《驟雨中的陽光》,寫溫馨父子情的《漁火閃閃》,古意盎然的《漁舟唱晚》,亦有悲情滄桑的《今生無悔》等等。盧沾對歌詞的理想,充份體現於八三年由他發起的「非情歌運動」。鑑於當時樂壇情歌氾濫,盧沾希望推動詞壇新風氣,故寫了不少非情歌作品,例如為理想「**策勵揚鞭,甘心做先驅**」的《夢想號黃包車》,被視為夫子自道的《傲骨》,寫饑民慘況的《螳螂與

我》,帶出反戰訊息的《小鎮》,寫國家民族情的《火燒圓明園》等等,都是發人深省的佳作。雖然非情歌作品並不是由盧沾首創,但其努力確曾為當時樂壇帶來一番新氣象。

盧沾説,每次作詞都很「驚青」,怕的是寫錯了, 交了出去,也就覆水難收,所以字字句句都得苦心經 營,填得好,也就份外有滿足感。問他作詞可有過人 之處?他謙稱自己只是較多一點認真、多一點誠意、 多一點心思。也許就是這麼的「一點點」,令盧沾的 詞經得起年月的考驗,到了今天,依然贏得樂迷及樂 界的掌聲。

im Lo is a well-known newspaper and magazine columnist, and a TV, radio and film veteran to boot. And what's more, he has also been successful in the publishing, advertising and trading industries. But while lyric writing has never been the focal point of his career, as fate would have it that is exactly what he is best known for.

Jim Lo, aka Lo Jim, left the Chinese University of Hong Kong with a bachelor degree in Chinese, and quickly got his first job at TVB as a journalist of its weekly magazine. It wasn't too long before he was transferred to the marketing department where he worked for almost a decade. In 1978, the 'Incident of Six Gentlemen' saw him following the lead of Selina Leung in an exodus to CTV, which closed its doors two years later. He wasn't out of work for long however, and soon joined RTV as Publicity & Promotion Controller, where he stayed for three years before starting his own business. Somehow between all of

this job swapping, he found time to pen the lyrics to over a thousand canto pop tunes and advertising jingles, many of which are award-winning pieces.

Lo might not have a mentor, but he is extremely serious about his art. For him, lyrics are meant to be aesthetically conceived and convey vivid images. He thinks of pop lyrics as a form of literature that touches on a much wider array of themes than just romance. He cares about society and longs for his distant homeland in China, and the combination of this broad vision and his monumental talent provides his lyrics with a timeless quality.

It was while working at TVB in 1976 that Lo released his first composition, 'The Spring Dream Of The Greenfield', which was hotly followed by other classics such as 'Cleaving The Waves', 'A Rosy Future' and 'A Thousand Knots In The Heart'. He was starting to make a name for himself.

In 1981, 'Can't Find The Excuse' won Lo the CASH Best Chinese Lyrics (Pop) Award. The song is deeply emotional and comes to the juddering close, "Com'n, say it, wait no more; Maybe my love is too deep, you can't find the right excuse". The coda is so impressive that it leaves the listeners reeling from the emotions present in it.

Ballads such as 'Hope You Remember Me By Heart', 'Flowery Moon Chamber', 'It Is Fate That We Met' and 'Love Without Flowers Will Bear No Fruits', are abundant with soothing, loving vibes. 'It's Like In The Dream We Met' describes the reunion of two lovers after a long separation, and has been dipped in the colour of Lo's literary palette: "The evening zephyr

seeps through the thin wood; Withers the grass, droops the pine; Floating clouds paint the sky white, as the colour of mist shifts in early winter..." Immersed in such picturesque phrasing, the listener is drawn into a tableau of winter days. Other great love songs written by Lo include 'Tears Shed In The Journey', 'Broken Dream' and 'Love In The Snow'. Even today, these songs are frequently sung at concerts and are just as moving as the day they were written.

But while Lo has always been good at writing love songs, his best work is still found in the more philosophically charged

pieces. 'Every Time When There Is A Change' and 'Tomorrow On Today' are superb examples of this, and both songs were rewarded with a RTHK Top Ten Chinese Gold Songs Award in 1979.

After joining RTV, Lo had written theme tunes for a number of popular TV drama series including *Chameleon, Dramatic Life, Reincarnated, Tian Lung Jeut, Dynasty, Tai Chi Master, Huo Yuanjia the Hero* and *The Grace of Homeland*. 'Chameleon' remains one of his personal favourites, in particular the words,

"Let me bask in fame and fortune, maybe someday I'll regret; One day if looking back, I'll smile to the changes in life". He explains that even though the lyrics were written in line with the story, they also reflected his frame of mind at that time.

'Dramatic Life' is commonly recognised as Lo's best philosophical composition, and the lyrics speak for themselves: "Wishes, always disheartened, who can ever understand your loneliness; Tears never stop falling, there're no justice and fairness in all matters ... Be happy when you can, sadness creeps in when the curtain drops; Stay drunk when you can, sweet memories once gone can never be captured again; Today you take the centre stage, why not forget the promises you made when you were drunk." The solitary and dejected spirit described is so real that some scholars claim the words are comparable to Xin Qiji's poem "A Farewell to Mo Jia the Twelfth Brother".

During his career, Lo has written a number of works which are sad and bleak. The theme songs he wrote

for the TVB dramas *The Swordsman Li, Luk Siu Fong* and *Eve Of The Duel* are all imbued with a sense of dismay, but the theme song for *Reincarnated* is different, and is still regarded as the apex of lyrics written for martial-arts drama series. The fortitude shown in *"Turning a cold eye to the bloody trail"* and the haughtiness expressed in *"Competing*"

with the Heaven" remain unmatched even today. The first line of 'Emperor Qin Shi Huang' - "The land is under my feet" - strikes the audience so hard that it is impossible to forget.

'The Grace Of Homeland' is Lo's personal favourite work, and is also the most in touch with the emotions of his fellow villagers. He came to Hong Kong from Xinhui with his Grandma at the tender age of eight, and when he was taken onto the boat he was too young to feel for his mother who was saying goodbye from the riverbank. Thirty years later, he revealed the emotions he felt at the time in the lines, "As I left my fellow villagers, my tears wet my clothes." He continues, "If there was a boat to brave the raging sea, I would return one day." Perhaps that is his simple wish after all these years.

Lo has always been celebrated in the music industry for his versatility. Aside from the well-known classics mentioned above, his repertoire also includes many other gems such as the refreshing love song 'Sunshine

In The Rain', the heart-warming folk song about a father-son relationship 'Glitters Of The Fishing Boats', the classy 'Evening Song Of Fishermen' that was adapted from a traditional tune, and the rueful 'No Regret'.

Lo's missionary mindset as a lyricist was manifested in the "Anti-ballad Campaign" initiated by him in 1983 - a time

when the music scene was awash with ballads, and he was determined to turn the tide by pursuing themes other than romance. And he succeeded too - 'A Rickshaw Named Dream' is all about ideals, 'Being Tough' which is regarded as a self-portrait of the lyricist, 'The Mantis And I' depicts the plight of the victims of famine, 'Small Town' is a cry for peace, and 'Burning Down The Yuanming Garden' is a patriotic ode. All of these tracks are inspirational masterpieces, and while Lo was not the first person ever to experiment with subjects such as these, his efforts did successfully breathen new life into the music scene at the time.

Lo readily admits that he approaches each new song with extreme care. He says if he were to write poor lyrics that were recorded, there would be nothing he could do to remedy that. So he puts his heart and soul into every job, and when he gets it right, the satisfaction is overwhelming. But does he consider himself to be a cut above the rest? He modestly suggests that maybe he is simply a little more serious, a little more sincere, and a little more creative than some of his contemporaries. Maybe it is an accumulation of all of these factors that give his lyrics such lasting vitality and applause.
