I. Active cases in the state:

(Note: As the reconciliation of 147 patients shown in MCGM region and 140 in Thane district as per the ICMR portal since 7th May 2020 is in process; they have not been included in the table above. Due to technical issues of the portal, information on discharged patients is until 3pm today.

This report is prepared based on figures provided by the authorized laboratories on Central Government's COVID-19 Portal. Because the laboratory report scrutiny and the availability of figures accordingly is an ongoing process, state cumulative numbers are subject to change.)

III. Some key observations:

- Recovery rate in the state is 47.2%
- Case fatality rate in the state: 3.7%
- Currently, 5,83,302 people are in home quarantine. There are 79,074 beds available in 1580 quarantine institutions and 28,200 people are in institutional quarantine currently.

IV. Deaths:

There were 113 COVID-related deaths reported in the state today. Circle-wise deaths as follows:

Other details of deaths:

Out of the 113 deaths today, 73 were men and 40 women. 65 of them aged over 60 years, 38 were from the age group 40 to 59 years and 10 were aged less than 40 years. Information regarding comorbidity status of 10 patients is not available yet. 83 out of the rest 103 patients (80.6%) had high-risk co-morbidities such as diabetes, hypertension, heart disease, etc. Death toll in Covid-19 patients has now gone up to 3830 in the state.

Out of the total deaths reported today, 73 deaths occurred in the last two days and the rest are from the period 27th May to 10th June 2020. Out of the 40 deaths in this period, 19 were recorded in Mumbai, 8 in Navi Mumbai, 4 in Solapur, 3 in Thane, 3 in Panvel, 1 was recorded in Kalyan-Dombivali, 1 in Pune and 1 in Satara.

V. Lab testing details:

Total 97 laboratories are functioning for COVID-19 diagnosis in the state currently – 55 government ones and 42 private ones. Out of 6,41,441 laboratory samples, 1,04,568 have been tested positive (16.3%) for COVID-19 until today.
