UK Judge Is Asked To Block Radio Super-group UNITED KINGDOM

The law governing radio company ownership in the UK received its stiffest legal test last week in a case that may pave the way for the creation of new super-groups of stations.

The UK Radio Authority has already decided that the 1990 Broadcasting Act would allow such groups to be established, but that decision was challenged in the High Court in London.

The case was instigated by the Guardian Media Group (GMG) which is objecting to the sanction given to EMAP Radio to buy a controlling interest in Trans World Communications. EMAP already owns 29.6% of Trans World, and GMG is a minority shareholder. Trans World holds five ILR franchises and runs eight stations, includ-(continues on page 16)

BBC Radio 1 Drops Romeo For Musical Subtleties Of Selector

New RAI Director Appointed

Government administrator Gianni Billia has been nominated as new Director General of Italian public broadcaster RAI. The nomination is the first official act of RAI's new board of governors appointed last week to replace the board forced to resign by Berlusconi's government.

Approval for Billia's nomination was expected in early August from RAI's minority shareholders, which include the state holding company IRI and a string of other state organisations including the authors rights society SIAE.

Popkomm Grows Into A True European Fair

In just six years, Popkomm has grown from its humble beginnings as a small German national fair with 1.250 attendees and 18 stands into a major European event attracting over 10,000 attendees with some 360 companies exhibiting this year. Last year exhibitors from other European countries were able to take part in the fair for the first time via collective stands ("country booths") under the banner "Meet The Nations". So successful was this expansion, that this year Popkomm has decided to open up to individual European exhibitors.

Popkomm MD Uli Großmaas says Popkomm's development from a national fair into a European event is a natural one. "In 1993, we opened up Popkomm to Europeans and we've had great feedback since then. This year we will see much more European participation with individual European exhibitors, as well as country booths. Popkomm is gradually developing into a European fair. It's been a special dynamic in the development of Popkomm, which we couldn't, and didn't want to, ignore. Popkomm's aim over the next few

years is to identify itself as a European event with the emphasis on European artists and repertoire

Großmaas is not afraid of Popkomm loosing its identity as a German music fair. "I think that as long as we keep our main nucleus of German companies, we have a very solid base for Popkomm." He also dismisses the views of some industry executives that Popkomm is growing too big. "There is a danger in Popkomm becoming too big, a danger that we have to be aware of. But it isn't a problem at the moment and I don't believe the (continues on page 15)

New FIMI President Caccia **Welcomes Sales-Based Chart**

ITALY

The arrival of a new president and a new purely sales-based chart are hoped to help Italian major label association FIMI inject new life into Italy's music industry.

CGD/Warner MD and MD of its CGD label Gerolamo Caccia Dominioni has replaced BMG Ariola MD Franco Reali as FIMI's new president. Reali could not stand for re-election according to the principles of "organisational bylaws."

Caccia welcomed the new chart, to be carried out by Danish market research company Nielsen, as the first of several new initiatives to be launched under his new presidency of FIMI. He listed FIMI's main objectives now as ensuring more transparency on the market via reliable statistics; continuing the fight against piracy; protecting rights, and a renewed commitment to the record as an artistic creation. "Both within the industry and on a political level we must award music the cultural recognition it deserves."

Caccia underlined the importance the long-awaited sales gauge based on scientific methodology. "Until now the charts have always been compiled on the basis of estimates," he said. "From January '95, record companies and media will have guaranteed statistics at their disposal, and the general public will be able to read or listen to a hit parade based on actual weekly sales."

Italy's two remaining charts have been criticised for their unreliable methodology, or the influence exercised on them by record companies. Meanwhile, state broadcaster RAI cancelled its own contract for a weekly chart with Italian market research company AGB as part of cost-cutting measures last January.

A spokesperson for the

Nielsen company in Italy said that 1.500 shops would be sampled with sales recorded using computerised point-of-sale bar code technology

Nielsen's contract with FIMI lasts for four years. Both organisations refused to reveal the value of the deal, however. The chart company compiles a sales chart

for the IFPI affiliate industry organisation in Denmark and is reportedly in negotiations with Belgium's IFPI affiliated group. The company supplied the official sales chart in France for several years until the contract was terminated last year, for what Nielsen describes as "various political reasons '

EC Gives Go Ahead To Advertising Probe

The European Commission [EC] has launched a study of obstacles to cross-border trade in advertising and marketing throughout the European Union. Results of the investigation are expected to be put forth in a Green Paper on Commercial Communication to be issued possibly as early as year end.

The probe will look into parameters for advertising, sponsorship, direct marketing, sales promotions and public relations within the EU.

One of the principle aims of the study is to gauge whether various national regulations are slowing down the ability of companies to conduct cross-border advertising within the EU, according to EC commissioner John Mogg, who is in charge of the study.

The EC has contracted the British Market Research Bureau International [BMRI] to survey 1.000 European advertising and marketing firms and associations to obtain possible examples of impediments to trade. The investigation was given the green light after more than a year of internal research on the matter by the DGXV EC directorate.

Many radio and TV planners are unhappy with the survey or the planned Green Paper, however, fearing the outcome will only be more red tape. EC Green Papers are often used as working papers for the Commission to churn out additional legislation in the form of directorates.

Tony Manwaring, a Londonbased director of Initiative Media, the second largest media buyer in Europe, calls the prospect of additional legislation "alarming" and predicts the cost of being buried in a mountain of bureaucratic paperwork is likely to offset any good that could come out of the Commission's efforts.

Frank Eijken, general director of IP, sales house for Holland's Happy RTL Radio and commercial TV stations RTL 4 and RTL 5, comments, "Another Green Paper just gives the opportunity for the people in Brussels to make new regulations, and rather than removing obstacles, it threatens to further compromise our freedoms to carry out cross border trade." Adds Eijken, "We can live with the 'TV Without Borders' directive, which already has sufficiently removed cross-border obstacles. I don't see the need for another one."

EUROPE AT A GLANCE

UNITED KINGDOM: JFM Regional Starts Testing

The UK's latest layer of ILR services began broadcasting last week, when JFM 100.4, the first of the country's four regional stations, started test transmissions in the north-west of England. JFM, which says its signal can be heard by 5.3 million adults, will emulate its London sister station's mix of jazz, blues and R&B and soul. Four other regional stations are due to come on line before the end of the year: Heart FM in the West Midlands of England, Galaxy serving the area centred on Bristol, Century Radio in the north-east of England and Scot FM in the Glasgow-Edinburgh region. SPAIN: Correo Newspapers Take Over Radio Tele Barcelona

Spain's largest newspaper group, Correo, has gained control of Radio Tele Barcelona in the Basque Country by buying the 45% owned by the media groups PRISA and TISA, which owned Antena 3 Radio through the joint management company Union Radio formed this year. In return, Correo will relinquish control to PRISA/TISA of one of its stations in the Basque capital of Vitoria. HL

SPAIN: Stations Settle Neighbouring Rights Levels

The 800-member Spanish commercial radio association (AERC) and the Spanish performing rights society (SGAE) signed a neighbouring rights agreement on July 15, which will regulate fees payable by stations until June 2004. The agreement classifies stations into three groups: those with under 10% of music time, those with 10-70% music time, and formula stations, who programme music in over 70% of their air time. Spain's commercial stations paid Pta850 million (US\$6.7 million) in rights to SGAE in 1993, and both sides described the new accord as "very positive." HL

UNITED KINGDOM: Howells Leaves PWL

David Howells, MD of PWL during its halcyon days as one of Europe's most successful independent labels, is leaving the company. Howells was with PWL for 10 years and oversaw the pan-European success of Kylie Minogue and Jason Donovan. Prior to his time with PWL, he ran his own Gull label which was the first home of Judas Priest. Describing his departure as "fairly amicable," Howells says he plans to re-enter the independent publishing and label market, adding that he feels there is still potential in the pop-dance sector. **JCM**

UNITED KINGDOM: Alliance Group Buys Castle Communications

Castle Communications, the London-based record and publishing group, has been bought by American record wholesaler The Alliance Group for £24.5 million. Castle chairman Terry Shand says Alliance's involvement will assist and accelerate Castle's international expansion. The Castle group's turnover in the last six months of 1993 was £18.7 million, producing a pre-tax profit of £1.13 million. **ICM**

POLAND: PolyGram Acquires Polish Label Izabelin

PolyGram International is continuing its expansion into eastern Europe with the acquisition of Polish record and publishing company Izabelin Studio. PolyGram is already represented in Hungary, the Czech Republic and Russia. The Warsaw-based company, a leading player in Polish-language repertoire with acts such as Hey, Big Day and Closterkeller, will become known as PolyGram Poland, though it will retain the Izabelin name for one of its labels. Izabelin founder Andrzej Puczynski will remain as president of the company reporting to PolyGram's president of continental Europe, Allen Davis. Davis says his company's move into Poland was made in the light of the country's new copyright law, which extends protection on records to 50 years.

FRANCE: Disney's Gangotena Heads Up PolyGram France

A senior Euro Disney executive is to be the new president of PolyGram France. Alfredo Gangotena, who has been vice president of marketing at Euro Disney since 1992, succeeds Gilles Paire, who is joining PolyGram International in London. Gangotena, who will be president and CEO, will report to Allen Davies, president of PolyGram Continental Europe. JCM

French authors rights society Sacem increased its collections in 1993 by 7.4%, with the bulk of revenues coming from private radio and television. That is according to the society's accounts report published in July. The society collected a total Ffr2.86 billion (app. US\$530 million) from music users in 1993, and distributed Ffr2.38 billion to authors, composers and music publishers.

Radio contributions rose 13.8% to Ffr210.7 million, with full-service stations RTL and Europe 1 paying Ffr67 million (a 5.5% increase), and public broadcaster Radio France paying Ffr76.4 million (a 5.6% increase). Meanwhile, private local station and FM networks paid Ffr58.1 million (a 45.7% rise, which can be explained by the increasing number of stations paying their dues to Sacem).

"Audiovisual media are becoming the main source of revenues for creators and music publishers." commented Sacem executive president Jean-Loup Tournier on the results. "In 1993, they represented 29.5% of the total rights collected."

Tournier noted a significant increase in collections from radio stations, adding that "Radio has confirmed its status of 'media of crisis,' easily accessible, not costly,

and easy to adapt to the needs of advertisers."

"The programming of most radio and television stations remains very open to local repertoire, which represents 57.1% of the rights from radio stations and 56.7% from TV channels," he said. "Over 60% of collections from France Inter, RTL, Europe 1, RMC and Radio Nostalgie is made of rights on local repertoire."

He added, however that "The trend which saw French repertoire becoming marginal on some FM networks has continued. Authors have reacted with vigour and supported a project voted by the parliament to implement a 40% quota of French chanson on radio stations.

Private Stations Encroach On Hamburg State Radio Audiences

Private radio stations have further increased their share of the tight Hamburg market, rising from 57.6% in 1993 to 60.3% of the city's listeners. Meanwhile the share of pubcaster Norddeutscher Rundfunk (NDR) in Hamburg dropped from 41.4% to 37.8%. This is according to a detailed study of the Media Analyse '94 data commissioned by the Hamburg Media Authority HAM and conducted by RMS Radio Marketing Services.

The five private stations in Hamburg-Radio Hamburg, AlsterRadio, OK Radio, Klassik Radio and Jazz Welle Plus-have a combined share of 51.6% up from 49.8%, against NDR's 37.8%. In addition, the four private stations from Schleswig-Holstein (RSH and Delta Radio) and Niedersachsen (Radio FFN and Antenne.Das Radio) which broad-

ORB, SFB Launch **News-Only Station**

GERMANY

German public radio stations ORB (Brandenburg) and SFB (Berlin) have agreed on a joint venture to launch a 24-hour news-only station, Info Radio.

Having received approval from the regional media board, Medienanstalt Brandenburg, ORB and SFB will present the final format plan in August and expect to be allocated a frequency by September. The station is scheduled to go on air early next vear. The move follows failed

attempts by ORB to save Info Radio's predecessor in 1993. Format problems were at the root of the station's failure, according to ORB MD Gerhard Hirschfeld. 'We need longer programme cycles. The previous station repeated news bulletins every 15 minutes, which was too repetitive '

The new station will broadcast 24 hours a day, with three to four minute blocks of main news repeated in an interval of less than one hour. Special features ranging from regional issues to cultural interests will link the news blocks.

Dutch national station Radio Noordzee Nationaal has more than doubled its market share since it began broadcasting on terrestrial frequencies at the beginning of April. The all-Dutch language music station has moved up behind Radio 10 Gold as the second most-listened-to commercial radio station in the market

"By year end," predicts station director Martin Banga, "we should be the top commercial channel in Holland.

Since November/December of 1993, Radio Noordzee's market share has jumped from 1.5% to 6.3%. More recently, longtime player Sky Radio fell back into third place among commercial stations, dropping from 8.3% in November/December to 6.1% in May/June.

New Heads Appointed For State Hungarian Radio, TV

Hungarian president Arpad Goncz has appointed new heads of state television and radio, following the dismissal of the incumbent broadcasting heads.

Meanwhile, staff at the first channel of Hungarian Radio who

were dismissed in the spring have resumed work.

Laszlo Csucs of Hungarian Radio and Gabor Nahlink of Hungarian Television were let go last week following complaints of conservatism and pro-government slant in programmes at the state broadcaster.

Goncz accepted nominations

for the new candidates made by new Socialist Prime Minister Gyula Horn. Adam Horvath has been appointed president of Hungarian Television and Jonas Sziranri President of Hungarian Radio, after consultations with opposition parties broke down. The opposition parties and a group of journalists had appealed

to Mr Goncz to delay the appointments, while trade unions and broadcasters' professional groups urged him to go ahead. The former centre-right government, which was replaced by a socialistliberal coalition on July 15, has been widely criticized by journalist groups in Hungary and abroad, of using electronic media to promote itself and attack adversaries. The new government has proposed that parliament pass a longpostponed media law which would lay down guarantees of editorial independence for broadcasters and pave the way for partially privatising electronic media, over which the state currently has a virtual monopoly.



Talking about a time warp, he revisits Khachaturian's Sabre Dance, the dazzling instrumental which was his first hit with Love Sculpture. Fortunately the effect of the Woolworth" synths and drum box is reduced to an acceptable level for purists.

ELECTRIC LIGHT ORCHESTRA PART II Moment Of Truth - Ultrapop/Edel

The light has dimmed. ELO without Jeff Lynne is possible, but don't look for nostalgia. The layers of violins and harmony vocals are much thinner now. Most of all we remember the powered orchestra for its musical fun through deliberate kitsch, but the humour factor with quotes from classical pieces and Beatles records has gone. The bombast is dead serious now, in a way Alan Parsons handles symphonic rock. Between the grotesque score the straightforward rocker Don't Wanna is most alluring.

Having as much fun as Cyndi Lauper, she provides the perfect pop, not directly for schoolgirls maybe, but certainly for college girls. It's only right that the single Right Beside You is exploding on radio, but wait until the rest will be issued as singles. Hopefully she has recorded enough potential B-sides, because it would be stupid to use one of the album tracks for that purpose. If we may choose one single candidate, than it will be the uptempo track Swing From The Limb To Limb (My Home Is In Your Jungle).

They are now one of three acts that have simultaneously held the top spot and the Sales Breaker award in the Hot 100, yet no-one before has pulled that trick twice.

Taken from the OST Four Weddings And A Funeral, Love Is All Around (Precious/Phonogram) is the fourth song featured on a soundtrack to top the singles chart this year and-since last week's number 1 I Swear-the fourth cover to do so as well.

The Hot 100's highest entry goes to what is probably the UK's biggest duo-Erasure (Mute). Run To The Sun marks their 16th Eurochart entry, registering at number 45 and their previous single Always is not even cold yet at number 50. Currently Always and '86s Sometimes are their secondhighest charting singles (peak 4) behind their '92 Abba tribute Abba-esque which peaked at number 2.

More stunts are being performed in the Top 100 Albums. Last week's number 1 debut, the Rolling Stones Voodoo Lounge (Virgin), stays on top, grabs a bullet and earns this week's albums Sales Breaker award. Noblesse Oblige performed in grand fashion.

Meanwhile, highest new albums entry House Of Pain's Same As It Ever Was (Tommy Boy)-best known for their infectious singles Jump Around and Shamrocks And Shenanigans-is breaking out across Europe as if loud and brash rap performed by a bunch of American-Irish rappers has always been part of the mainstream. Scattered across various labels throughout Europe, all but Southern Europe has fallen for their infectious brand of funk-Mark Sperwer rap.



or almost twenty years reggae was the best known music from the Caribbean. Then at the turn of the decade "merengue" from the Dominican Republic came into European view via Juan Luis Guerra. Now we can finally complete the musical puzzle of the Caribbean map by introducing **Carlos Vives**, a native of Santa Marta on the Colombian Caribbean coast. Local specialities such as "cumbias" and most of all "vallenatos" are the name of his game.

In his pioneer days Vives was a purist in these genres, until he moved to the country's capital Bogota, where he urbanised his style. Under the influence of Argentinean rock he further branched out into new territories. Meanwhile, he also started a career as a TV actor. Since then the 31-year-old has hit the TV screens from Latin America to the US. It was during a historical TV tribute to vallenato legend **Rafael Escalona** two years ago that he rediscovered the beauty of that particular genre. Suddenly he looked his roots straight in the eyes, and he formed the band **La Provincia**.

Singing the classic vallenatos about everyday life in his homeland in still his very own way, he might have alienated himself from the purists, but not too drastically. "Luckily for me, those people don't buy records" was his own ironic comment when he released the album *Clasicos De La Provincia* in August 1993, which sold one million copies in only six months in Latin America and the US Hispanic market combined. Vives could very well be the next star of the Caribbean, and *La Gota Fria* the accordion and pan flute-dominated single as inserted in this week's issue should be the first step. It's so irresistibly cheerful, it should blow softly from radios on beaches like a tropical breeze. Viva Vives!



growth rate of Popkomm will continue at the same rate. I think there will be a point where it takes care of itself "

The German record industry on the whole welcomes Popkomm's steady growth into a European event. MCA president GSA Heinz Canibol says Popkomm's transition into a European fair was inevitable. "Based on the importance of the German market and the success of Popkomm, it's inevitable that it becomes a European event Especially as most German companies target the European market with

their dance product. My hope is that Popkomm might soon develop into Europe's most important and biggest fair, not only for music but for entertainment in general."


Comments PolyGram Germany president Wolf Gramatke, "It was always clear from the start that if Popkomm was a success, it would have European appeal and impact. I now look forward to Popkomm developing into the major music industry even in Europe." Sony Music Germany MD Jochen Leuschner says that Popkomm has always offered the opportunity

for people within the music industry to meet once a year. "This is obviously of most importance for the entire German record industry, but it is becoming increasing important for international participants from all over Europe. This is a trend which I welcome." Leuschner does not think Popkomm is in danger of loosing sight of its original goals. "Despite the by now obligatory participation of all the majors, Popkomm has managed to remain on the whole an event which is geared towards small independent creative cells.

Although he doesn't see any immediate danger of Popkomm becoming too big, Leuschner hopes that in future years the organisers can keep check of the fair's growth in order to maintain "the charm and efficiency of this event for national and international attendees

MD marketing EMI/Electrola Erwin Bach agrees, saying he is all for the trend towards Europeanisation at Popkomm, provided that Popkomm's unique club atmosphere is preserved. Bach does not think Popkomm is expanding at such a rate that it is loosing sight of its original goals, however. "As long as the panels and the respective directives achieve their ends, this danger does not exist. However, in my opinion, it is important to have well-prepared presenters at the individual panels and all fair activities must be carefully planned by the participants: indies, majors, media, musicians and publishers.

Gramatke says that although he does see a danger in Popkomm growing too big, the fair has managed to keep sight of its original goals and aims so far. He adds, "German music is international and has gained international acceptance, so I think that Popkomm's first

goals have already been well achieved "

Another change to this year's Popkomm is mirrored in the logo-the underline has been changed-from "The Trade Fair for Pop Music In Germany" to "The Trade Fair for Pop Music & Entertainment". Explains Großmaas, "We've made this change to the logo as it allows us to include new technology and new developments in the fair. It will in fact be one of the main themes of the fair this year-especially in the seminars. We are still keeping Popkomm's roots as a music centre in mind, but we have to be aware of things being added to music. New technology will become part of the music market. If you set out as Popkomm dealing with the whole music industry, you have to deal with the whole field, you can't ignore one part."

Großmaas says the music industry still has a lot of fears about dealing with new technology. "A lot of things are unclear in the music industry related to new technology, such as how it will affect licensing, rights and the artists themselves. It

is therefore a helpful aspect of Popkomm if the fair can be used to educate and inform people on these topics. Popkomm has always been intended as a communication forum and a place to give a perspective on the future of the music marketplace.

Popkomm has already generated classical offshoot--Klassik Komm, a separate fair for classical music. This year Popkomm is devoting floorspace to jazz music for the first time. Whether or not Jazzkomm will be the end product remains to be seen, but it underline's Popkomm's support for all music genres.

> This year Midem placed more emphasis on showcasing new talent Großmaas thinks there is no need for such adjustments at Popkomm, however, as the Festival programme is well-known for its support of new bands and is now billed as the biggest live music festival in the world. Says Großmaas, "You don't see many big names in the Popkomm Festival programme. We feature around 40-50% upcoming and unsigned bands in our new talent showcase." For the last few years, the showcase has been sponsored by Sony Music UX-S; this year it is to be spon-

sored by C&A, while public radio net Westdeutscher Rundfunk and retail chain WOM are also presenting concerts. Großmaas is already envisaging the showcase becoming European in the next few years and is looking at forging partnerships with other European organisations and institutions with which Popkomm has a good relationship.

The Festival itself is already becoming increasingly European with Scandinavian acts featuring especially strong in this year's programme.

German music TV channel Viva is to present Popkomm's programme of live music events, "Popkomm-Das Festival". The channel was first announced as a project at Popkomm two years ago. Now former Popkomm supremo Dieter Gorny will be attending the fair which he set up six years ago in a different capacity, as the MD of Viva.

Großmaas is keen to stress the differences between Popkomm and Midem. "We have a quite different concept to Midem. Popkomm is much more musically-oriented. Popkomm is European, Midem international. The fairs are held at different times of the year. In all, I think the whole festival and conference programme and the kind of distributors at Popkomm show quite an obvious difference to Midem."

Summing up, Großmaas says the main purpose of Popkomm is related to its name. "Communication is one of the most important things that has to happen in the music industry. It is always at the forefront of Popkomm, plus the fact that it's first and foremost a business fair, a forum where you can meet, discuss and do business with people. Feedback from attendees tells us this is exactly what people want.'

Popkomm—The History

Dieter Gorny faunds the Rock Bureau in Wuppertal, North Rhine Westphalia. 1986 Funded by the State of NRW, the rock centre sets out to support new rock and pop talent in the region.

1989 Dieter Gorny launches Popkomm with the first foir's motto as "Popular Music In Germany Today". Held in Düsseldorf, the fair offers the music industry its first platform for the exchange of ideas and thoughts. 1990 The concept of Popkomm with its fair, congress and festival divisions is so suc-

cessful that Popkomm has to move to Cologne where it has space to expand.

1991 The Ministry of Economics and Technology becomes interested in the pop music industry seeing its cultural and economic value. Minister Günter Einert becomes the patron of Popkamm for the first time. After long discussions, a date is set for the launch of the Popkomm company for the Support of Music and Cammunications Technology.

1992 Popkomm receives funding for the next four years from the ministry of Economics and Technology. Due to a steep rise in the number of exhibitors and delegates, the fair is moved to the Cologne Exhibition Centre.

1993 Popkomm is opened up to Europeans in recognition of the impending European Union. The fair attracts over 10.000 people. The launch of music TV channel Viva is announced and Dieter Gorny hands over the reins of Popkomm to Uli Großmaas in order to devote himself to this new project. Ralf Plaschke is appointed as his deputy.

1994 As Popkomm's activities expand with the launch of Klassik Komm, Popkomm GmbH is renamed Musik Komm GmbH. The first Klassik Komm takes place in March. Popkomm acknowledges the growth of new technology and multi-media by changing its logo this year to Popkomm—The Trade fair for Pop Music & Entertainment. In July, Popkomm announces it is sold out, with record attendance figures expected.

The Popkomm Festival

Thursday August 18

7 Seconds, 7 Adds

Airplay

During its ninth charting week, 7 Seconds, the lead-off single from Youssou N'Dour's new album The Guide (Wommat), and the only track on it that features vocals by Neneh Cherry, stands out as the hottest record on EHR, earning M&M's Radio Active award for collecting the biggest chart-point gain of the week. The record ascends the top 3 now with a roster of 104 stations, spread out over 23 European countries.

M&M's Trackfax data learns that, along with six upward conversions (e.g. from medium to heavy rotation) at platinum and gold stations, seven counting adds are helping the record in its upward move. Those first-time reports are divided quite advantageously, as five are coming from platinum, one from a gold and yet another from a silver station. Especially in the UK, Germany, Austria and Denmark, the duet is gaining radio impact, whereas national networks in Italy (Radio Deejay Network/Milan), Spain (Cadena 100/Madrid) and Portugal (RFM/Lisbon) have added the song to their playlists this week. Best penetration figures (80 to 100%) are being scored in Holland, Italy, Austria, Switzerland and Turkey.

On a regional level, the Senegalese, US-signed artist is currently number 2 in both the North and West Central regions (see **Regional Airplay**, page 19). In the South he already went that high six weeks ago, whereas in the West Central, *7 Seconds* enjoyed number one status for five weeks, four of which were consecutive (issue 27-30). This week, it jumps to the pole position of the **Atlantic Crossovers** chart as the top-playlisted North American record on European radio, considering all formats (see **Regional Crossovers**, page 18).

As discreetly anticipated last week, Sophie B. Hawkins claims the highest new entry in the top 40 (at number 28) with *Right Beside You*, while managing to attract the largest amount of adds for the second consecutive week (17; last week 16), thus qualifying as Most Added leader once again. Notably in Italy the US singer picks up numerous adds and it is also Italy where she reaches the highest penetration ratio, as well as in the UK (53% in both countries). Norway follows closely with a 50% acceptance level.

The second highest new entry (at number 34) is grabbed by German signing Jam & Spoon. The DJ duo's *Find Me*—currently number 9 in the **Border Breakers** chart, page 18—appears on playlists from 12 countries, most prominently on those from Italy (60%), followed by Holland (50%) and Germany (48%). In the South, *Find Me* enters straight at number 8 (see Regional Airplay again). *Pieter Kops*

The highest new entry in this week's **Border Breakers** chart (at number 19) is *Tonight Is The Night* by German dance act Le **Click**, signed to Frankfurtbased dance indie Logic. Produced by **Click**

Production, the same production team that delivered La Bouche's Sweet Dreams (currently at number 10 in the same chart), Le Click's single crosses over to Italian stations only. They are nine in total, including Milanese platinum EHR networks Radio Deejay Network and Rete 105 Network as well as 101 Network's "Dance Parade" (also Milan-based) and dance-formatted platinum programme "Los Cuarenta" at Italia Network/Udine. Although not contributing to the chart calculations, which are solely radio-driven, the song is also included in MTV Europe's dance show "Party Zone".

Le Click is really breaking out on Italian radio as five out of the nine stations playlisting it concern first-time reports, while another has moved the track from medium to heavy rotation. The latter brings the heavy (or "A") rotation penetration to a stunning 100%, as all the others also play it that often. At two of these stations, the record has even achieved "powerplay" status.

It is also striking to see that the second-highest new entry in the chart (at number 22) is grabbed by French signing Blind Fish featuring David Hallyday whose *Natural Child* was a CD-insert in M&M recently. No less than 19 stations across the regional borders are reporting the track, including platinum EHR's in Italy (RTL 102.5 - Hit Radio/Bergamo), Poland (Polskie Radio 3/Warsaw) and Russia (Radio Maximum/ Moscow/St. Petersburg). The Regional Crossover charts track the cross-regional movement of product. The Border Breakers chart ranks the 25 most successful Continental European records making airplay impact outside their region of signing (airplay achieved in the original region is excluded from the calculations).

The second chart, Channel Crossovers, registers the airplay penetration of UK-signed artists in mainland Europe, while the third Top 25, the Atlantic Crossover chart, ranks the most successful North American artists according to regional airplay impact in Europe.

All three charts are non-format specific. "Region Of Origin" is not necessarily an indication of where the artist comes from but, more significantly, where he/she is signed. An increasing number of national artists are signed to "foreign" labels and M&M wants to acknowledge the crossover impact of such deals.

For each record, "Crossover Regions" are listed in order of firsttime airplay appearance.
