## OKLAHOMA CITY BLUE NOTES

**Tonight's Matchup:** The **Oklahoma City Blue (20-21)** plays game three of a five-game road stretch with a matchup against the **Stockton Kings [Sacramento Kings affiliate] (23-19)**, for the final meeting between the teams this season.

**Last Time Out:** After being down by as much as 22 in the game, Oklahoma City fought back and took a lead 110-109 on a Tyler Cook layup with 4:28 left in the game. The teams would go back and forth down the stretch, with the game coming down to the last possession. Kevin Hervey's corner three-pointer would not fall for the Blue in the final seconds as the Spurs would hold on to win by three.

**Three-efficient Basketball:** Oklahoma City ranks sixth in the league with a 47.7 percent field goal percentage, due in large part to its 36.1 three-point field goal percentage, which ranks sixth overall in the G League. Oklahoma City has four players shooting 40 percent or above from beyond the arc: Sedrick Barefield (41.0), Markel Brown (43.8), Abdul Gaddy (43.8, 5th NBAGL) and Scotty Hopson (50.0).

**Give Me Three:** On Feb. 4 vs. the South Bay Lakers, Oklahoma City set an all-time G League record with 32 made threes in the game. Previously the record was 31, held by the Stockton Kings (12/17/19) and the Reno Bighorns (1/31/15). Abdul Gaddy and Devon Hall each had six 3s while Vincent Edwards contributed five.

**Simply Irr-ASSIST-able:** On Jan. 23 vs. the Texas Legends, guard Abdul Gaddy set a career high and G League season high with 20 assists. Gaddy, the league leader with 8.9 dimes per game, has bested his career high in assists three times this season.

**What are you doing New Year's Eve?:** To wrap up 2019, the Blue competed in just its third NYE contest in franchise history. With the 99-92 victory over the Sioux Falls Skyforce, Oklahoma City is a perfect 3-0 on New Year's Eve. Meanwhile, the parent club played its traditional home NYE contest, defeating the Dallas Mavericks, 106-101, taking its record on the last night of the year to 10-2.

**Rookie Record:** In Oklahoma City's first game of the season, Luguentz Dort scored 35 points on 12-19 shooting from the field and 4-9 from beyond the arc, marking a record for a Blue player in their G League or team debut. Jeremy Lamb previously held the record, scoring 33 points in his first game with the franchise on November 30, 2012.

**Block Party:** The Blue ranks second in the league with 5.98 blocks per game. In Oklahoma City's 12/7 game versus the Salt Lake City Stars, the Blue recorded 14 blocks, tied for most blocks in any G League game this season.

**The Gould Standard:** Oklahoma City Thunder Director of Pro Evaluation Jesse Gould took over roster management of the Blue at the start of the 2016-17 season and in his time at the helm, the Blue stands as one of the G League's best teams. Over the last three seasons, Oklahoma City has put together the second-best regular season record in that time (96-54, .640). The Raptors 905 lead the G League with a .660 win percentage in that time. Oklahoma City has advanced to the playoffs in each of the last three seasons, including a trip to the Western Conference Finals in the 2016-17 season.

**Proud to be an American:** Oklahoma City Blue guards Abdul Gaddy and Devon Hall were named to the roster for the February 2020 USA AmeriCup Qualifying Team. Oklahoma City was one of only three G League teams with multiple players named to the roster. The 12-man roster played a pair of games in the February FIBA AmeriCup Qualifying window, including a game versus Puerto Rico in San Juan on Feb. 20 and a home game on Sunday, Feb. 23.

**II-LU-minating Beginnings:** Two-way player Luguentz Dort has started 21 games for the Oklahoma City Thunder this season with the Thunder earning a 16-5 record in those games. Dort's 21 starts are the most by any two-way player since two-way contracts were introduced in 2017. This season, the Arizona State product is averaging 6.2 points and 1.9 rebounds in 21.9 minutes, while shooting 41.4 percent from the field.

**A Part of the Program:** The Oklahoma City Blue's roster features 12 players who have previous experience as a part of the Thunder program. Luguentz Dort and Kevin Hervey are under two-way contracts with the Thunder, while Isaiah Roby is on assignment from the Thunder. Devaughn Akoon-Purcell, Sedrick Barefield, Markel Brown, Abdul Gaddy, Devon Hall, Myke Henry, Scotty Hopson and Kadeem Jack have all previously played in training camp with the Thunder.

**Balanced Blue:** Oklahoma City's roster features a balanced offensive attack, with 10 players averaging double-digit scoring. Thirty-five of the team's games this season have featured five players scoring in double figures. The Blue has had at least five players score in double figures in 235 of 291 regular season games the past six seasons.

**Investing in Development:** The Oklahoma City Thunder has placed an emphasis on using its development team and investing in the development process. When Oklahoma City purchased its G League affiliate in 2008, it entered the season as one of just three teams to have a single affiliation with a G League club. Ten seasons later, all teams in the G League are in single affiliation with an NBA organization. Since the 2008-09 season, the Thunder has helped lead the way in using the G League as a place to develop and grow talent. The Thunder has assigned 28 different players to its G League affiliate a combined 152 times since 2008. The Thunder has called-up a player from its affiliate on 13 occasions since the 2008-09 season.

**Triple-Threat:** On Friday, December 9, 2018, Markel Brown scored a career-high 41 points at the Wisconsin Herd, the most by any Blue player this season. Brown shot 15-29 from the field and 9-19 from beyond the arc. The nine three-pointers are a team record, besting the eight 3s made by Mario Little on 3/22/14 vs. Iowa. It also ties the record for three-point field goals attempted set by Thunder player Josh Huestis on 1/31/15 vs. Iowa.

#### GAME HIGHLIGHTS:

- The teams would go back and forth down the stretch, with the game coming down to the last possession. Kevin Hervey's corner three-pointer would not fall for the Blue in the final seconds as the Spurs would hold on to win by three.
- Hervey led the Blue with 22 points on 8-of-18 shooting, including six three-pointers, and added five assists, four rebounds and two steals. Scotty Hopson added 19 points on 5-of-5 shooting from beyond the arc and six rebounds.
- Kadeem Jack recorded a career-high 21 rebounds to go with his eight points and two steals.
- DeVaughn Akoon-Purcell led the Oklahoma City bench with 18 points on 7-of-11 shooting and six rebounds. Myke Henry was another one of six Blue players in double figures, scoring 12 points on 5-of-7 shooting.

#### GAME HIGHLIGHTS:

- After the Blue put together a 15-2 fourth quarter run punctuated by a Devon Hall three-pointer to bring Oklahoma City within one, Brandon Sampson's and-one layup with 43 seconds left put game away as the shot gave the Vipers a 129-125 lead.
- Oklahoma City had six players that scored at least 15 points in the game. Scotty Hopson led the Blue with a team-high 21 points on 7-of-13 shooting along with six assists and four rebounds. Kadeem Jack scored 11 of his 15 points in the second quarter and added seven rebounds.
- The Oklahoma City bench was led by Tyler Cook, who scored 16 points on 7-of-15 shooting and added six rebounds. Markel Brown made five of his eight three-point attempts to add 15 points off the bench.
- The Blue outscored the Vipers off the fast break 30-4 and generated 24 points off Vipers turnovers.

#### GAME HIGHLIGHTS:

- The Blue kept the Hustle at a double-digit distance through halftime until Memphis generated an 18-4 run midway through the third to pull within two at 86-84. The Blue responded by gradually growing the lead back to 18 with 2:25 to play thanks to 16 combined fourth quarter points from Scotty Hopson and Kadeem Jack. Oklahoma City held the lead for all but 10 seconds of game action to extend its home win streak to five games.
- Jack led the way for Oklahoma City with a team-leading 24 points and a game-best and career-high-tying 19 rebounds, shooting 9-for-14 from the floor. Hall and Hopson were close behind with 22 points apiece as Hall grabbed 10 boards of his own while Hopson drained a team-best three shots from beyond the arc.
- On assignment from the Thunder, Isaiah Roby went 3-of-4 from the field en route to nine points, five rebounds, two steals and two blocks. Tyler Cook led the Blue bench efforts with 13 points and six boards.

Grant Gibbs is in his first season as head coach of Oklahoma City Blue, becoming the seventh head coach in franchise history. Gibbs spent two seasons as an assistant coach for the Blue, as the team went 62-38 (.620) and advanced to the playoffs in both years.

Gibbs joined Oklahoma City after a three-year international playing career. A native of Iowa, he played in the Netherlands and Germany after graduating from Creighton with a degree in journalism.

Gibbs began his collegiate career at Gonzaga then transferred to Creighton after two seasons with the Bulldogs. He played in 100 games and averaged 7.6 points and 4.9 assists as the Bluejays appeared in the NCAA tournament in each of his seasons with the team.
