Resignations/Appointments:

Amendment 1-

Change Art Swanson President Award Club Growth percentage from 25 to 20 percent and move the 5 percent to Kiwanis support.

Amendment 2-

Change the Tom Duncan Secretary Award to move 15 percent weight from Miscellaneous to Duties.

Amendment 3-

Change the Club Editor Award to Evaluation 30 percent, Duties 50 percent, Meetings 15 percent, and Miscellaneous 5 percent.

Amendment 4-

Change Vice President weight by moving 15 percent from Miscellaneous to Duties.

Bryan Pham moved to accept the presented changes. Katie Stephenson seconded the motion. The motion was voted on and passed.

Regulations, Contests, and Awards Committee:

The Regulations, Contests, and Awards committee gave their report over changes to the policy code.

Amendment 1-

Add "or March" to the date on the post-convention board meeting. Article 1, Section 1, Subsection a, Paragraph 1.

Amendment 2-

Add "or February" to the winter board meeting date. Article 1, Section 1, Subsection a, Paragraph 5

Amendment 3-

Add "or March" to the pre-convention board meeting. Article 1, Section 1, Subsection a, Paragraph 6

Amendment 4-

Add, "This means online is not to be used to elect officers, or endorse candidates for international." To clarify the online voting process. Article 1, Section 1, Subsection d, Paragraph 1

Amendment 5-

Strike "Travel to and from the Key Club international convention at a fixed rate per person. Because it is not required, it is not reimbursable by district. Article 2, Section 1, Subsection b

Amendment 6-

Strike "and newsletters" because they are not required and thus not reimbursable through the district. Article 2, Section 1, Subsection c

Amendment 7-

Strike "Long distance telephone calls, not to exceed thirty minutes, to clubs or other authorized officials that require long distance phoning. Reimbursement shall not exceed ten minutes per call unless approved by the District Administrator." There are free ways to communicate which are more efficient rather than long distance phone calls. Article 2, Section 1, Subsection e

Amendment 8-

Change "two" to "one" meeting on the visit for lieutenant governors per club because they are only required to attend one meeting per club. Article 2, Section 1, Subsection f

Amendment 9-

Include "All travel and other expenses shall be pre-approved by the District Administrator." Article 2, Section 1, Subsection g

Amendment 10-

Strike "The following are reimbursable expenses for District Staff Officers of the Texas-Oklahoma District. District travel to and from the Lt. Governor-elect training (as a trainer), all board meetings, and the district convention at a rate per mile as established by the Kiwanis Board in the annual budget. Lodging and at least one meal shall be provided for the same;" All of Article 2, Section 2

Amendment 11-

Include "District staff" in order to condense by-laws so that you don't have an entire section for District Staff reimbursement. Article 2, Section 1

Amendment 12-

Add "Assistant Administrator-Finance with final approval of the District Administrator." Article 2, Section 1, Subsection a

Kathryn Aung moved to accept all the presented changes. Sarah Spivey seconded the motion. The motion passed.

The changes to the Code of Elections were presented.

Amendment 1-

Change "letter of intent" to "candidacy form" in all of Article 1, Section 1, Subsection b

Amendment 2-

Add "to the Regional Advisor prior to the election starting" Article 1, Section 1, subsection b

Amendment 3-

Add "Each Divisional Elections Conference will be held no later than January 15th of each year." Article 1, Section 1, subsection f

Amendment 4-

Add "Each club in the division shall be notified at least 30 days before the Divisional Election conference is held. Article 1, Section 1, Subsection g

Amendment 5-

Add "and the Assistant District Administrators." Article 1, Section 2, Subsection a, Paragraph 2

Amendment 6-

Add "At no time shall a candidate for any office comment, question, speak on another candidate's race, sex, sexual orientation, or any other inappropriate topic. Article 1, Section 2, Subsection a, Paragraph 9

Amendment 7-

Add "Any decision on appeal to the Administrator will be made by the District Administrator and the Assistant District Administrators." Article 1, Section 2, Subsection b, Paragraph 4

Amendment 8-

Change "start of district convention" to "after the candidacy meeting". Article 1, Section 2, Subsection b, Paragraph 5

Amendment 9-

Add "any decisions on an appeal to the Administrator will be made by the District Administrator and the Assistant District Administrators." Article 1, Section 2, Subsection b, Paragraph 7

Amendment 10-

Add "and/or by using a bar code". Article 2, Section 2, Subsection c, Paragraph 1

Amendment 11-

Add "and/or have their bar code appearing on the name badge electronically scanned." Article 2, Section 2, Subsection c, Paragraph 2

Amendment 12-

Add "Any violations of these rules may result in the disqualification of the candidate by the Committee on Regulations and Credentials. Decisions by the committee may be appealed to the District Administrator and the Assistant District Administrators." Article 2, Section 4, Subsection g

Amendment 13-

Add "In the event that the candidate running for District Staff position or International Endorsement is from the home Region of the District Administrator or Assistant District Administrators; that the administrator or assistant district administrator shall abstain from any decision and appoint another person from the Committee for Key Club to decide the appeal." Article 2, Section 4, Subsection h

Amendment 14-

Change "or his/her designee" to "and the Assistant District Administrators." Article 2, Section 6, Subsection b, Paragraph 5

Kathryn Aung moved to accept the proposed changes. Addi Duerksen seconded the motion.

During discussion, a grammar error was found.

Kathryn moved to fix all the grammar errors. Moselle seconded the motion.

Through a vote, the motion to fix gramma errors passed.

Through a vote, the motion to accept the changes to the Code of Elections passed.

Sponsorship Updates and Form:
