Academia & Business

During my entire career, I was both active in academia (clinical research/clinical care) and also in clinical drug development (private business). **Academic research:** During my earlier years, I was primarily dedicated to addiction/schizophrenia research (electrophysiology, neuroimaging, pharmacology, genetics). More recently, my focus partly shifted to cognitive decline/neurodegeneration in the critically ill elderly patients (dementia). I am the coordinator of two large national/international research consortia (www.biocog.eu; www.nicotine-research.com). **Business:** Since the early 90ies, I was working in parallel as a study physician/consultant (CNS phase-I/II studies) for the clinical research organization (CRO) Parexel Berlin. 2005, I started my own CRO business (Pharmaimage), providing services (electrophysiology, neuroimaging) to pharmaceutical companies and CROs worldwide.
