SF Bay Ferry

Alameda/Oakland/San Francisco Route operates weekdays, weekends, and some holidays between Alameda's Main Street, Oakland's Jack London Square, and the San Francisco Ferry Building.

Harbor Bay/San Francisco Route operates weekdays only between Alameda's Harbor Bay Isle and the San Francisco Ferry Building. No weekend service.

Richmond/San Francisco Route operates weekdays only between Richmond and the San Francisco Ferry Building. No weekend service.

Vallejo/San Francisco Ferry Route operate weekdays, weekends, and some holidays between the Vallejo Ferry Terminal and Mare Island and the San Francisco Ferry Building.

Fare Information

Passengers should purchase tickets at the Vallejo Ferry Terminal, Pier 41 ticket offices, or at Bay Crossings in the San Francisco Ferry Building - cash, VISA, MasterCard, and Commuter Checks accepted. One-way tickets may be purchased using the Hopthru mobile ticketing app and onboard by cash or credit card.

GGT bus fares may be purchased on board. Change will be given on a transit card, valid for future GGT travel. Inform the bus driver of your destination as you board.

Discount fares are available for youth, seniors, persons with disabilities, or by using a Clipper® card.

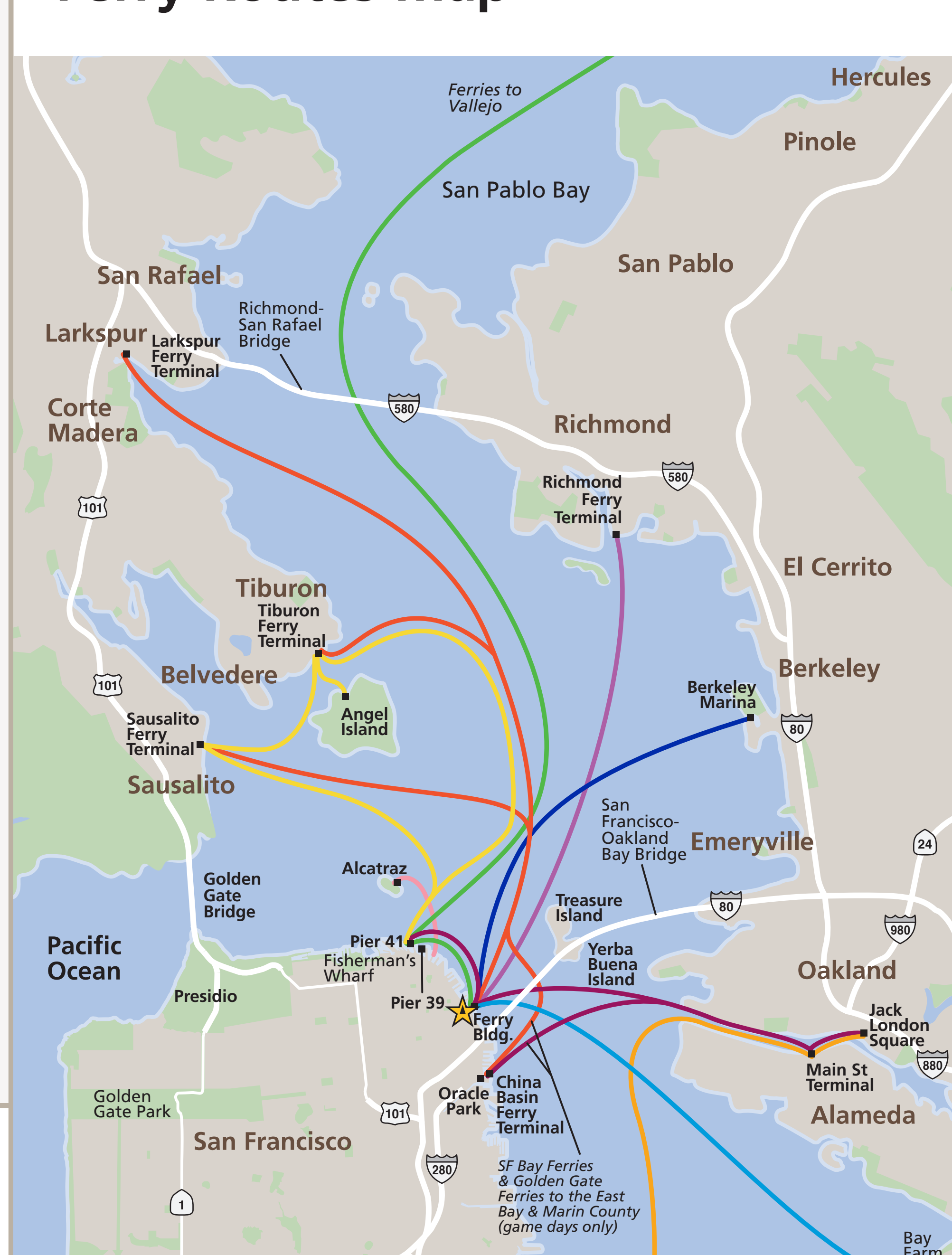
