[KENNEDY] As a fourth generation South Jerseyan and daughter of a former Absecon City Councilman, Amy Kennedy's parents taught her the importance of public service and giving back to her community. That's why Kennedy became a teacher who worked in New Jersey's public schools, and she continues to advocate for the well-being of children as a non-profit director. Kennedy is running for Congress because she wants to keep advocating for the people of South Jersey, making sure that they have a voice in Congress and are represented by someone who is interested in serving them, not serving their own self-interest.

[VAN DREW] Jeff Van Drew believes that Washington is broken because both Democrats and Republicans are being pulled apart by their most extreme members, making it impossible to get things done. In Congress, Van Drew has been willing to stand up to his own party to do what's right for South Jersey. He's worked to find common ground so that Congress can find solutions to the problems facing middle class New Jerseyans. Van Drew is going to keep working to build consensus and reach across the aisle so that Washington works for South Jerseyans again.
