Survey Methodology

<i>Period :</i>	November 27- December 01, 2018
<i>Survey Type :</i>	Computer Assisted Telephone Interviews (CATI)
<i>Eligibility :</i>	Age 18+.
<i>Total Respondents :</i>	n = 2,041
<i>Response Rate :</i>	Approximately 56%
<i>Margin of Error :</i>	The confidence interval is not more than $\pm 2.169\%$ at the mid-range with a confidence level of 95%.

- Data was collected by the dedicated team of enumerators of IPOR Consulting Through Computer Assisted Telephonic Interviews (CATI).
- The selection of respondents was made randomly from the phone data-base collected face to face on proportion to population sample (PPS) of adult residents in all four provinces of Pakistan.
- The information in this report has been compiled in accordance with international standards for market and social research methodologies. Figures in charts and tables may not sum to 100 percent due to rounding error.

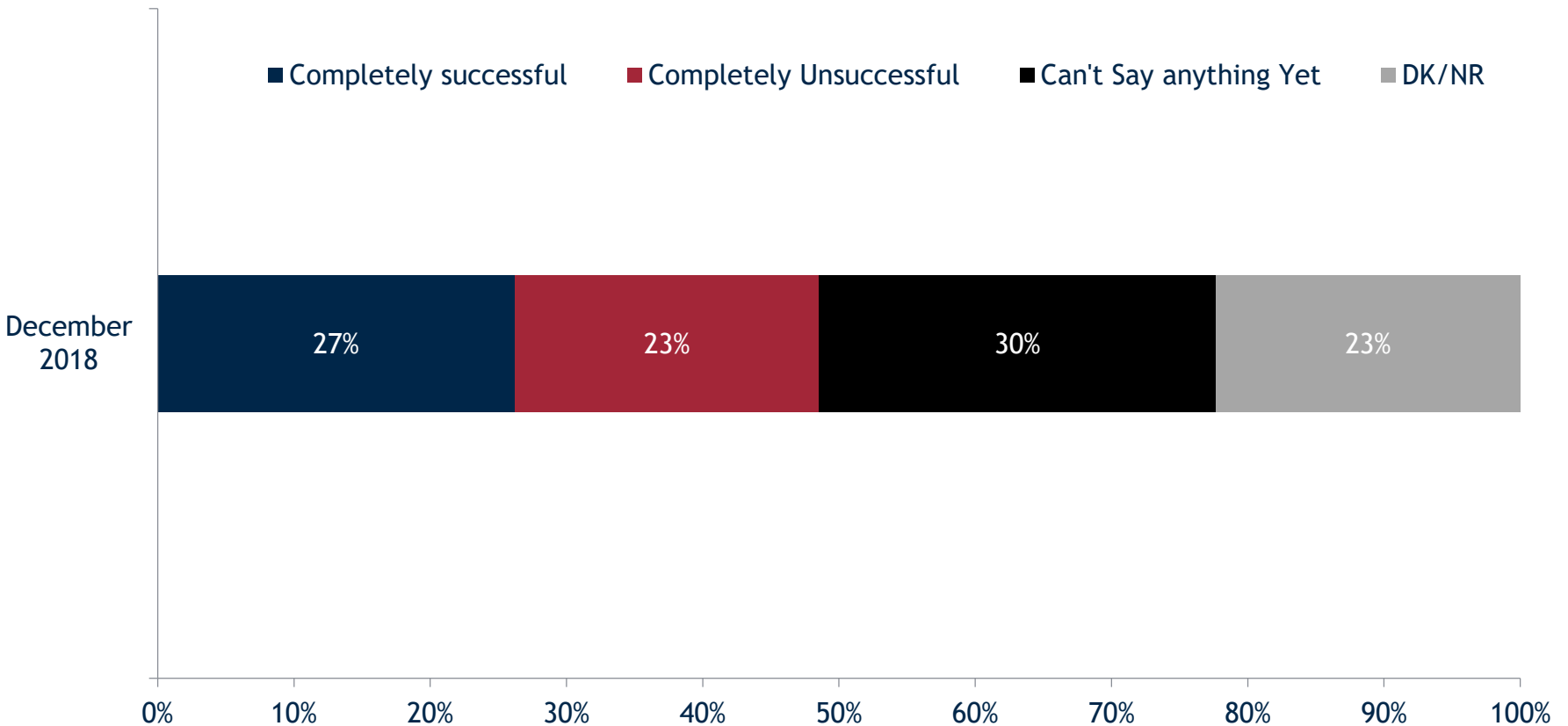

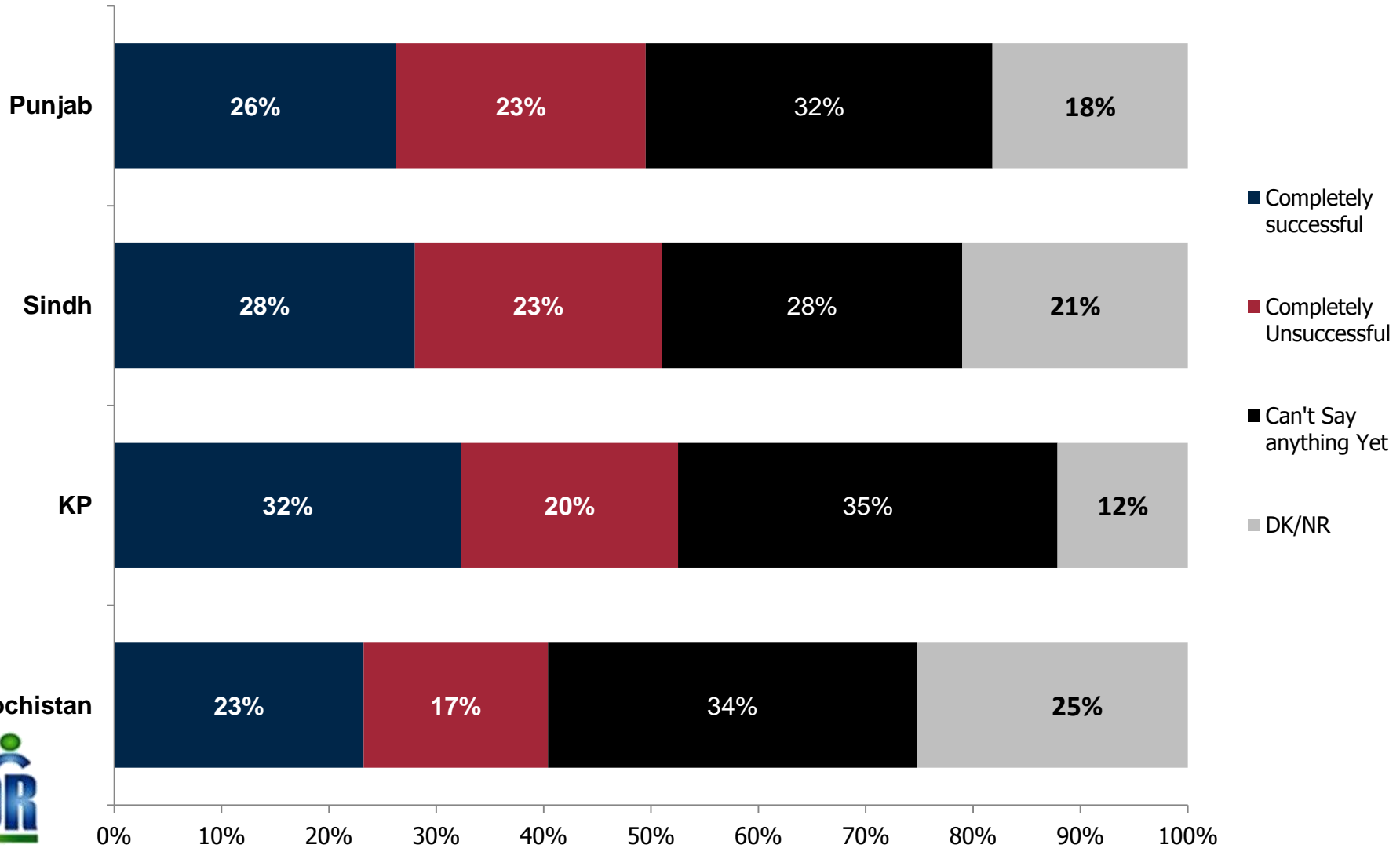

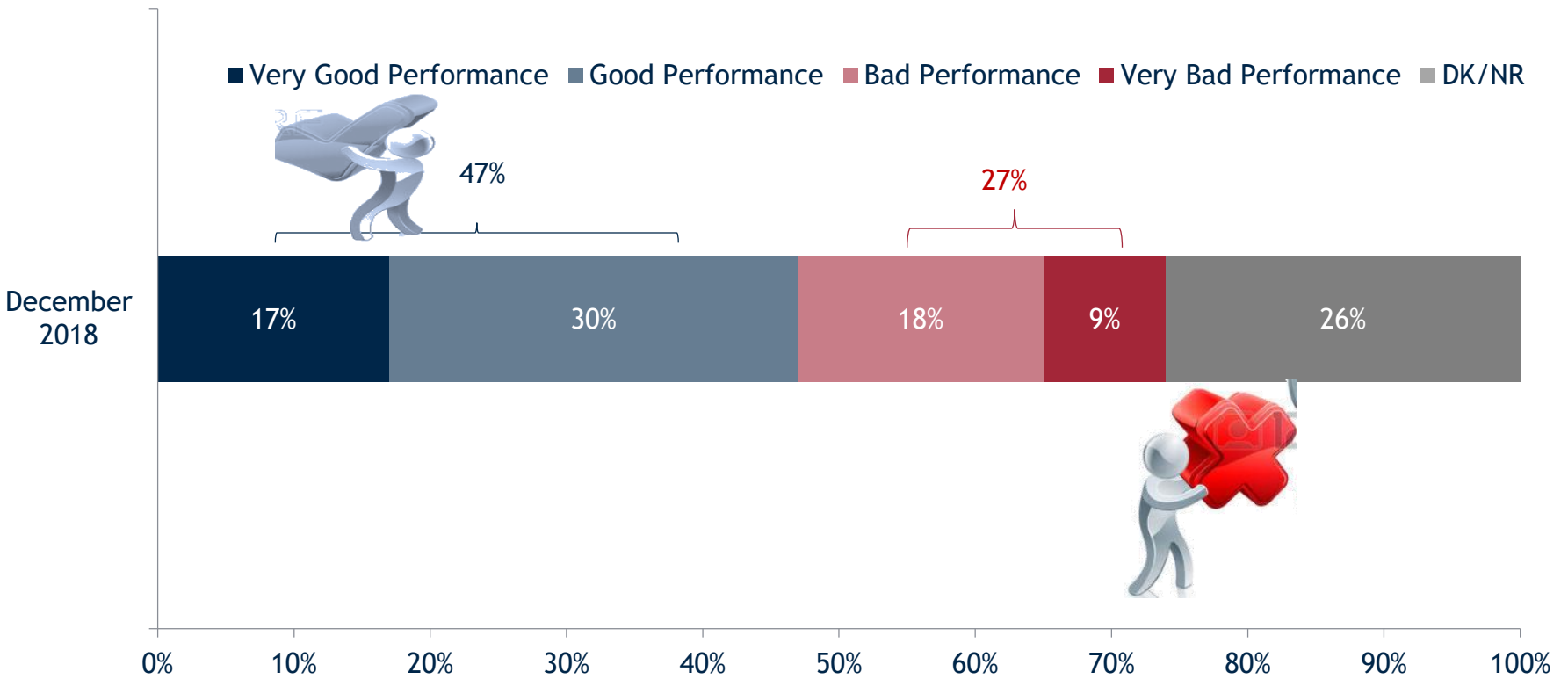


In your Opinion how successfully PTI Government has implemented its 100 days agenda/plan? By Province

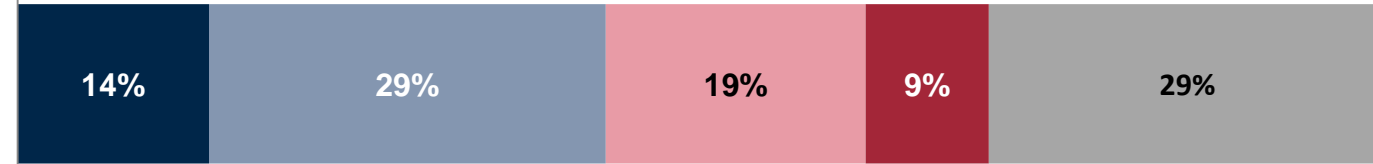


In your opinion how was the over-All performance of PTI Government in last 100 Days?

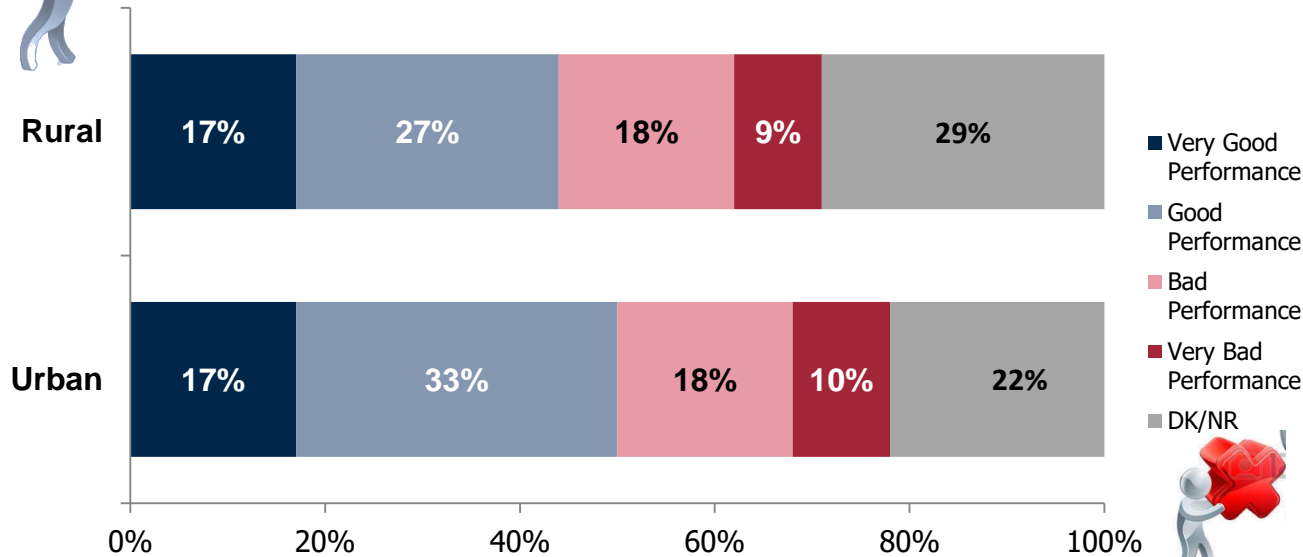

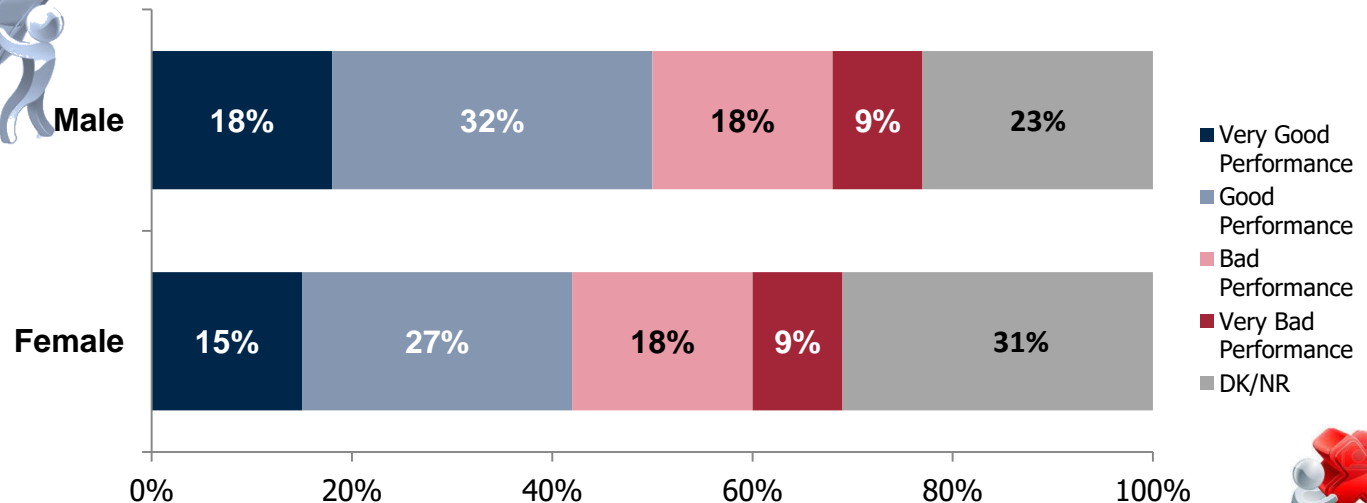
In your opinion how was the performance of PTI Govt. in last 100 Days?



By Location

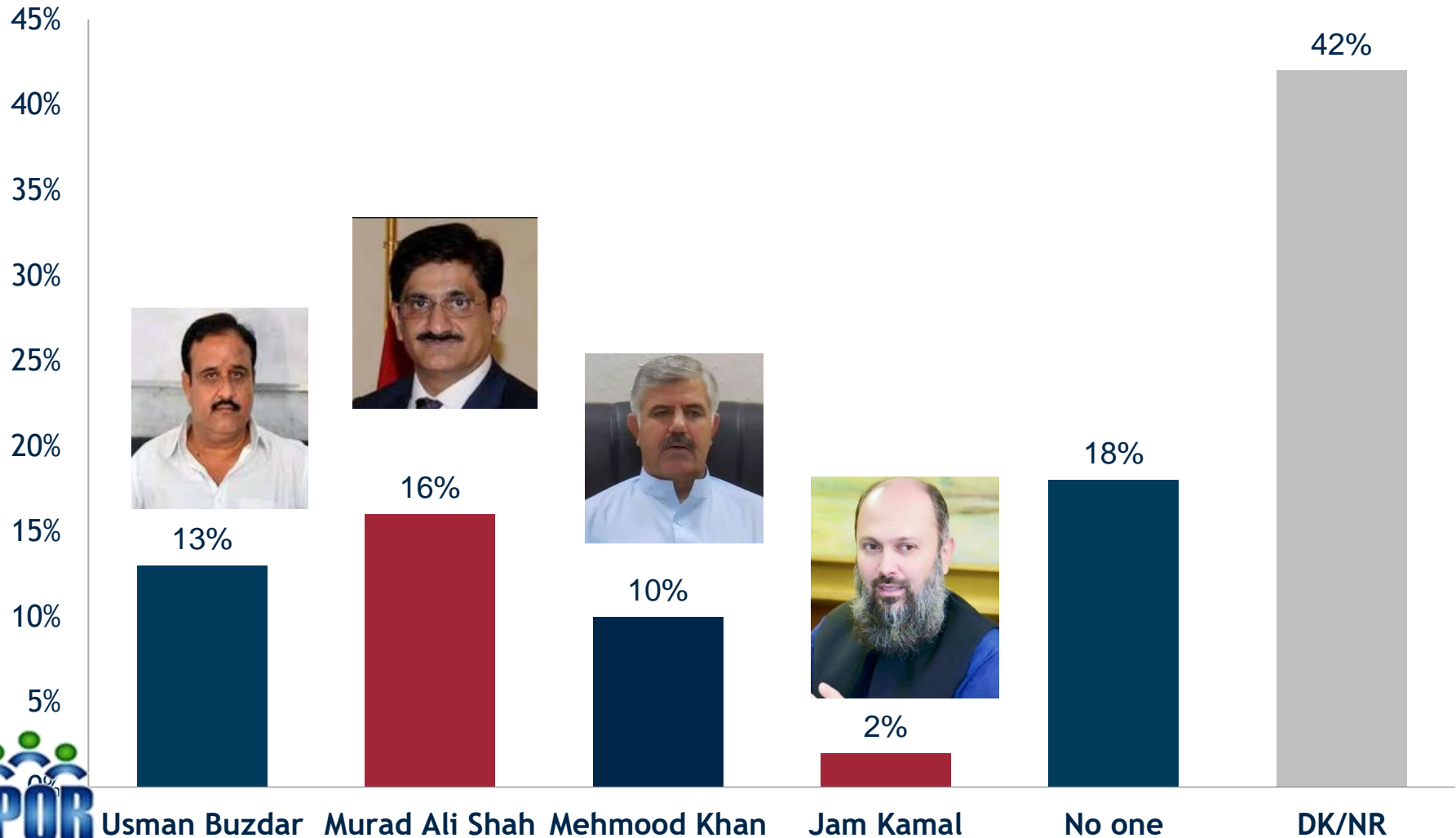


By Gender



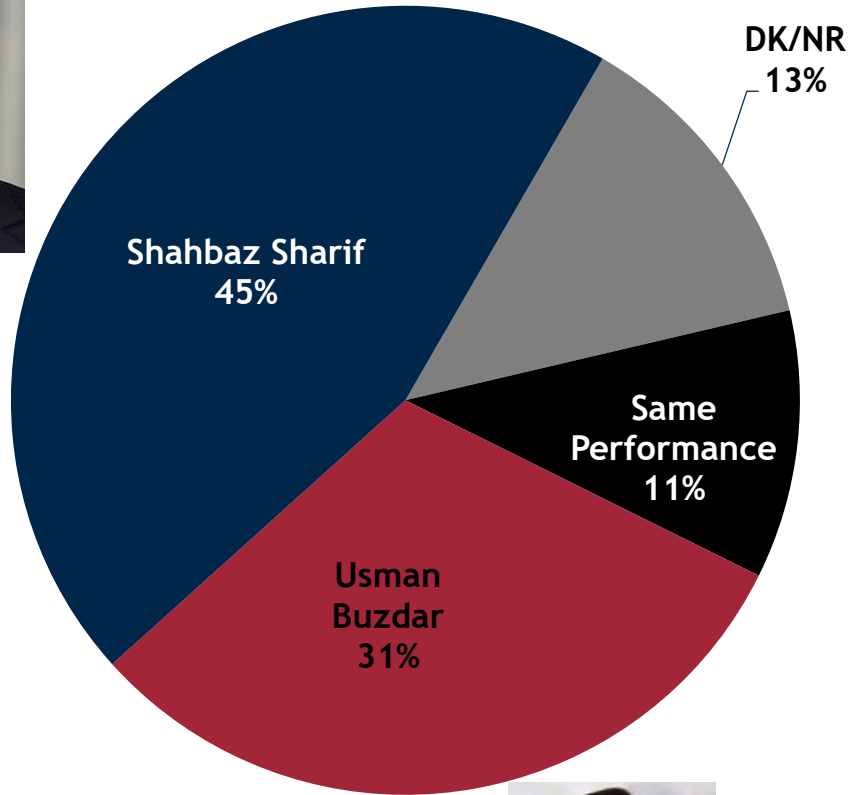
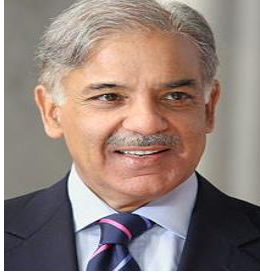
In your Opinion which of the following Chief Minister (CM) is performing a better job for his province?

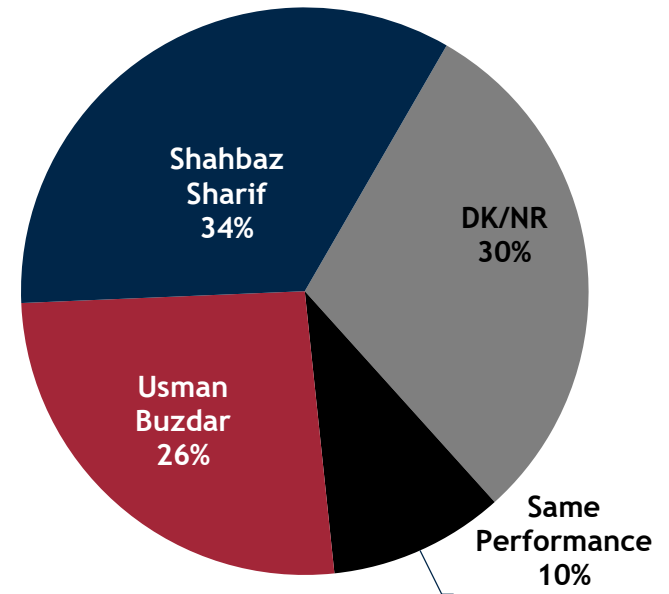


Who do you think has performed best as a Chief Minister of Punjab, Mr. Usman Buzdar or Mr. Shahbaz Sharif?

Only Punjab

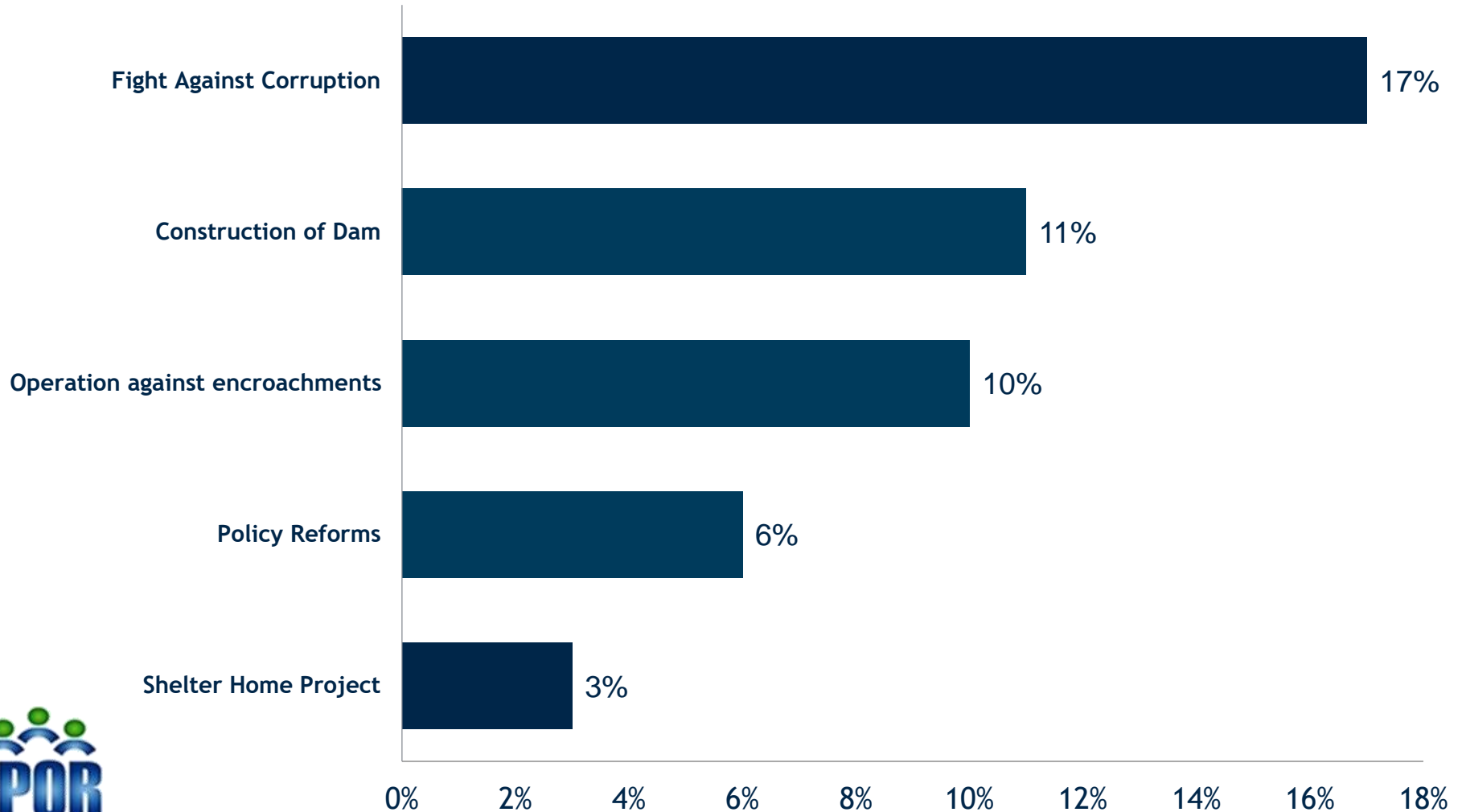

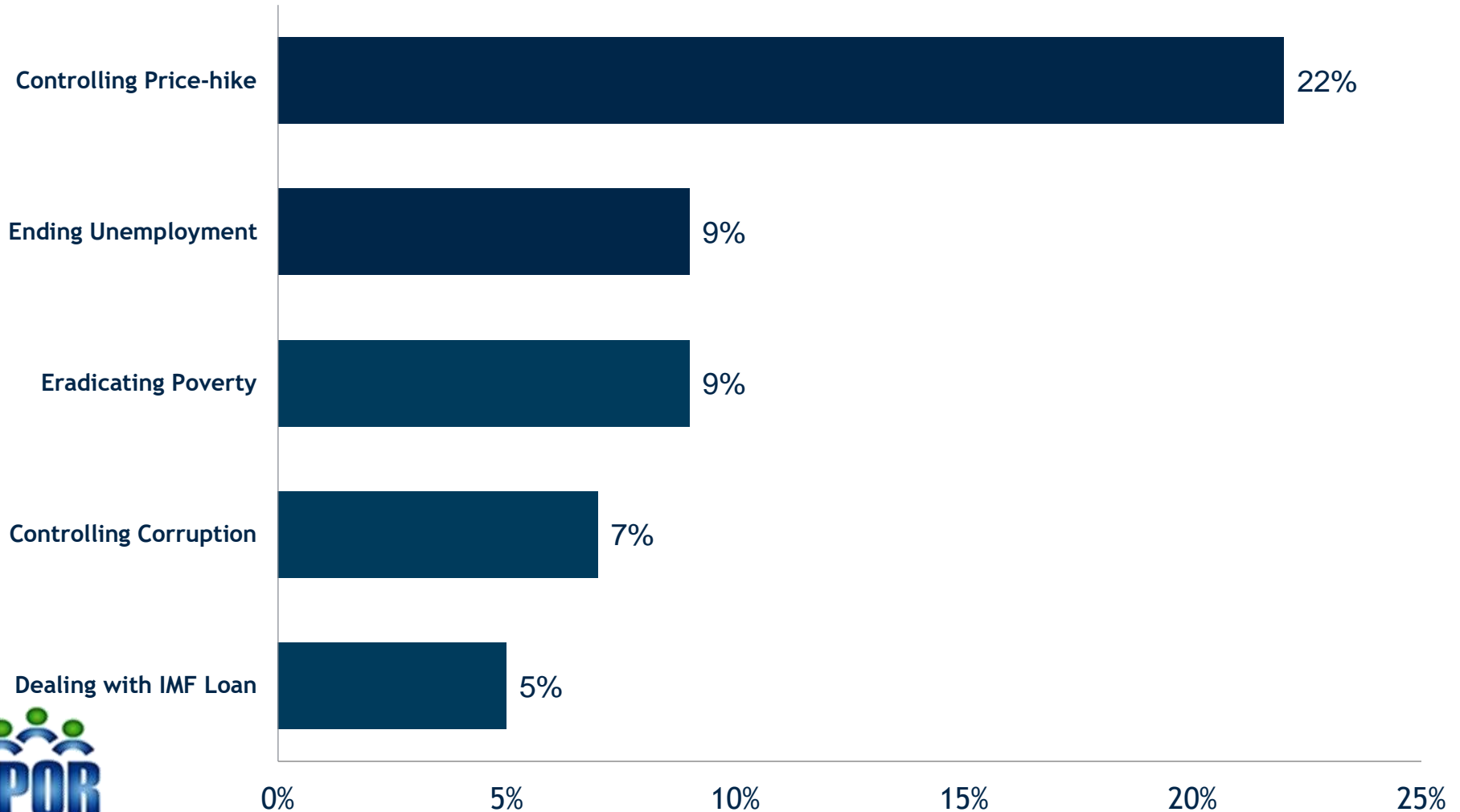
In Your Opinion what are the really good work that has been done by the current PTI government so far? (Open-ended)
