



#### Tropical Storm Lowell (Advisory #15 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 890 miles W of the southern tip of Baja California
- Moving WNW at 10 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 45 mph
- · Expected to weaken to a tropical depression Friday
- Tropical storm force winds extend outward 90 miles

#### **Disturbance 1** (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Expected to form south or southwest of the southwest coast of Mexico next week
- · Gradual development possible
- 48-hours Formation Chance: Low (near 0 %)
- 5-day Formation Chance: Low...(20%)

### Wildfires – Western US



<u>Situation:</u> Of the over 7 million acres burned, the National Watch Center continues to track 13 active fires that have burned over 2 million acres from the West Coast to the Rocky Mountains. Mandatory evacuations continue throughout the impacted regions. Current U.S. Air Quality Index ranges from "Moderate" to Very Unhealthy" for Central California to northern Washington state. No unmet needs at this time.



<u>Situation:</u> Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 22 states/territories, with 13 (-2) states/territories in a plateau status, and 21(+2) states/territories on a downward trajectory. 19,757 Federal employees deployed / activated; 1,469 (+1) FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Sep 23)

Nationwide Testing: 106,363,751 (+1,223,744) cumulative (as of Sep 23)

COVID-19 positive cases continue to increase globally (CDC COVID-19 update as of Sep 23)
